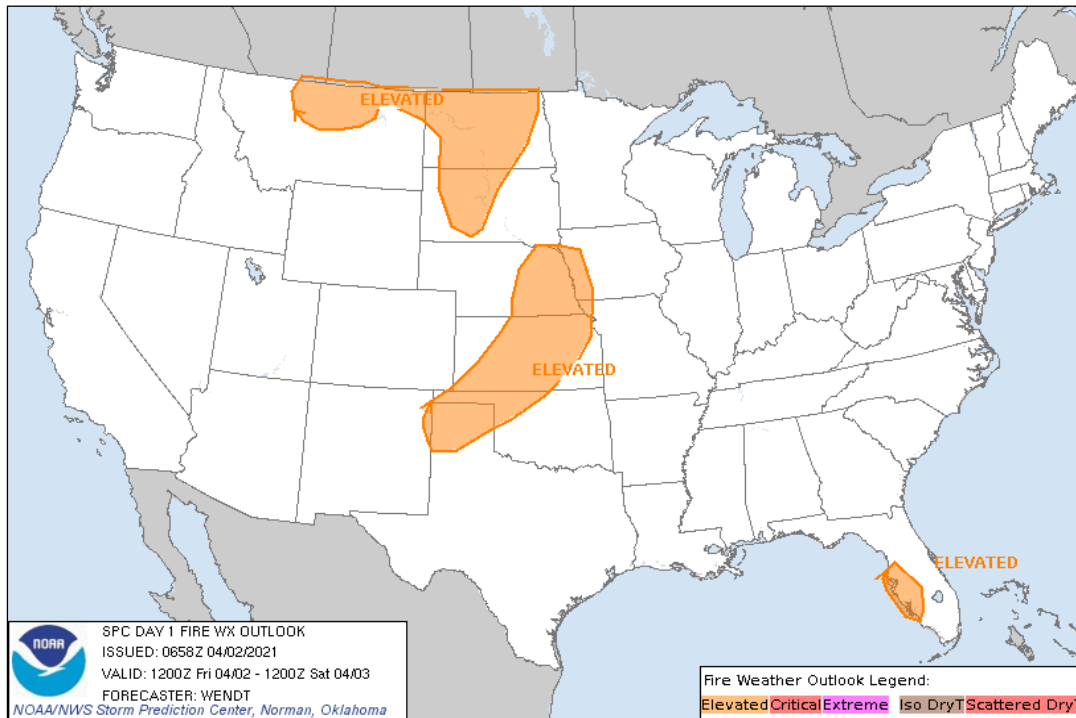
National Weather Forecast



