National Current Operations and Monitoring FEMA

Significant Incidents or Threats:

- Wildfires CO
- COVID-19

Tropical Activity:

- Atlantic: Tropical Storm Eta
- Eastern Pacific: Tropical Storm Odalys
- Central Pacific: No new tropical cyclones expected during the next five days
- Western Pacific: No activity affecting U.S. interests

Tropical Storm Eta

Current Situation (Advisory #15A as of 7:00 a.m. ET)


- 90 miles W of Puerto Cabezas, Nicaragua
- Moving W at 8 mph
- On the forecast track, the center of Eta is expected to move inland over northern Nicaragua through this morning, and then move across the central portions of Honduras through Thursday morning, and emerge over the northwestern Caribbean Sea Thursday on Friday
- Maximum sustained winds 60 mph
- Continued weakening will occur while Eta moves over land during the next couple of days
- Should become a tropical depression tonight
- Tropical storm force winds extend 115 miles
- Continues to produce life-threatening flash flooding over portions of Central America






Tropical Outlook

Tropical Storm Odalys (Advisory #3 as of 4:00 p.m. ET)

- 755 miles SW of southern tip of Baja California
- Moving NW at 15 mph
- Should begin weakening by Thursday; could become a remnant low by Friday
- Tropical storm force winds extend 140 miles

COVID-19 Update



<u>Situation</u>: Upward trajectory in COVID-19 case count continues across 45 (-4) states/territories, with 4 (+1) jurisdictions in a plateau status, and 7 (+3) jurisdictions on a downward trajectory; 1,253 (+8) FEMA employees deployed. (COVID-19 SLB, as of Nov 3)

Nationwide Testing: 151,056,893 (+1,115,539) cumulative (COVID-19 SLB, as of Nov 3)
