




Tropical Outlook – Five Day



- 5-day formation chance: Low (20%)


Disturbance 2 (as of 1:00 a.m. ET)




National Weather Forecast






Severe Weather Outlook







Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall





Fire Weather Outlook