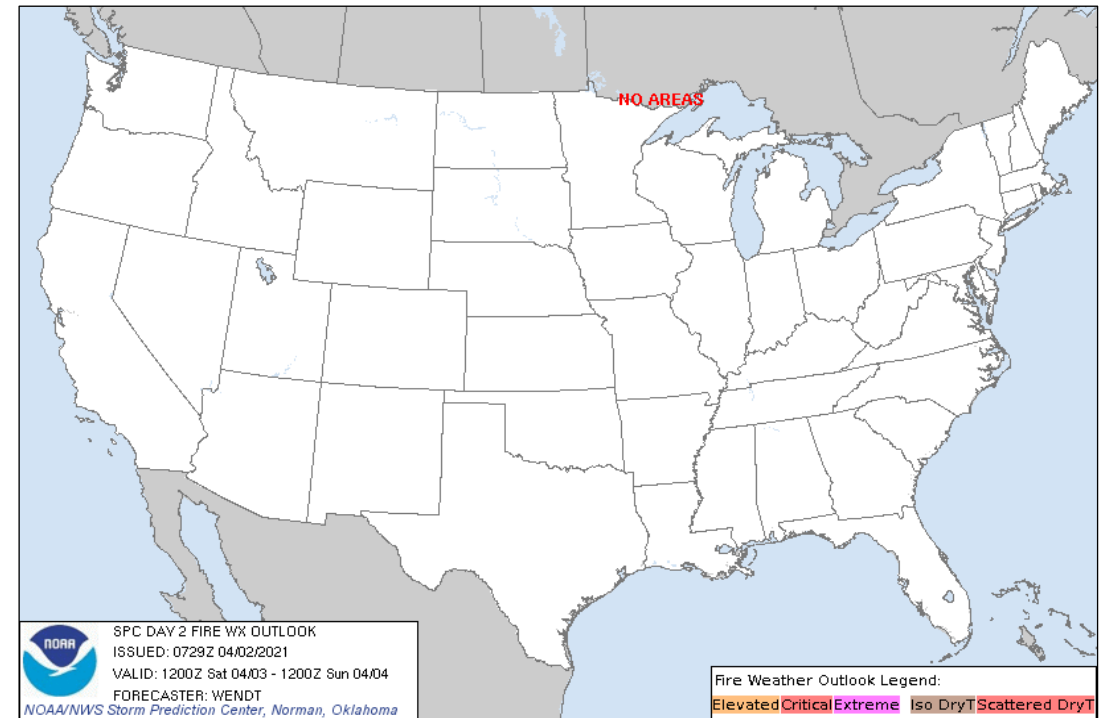

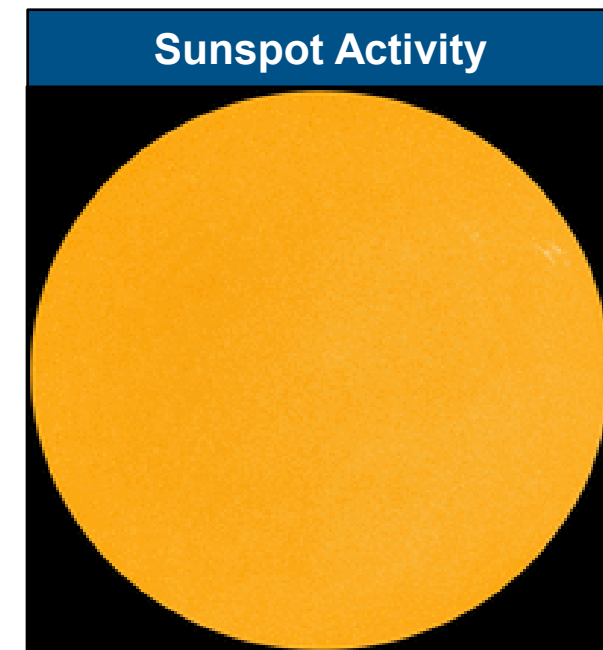
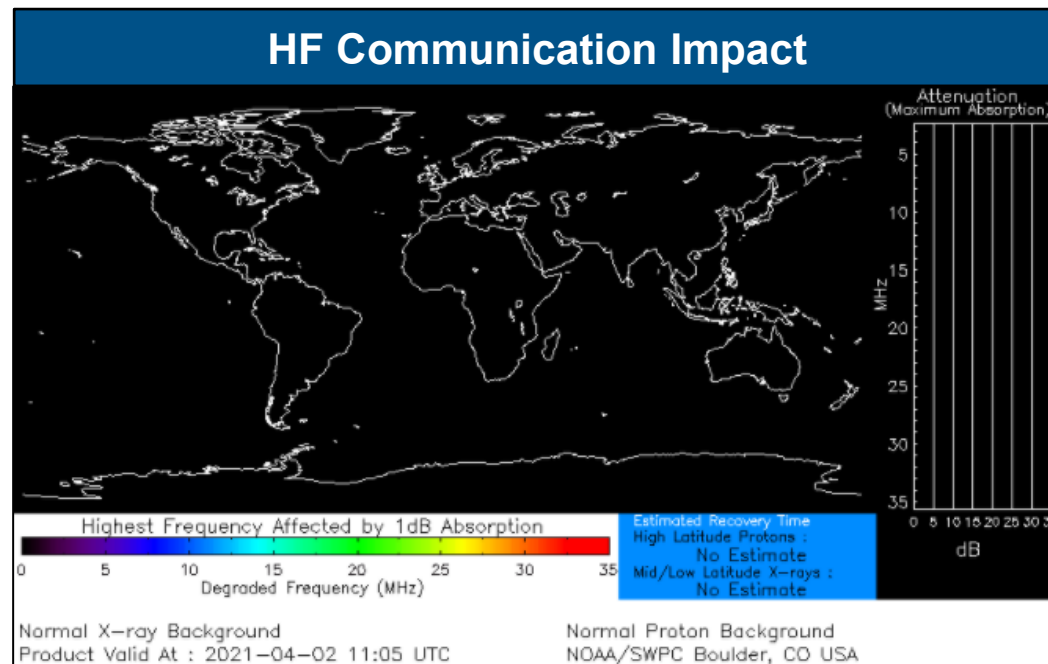
