## National Current Operations and Monitoring FEMA

- Heavy snow possible Northern/Central Plains and Northern Rockies
- Critical fire weather Southern/Central Rockies
- Wildfires Western U.S.
- COVID-19

- Atlantic:
  - Hurricane Epsilon (CAT 1)
  - Disturbance 1 (Invest 95L): High (90%)
- Eastern Pacific: No new tropical cyclones expected during the next five days
- Central Pacific: No new tropical cyclones expected during the next five days
- Western Pacific: No activity affecting U.S. interests



#### Disturbance 1 (Invest 95L) (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)


- Located just southwest of Grand Cayman Island
- Drifting NW or N
- Could move near western Cuba on Monday and move slowly across the southeastern Gulf of Mexico by Tuesday
- Tropical depression is expected to form within the next day or so
- Formation chance through 48 hours: High (90%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: High (90%)

#### Tropical Outlook – Atlantic



#### Hurricane Epsilon (CAT 1) (Advisory #22 as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

- 355 miles NNE of Bermuda
- Moving NNE at 12 mph
- Maximum sustained winds of 75 mph
- Forecast to become a large and powerful post-tropical cyclone early next week
- Hurricane force winds extend outward up to 45 miles
- Tropical storm force winds extend outward up to 355 miles



## COVID-19 Update



<u>Situation:</u> Upward trajectory in COVID-19 case count continues across 42 (+1) states/territories, with 5 jurisdictions in a plateau status, and 9 jurisdictions on a downward trajectory; 1,254 (+6) FEMA employees deployed. (COVID-19 SLB, as of Oct 23)

Nationwide Testing: 138,334,061 (+1,293,657) cumulative (COVID-19 SLB, as of Oct 23)




#### Response:

- NWC, all RWCs, and MOCs are monitoring




#### National Weather Forecast





#### Forecast Snowfall








