- Approved: FMAG – AZ

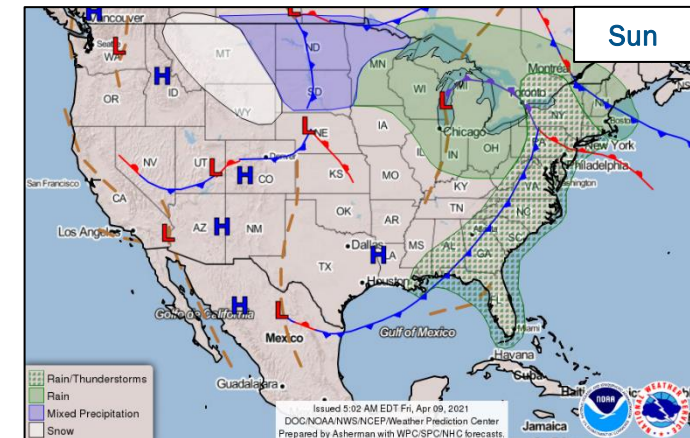
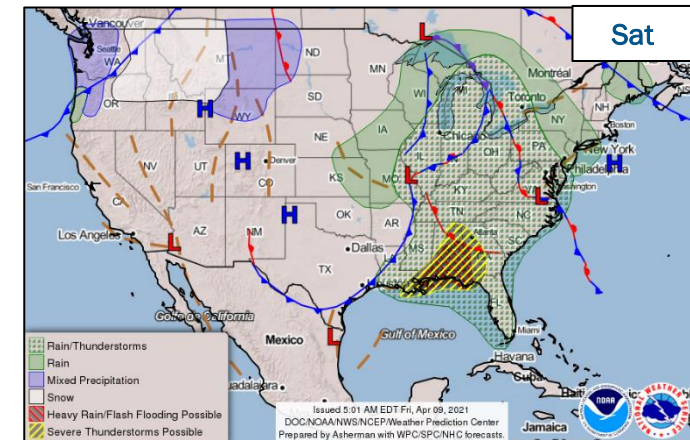
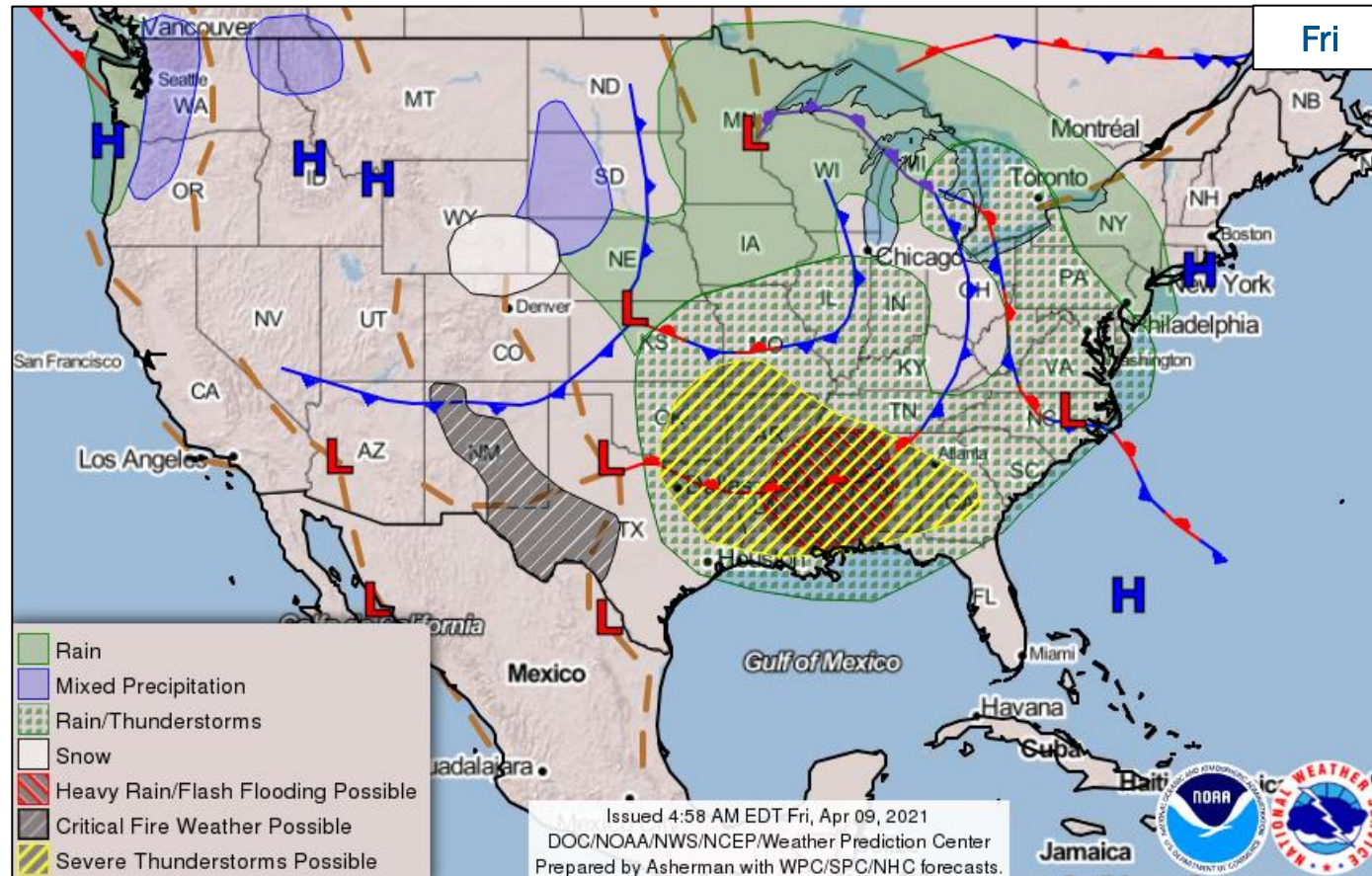

