National Current Operations and Monitoring FEMA

Significant Incidents or Threats:

- Tropical Cyclone Zeta
- Wildfires CO
- COVID-19

Tropical Activity:

- Atlantic: Disturbance 1: High (90%)
- Eastern Pacific: Disturbance 1: High (70%)
- Central Pacific: No new tropical cyclones expected during the next five days
- Western Pacific: No activity affecting U.S. interests



Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Forecast to develop S or SW of the coast of southern Mexico this late weekend or next
- A tropical depression could form mid next week
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (near 0%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: High (70%)

Atlantic

Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located over the central Caribbean Sea
- A tropical depression likely to form in the next day or two
- Formation chance through 48 hours: High (90%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: High (90%)

Tropical Cyclone Zeta – Final



<u>Current Situation:</u> Zeta has dissipated; incident support responsibilities are being coordinated in the field.

Lifeline Impacts: (NRCC SLB Oct 30 as of 12:00 p.m. ET)

Safety and Security

· LA: All evacuation orders have been lifted

Food, Water, Shelter

- Meals, water and tarps are pre-staged within Regions IV and VI
- LA: 16 water systems serving a population of 5,278 with water outages due to TC Delta; 10 systems remain under boil water advisories affecting 28,630 people
- Shelters: (ARC as of 7:10 a.m. ET)
 - LA: 1 (-2) congregate open / 8 (-97) occupants (TC Zeta occupants only)
 - o MS: 2 (-3) congregate open / 29 (-43) occupants


Energy (Eagle-I as of 8:15 a.m. ET)

- 614k customers without power across the affected area:
 AL 172k (-111k); GA 125k (-245k); LA 220k (-53k); MS 97k (-30k)
- 56 generators staged at Craig Field, AL
- LA: 5,500 power restoration crews responding

Transportation

- Ports: Closed (4): LA Offshore Oil Port; MS Gulfport and Pascagoula;
 AL Mobile
 - o Open with restrictions: LA Lake Charles, Houma, Port Fourchon





Tropical Cyclone Zeta – Response




State/Local Response:

- LA EOC at Partial Activation (TC Laura, Delta, Zeta and COVID-19)
 - Approved: Emergency Declaration on Oct 27
 - National Guard activated
- AL EOC at Partial Activation (TC Sally, Delta, Zeta and COVID-19)
 - Governor declared a State of Emergency
 - National Guard activated
 - Requested: Expedited Emergency Declaration on Oct 29
- MS EOC at Partial Activation (TC Delta, Zeta and COVID-19)
 - o Approved: Emergency Declaration on Oct 28
- FL EOC at Full Activation (COVID-19)

FEMA/Federal Response:

- NRCC is conducting COVID response operations; NWC is monitoring
- Region IV RRCC rostered; RWC is monitoring
 - IMAT-1 Deployed to MS EOC, LNO supporting virtually; IMAT-2 and LNO deployed to AL EOC
- Region VI RRCC at Level III (COVID-19); RWC is monitoring
 - IMAT-1 demobilizing, IMAT-2 deployed to Baton Rouge, LA (TC Laura & Zeta)
 - o LNO demobilized
- SMT deployed in Camp Beauregard, LA (TC Laura/Delta)



COVID-19 Update

<u>Situation</u>: Upward trajectory in COVID-19 case count continues across 49 (+6) states/territories, with 3 (-5) jurisdictions in a plateau status, and 3 (-2) jurisdictions on a downward trajectory; 1,242 FEMA employees deployed. (COVID-19 SLB, as of Oct 30)

Nationwide Testing: 146,346,296 (+1,044,815) cumulative (COVID-19 SLB, as of Oct 30)

COVID-19 positive cases continue to increase globally COVID-19 Confirmed Cases:

United States: 8,834,393 (+90,155)Worldwide: 44,592,789 (+485,398)



- NWC, all RWCs, and MOCs are monitoring






National Weather Forecast






Severe Weather Outlook






Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall






Fire Weather Outlook






