
Tropical Outlook – Atlantic





Tropical Storm Zeta (Advisory #3A as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- 275 miles SE of Cozumel, Mexico
- Currently stationary
- Maximum sustained winds of 40 mph
- Tropical force winds extend outward up to 80 miles
- Forecast to become a hurricane by late Monday or early Tuesday.




Hurricane Epsilon (CAT 1) (Advisory #26 as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

- 270 miles S of Cape Race, Newfoundland
- Moving NE at 24 mph
- Maximum sustained winds of 80 mph
- Expected to become powerful post-tropical storm today
- Hurricane force winds extend outward up to 45 miles
- Tropical storm force winds extend outward 380 miles

<u>Situation</u>: Upward trajectory in COVID-19 case count continues across 42 states/territories, with 5 jurisdictions in a plateau status, and 9 jurisdictions on a downward trajectory; 1,254 FEMA employees deployed. (COVID-19 SLB, as of Oct 23)

Nationwide Testing: 138,334,061 cumulative (COVID-19 SLB, as of Oct 23)





- NWC, all RWCs, and MOCs are monitoring




National Weather Forecast






Forecast Snowfall






Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall






Severe Weather Outlook






Fire Weather Outlook









6-10 Day Temperature Probability





6-10 Day Precipitation Probability