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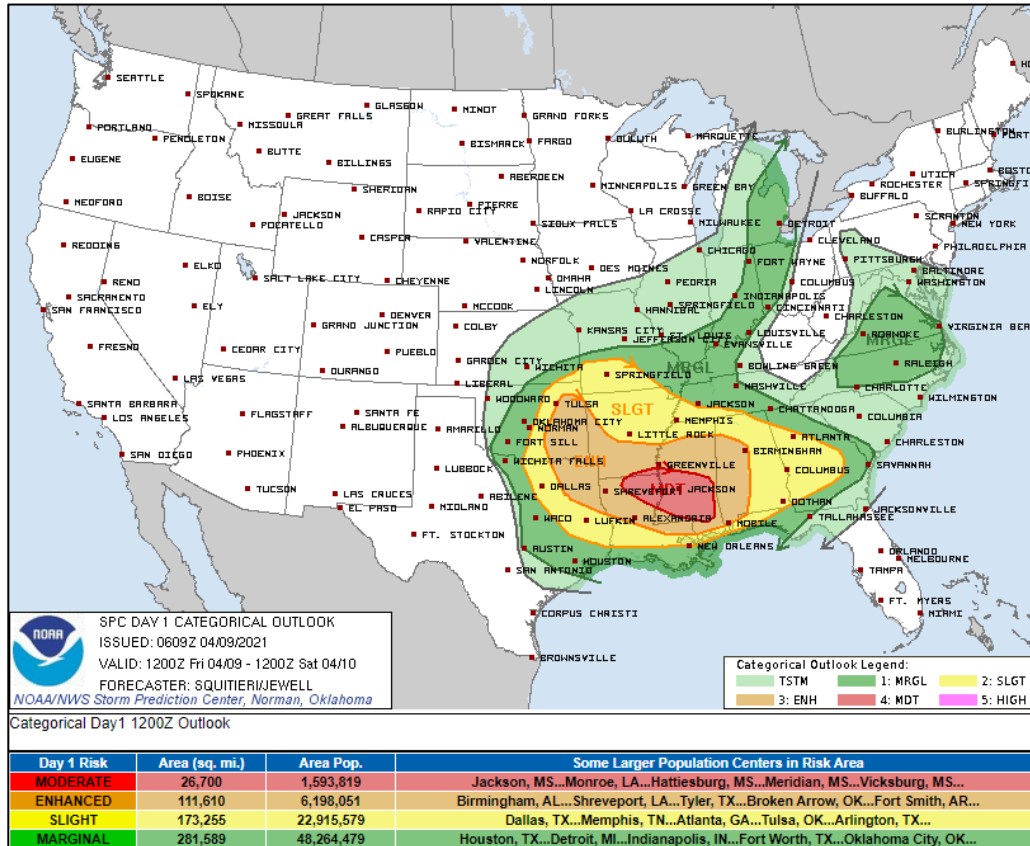
Severe Weather Outlook



