PROCLAMATION

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY COME, GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, Hoosiers can face a variety of weather risks during the winter

such as ice storms, tornado outbreaks, major flooding caused by

heavy rain, high winds and snow squalls that may occur

throughout the state; and

WHEREAS, Indiana has experienced winter storms of such magnitude that

federal assistance was required multiple times; and

WHEREAS, the Indiana Department of Homeland Security, American Red

Cross, National Weather Service, other state and local partners and emergency personnel work to warn, care for and protect Hoosiers affected by the elements, clear the roads and restore any

disruption of utility services caused by storms; and

WHEREAS, all Hoosiers are encouraged to learn and prepare for weather-

related risks that occur in the winter;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Eric J. Holcomb, Governor of the State of Indiana, do hereby proclaim November 8-14, 2020 as

WINTER WEATHER PREPAREDNESS WEEK

in the State of Indiana, and invite all citizens to duly note this occasion.
