- Critical Fire Weather CA, NM, and TX
- COVID-19


#### **Tropical Activity:**






**Central Pacific**

Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)


- Located over the western Caribbean Sea

## Tropical Outlook – Atlantic




#### Hurricane Epsilon CAT 2 (Advisory #14A as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- 235 miles ESE of Bermuda
- Moving NW at 7 mph
- Maximum sustained winds of 100 mph
- Slow weakening forecast during the next few days
- Hurricane force winds extend outward up to 25 miles
- Tropical storm force winds extend outward up to 310 miles