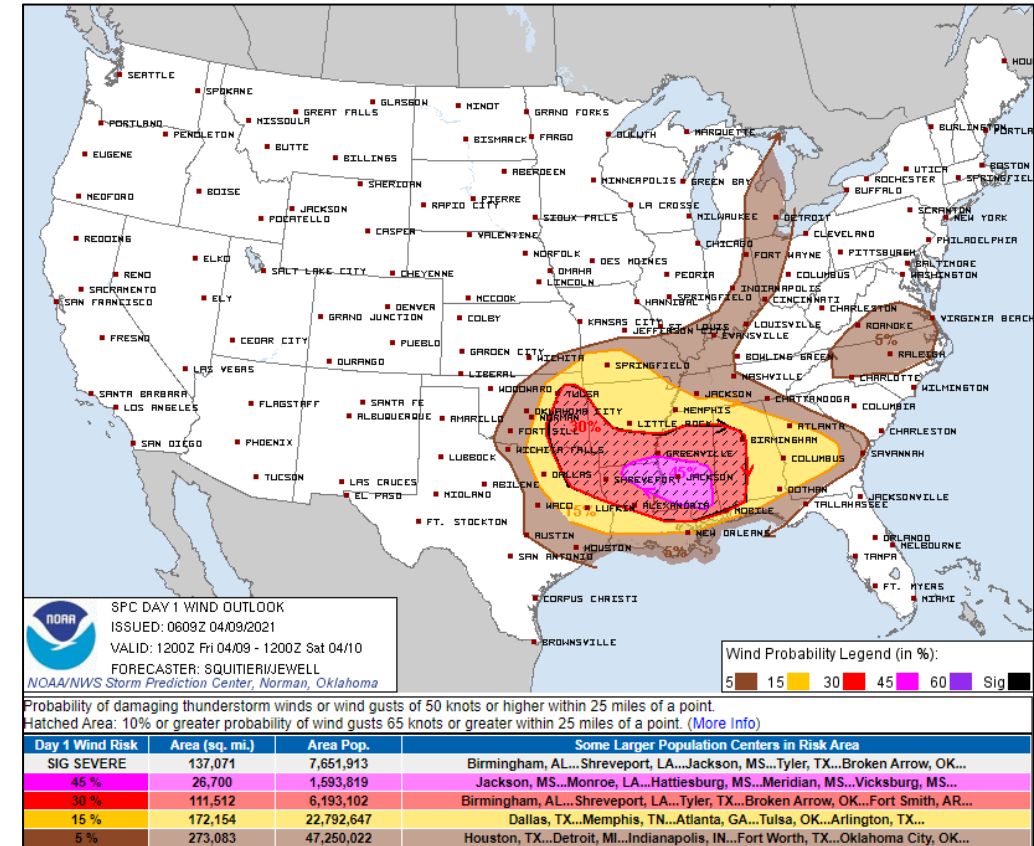
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Severe Weather Outlook



