#### **Tropical Activity:**


- Atlantic:
  - Disturbance 1: Medium (40%)
  - Disturbance 2: Low (30%)
- Eastern Pacific: No new tropical cyclones expected during the next five days
- Central Pacific: No new tropical cyclones expected during the next five days
- Western Pacific: No activity affecting U.S. interests



#### Atlantic

#### Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- 600 miles ESE of Bermuda
- Additional gradual development possible
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (20%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Medium (40%)

#### Disturbance 2 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- · Over the SW Caribbean Sea
- Some gradual development possible
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (near 0%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (30%)

### COVID-19 Update



<u>Situation:</u> Upward trajectory in COVID-19 case count continues across 38 states/territories, with 8 (+4) jurisdictions in a plateau status, and 10 (-4) jurisdictions on a downward trajectory; 1,248 (-2) FEMA employees deployed. (COVID-19 SLB, as of Oct 15)

Nationwide Testing: 129,901,989 (+1,038,021) cumulative (COVID-19 SLB, as of Oct 15)


COVID-19 positive cases continue to increase globally

  - United States: 7,894,768 (+59,761)
  - o Worldwide: 38,202,956 (+304,119)
- · COVID-19 Associated Deaths:
  - United States: 216,025 (+831)
  - o Worldwide: 1,087,069 (+5,135)

#### Response:

- NRCC conducting COVID response operations
- Regions I, II, III, V, VI, & X RRCCs at Level III
- · Regions IV, VII, VIII, & IX RRCCs are rostered
- Regions VII, VIII, & IX COVID-19 working from the Virtual JFO
- NWC, all RWCs, and MOCs are monitoring




#### National Weather Forecast








