- 5. Motion to proceed with voting for President and Vice President in order.
- 6. Chairperson appoints two electors to serve as tellers and directs that ballots be distributed to all electors.
- 7. Electors cast ballots for President and Vice President to be canvassed by tellers.
- 8. Chairperson announces the results of the vote.
- 9. Certificates of Votes Cast are signed by all voting electors.
- 10. Meeting adjourns.
