

Seattle artist Janelle Abbott is creating a piece for the Wallingford site (see sketch above). If you have a t-shirt in your drawer that is rarely worn, consider donating it to her art! No matter where you live, you are welcome to make a contribution. Here's how:

- 1. Take a video of yourself holding your t-shirt and tell the story of the garment/why this t-shirt is meaningful to you.
- 2. Email your video to: jratzerowaste@gmail.com. We may share your video on social media or our project website. If you wish your video to remain private, please let us know.
- 3. Cut from the hem to the armhole or sleeve hem on one side seam of the t-shirt then cut widthwise into roughly 2" wide strips. Precision is NOT necessary!
- 4. Package the t-shirt strips in a clean plastic bag and tape shut. Travel to your local USPS and mail it to: PO BOX 31727 Seattle WA 98103. Please clearly mark your name or email address on the package!
- 5. Have material scraps leftover? Donate them to Threadcycle!
