National Current Operations and Monitoring FEMA

Significant Incidents or Threats:

- COVID-19

Tropical Activity:

- Atlantic: Hurricane Eta (CAT 1)
- Eastern Pacific: Disturbance 1: High (90%)
- Central Pacific: No new tropical cyclones expected during the next five days
- Western Pacific: No activity affecting U.S. interests

Hurricane Eta

Hurricane Eta (CAT 1) (Advisory #7A as of 7:00 a.m. ET)


- 140 miles E of Cabo Gracias a Dios, Nicaragua/Honduras border
- Moving W at 10 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 90 mph
- Hurricane force winds extend 25 miles
- Tropical storm force winds extend 125 miles






Tropical Outlook







Central Pacific

Eastern Pacific

Disturbance 1 (as of 7:00 a.m. ET)

- 700 miles S of the southern tip of the Baja California Peninsula
- Moving WNW or NW, well offshore of the coast of Mexico
- A tropical depression is likely to form during the next couple of days
- Formation chance through 48 hours: High (70%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: High (90%)

COVID-19 Update

<u>Situation:</u> Upward trajectory in COVID-19 case count continues across 49 states/territories, with 3 jurisdictions in a plateau status, and 3 jurisdictions on a downward trajectory; 1,245 (+3) FEMA employees deployed. (COVID-19 SLB, as of Oct 30)

Nationwide Testing: 146,346,296 cumulative (COVID-19 SLB, as of Oct 30)

COVID-19 positive cases continue to increase globally COVID-19 Confirmed Cases:

United States: 9,105,230 (+80,932)Worldwide: 45,942,902 (+473,311)

COVID-19 Associated Deaths:

United States: 229,932 (+823)
Worldwide: 1,192,644 (+6,578)

Response:


- NRCC conducting COVID response operations

- NWC, all RWCs, and MOCs are monitoring