Hazards Outlook – Apr 4 - 8

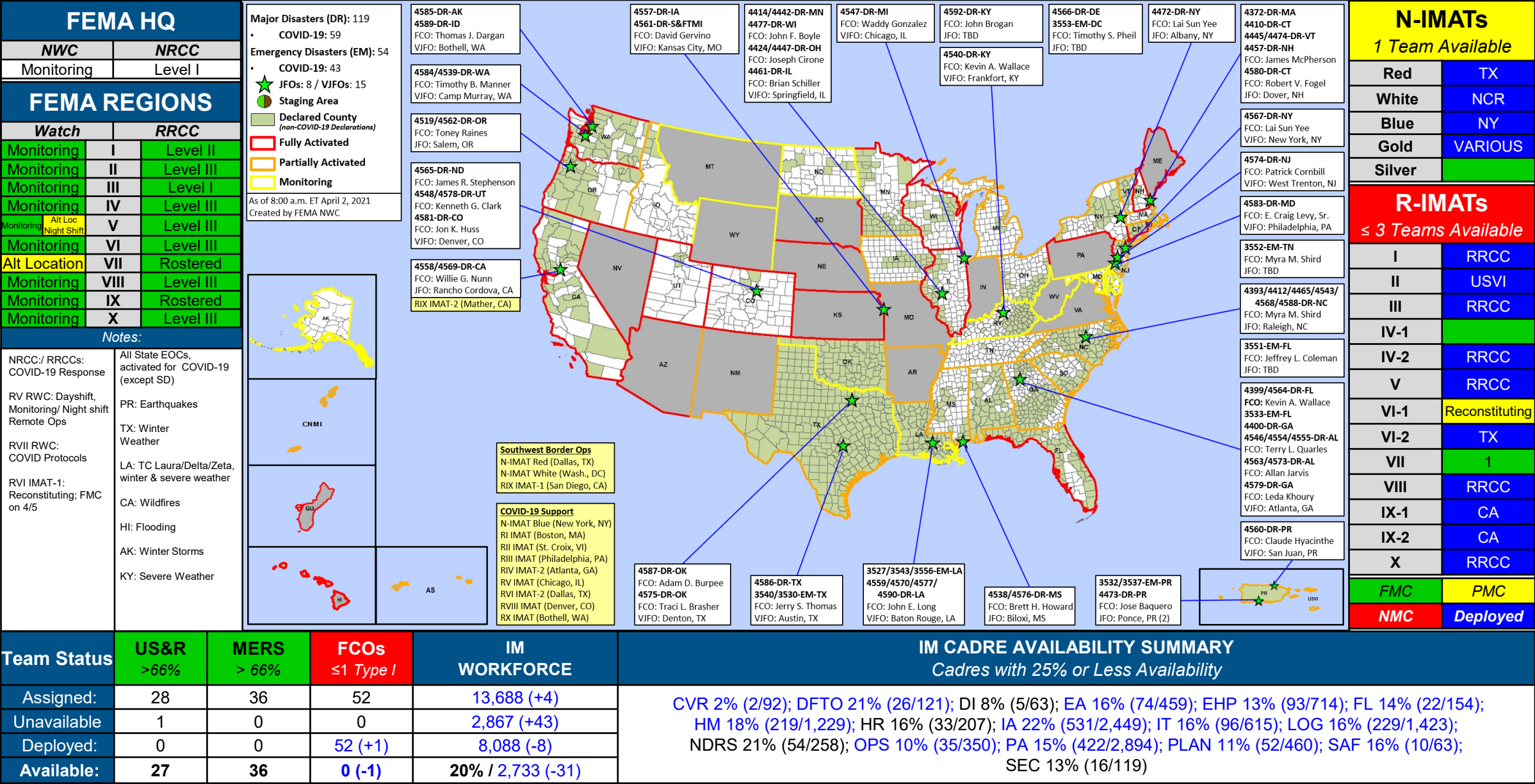
