



<u>Hurricane Epsilon CAT 1</u> (Advisory #9A as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- 425 miles ESE of Bermuda
- Moving WNW at 14 mph
- Maximum sustained winds of 85 mph
- Additional strengthening is forecast
- Hurricane force winds extend outward up to 25 miles
- Tropical storm force winds extend outward up to 435 miles

COVID-19 Update



<u>Situation</u>: Upward trajectory in COVID-19 case count continues across 44 (+2) states/territories, with 4 (-2) jurisdictions in a plateau status, and 8 jurisdictions on a downward trajectory; 1,255 FEMA employees deployed. (COVID-19 SLB, as of Oct 20)


Nationwide Testing: 135,071,270 (+3,076,414) cumulative (COVID-19 SLB, as of Oct 20)

 - O Worldwide: 1,114,692 (+3,716) (COVID-19 Response Update, as of Oct 20)




- NRCC conducting COVID response operations

National Weather Forecast











Forecast Snowfall




