Winter Storm- Preparation

Situation:

A major winter storm will significantly impact much of the Mid-Atlantic to New England beginning today through tomorrow; heavy snowfall up to 24 inches is forecast for parts of the Northeast and a large area of freezing rain is possible through much of the interior Mid-Atlantic into the Appalachians.

Potential Impacts:

Dangerous travel, significant power outages and disruption to mass transit








FEMA Response:

 - FEMA RIII RWC will telework starting at 6:30 p.m. ET tonight National Watch Center


National Weather Forecast







Severe Weather Outlook






Forecast Snowfall