Categorical Outlook



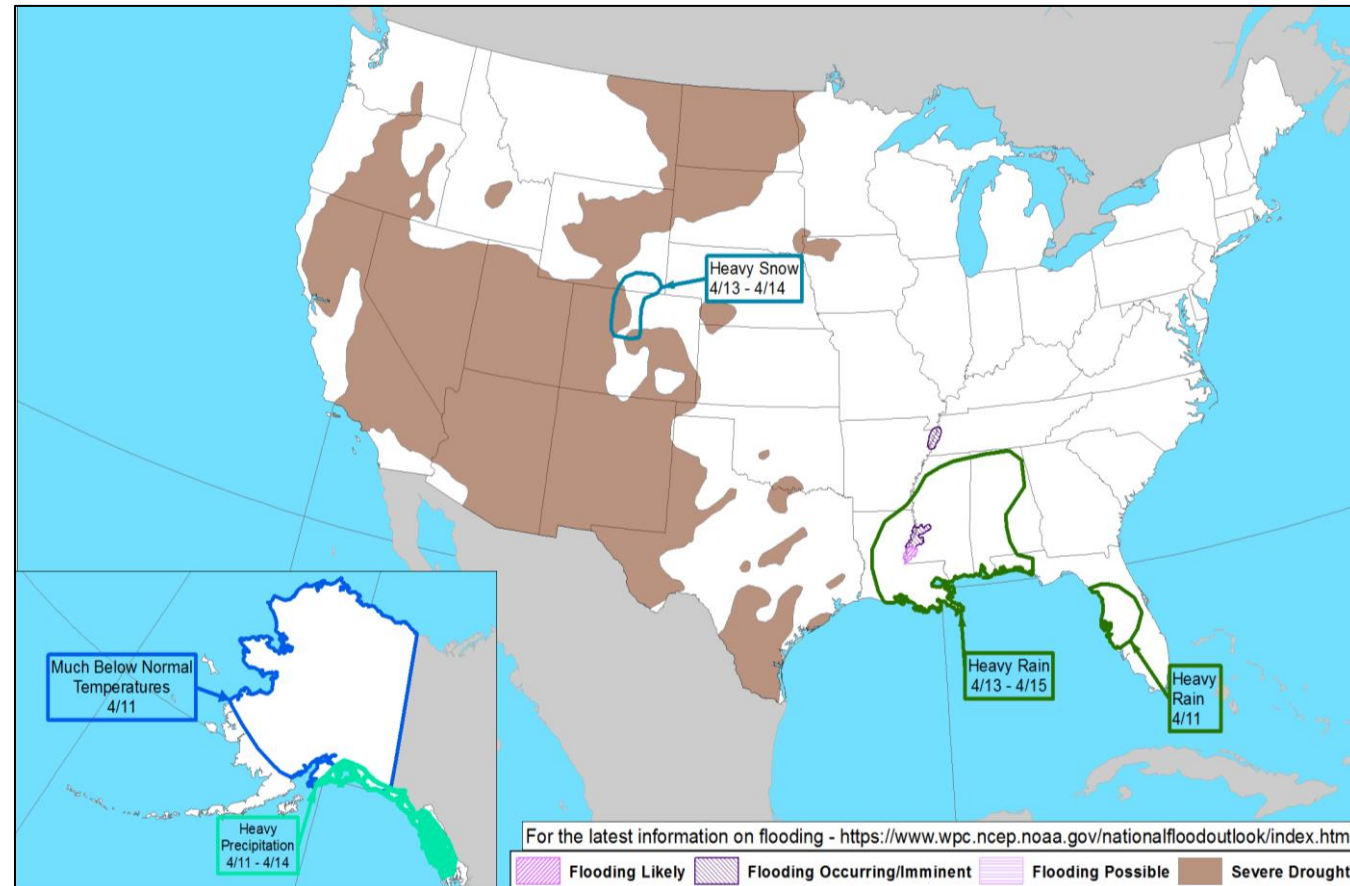
Winds Outlook



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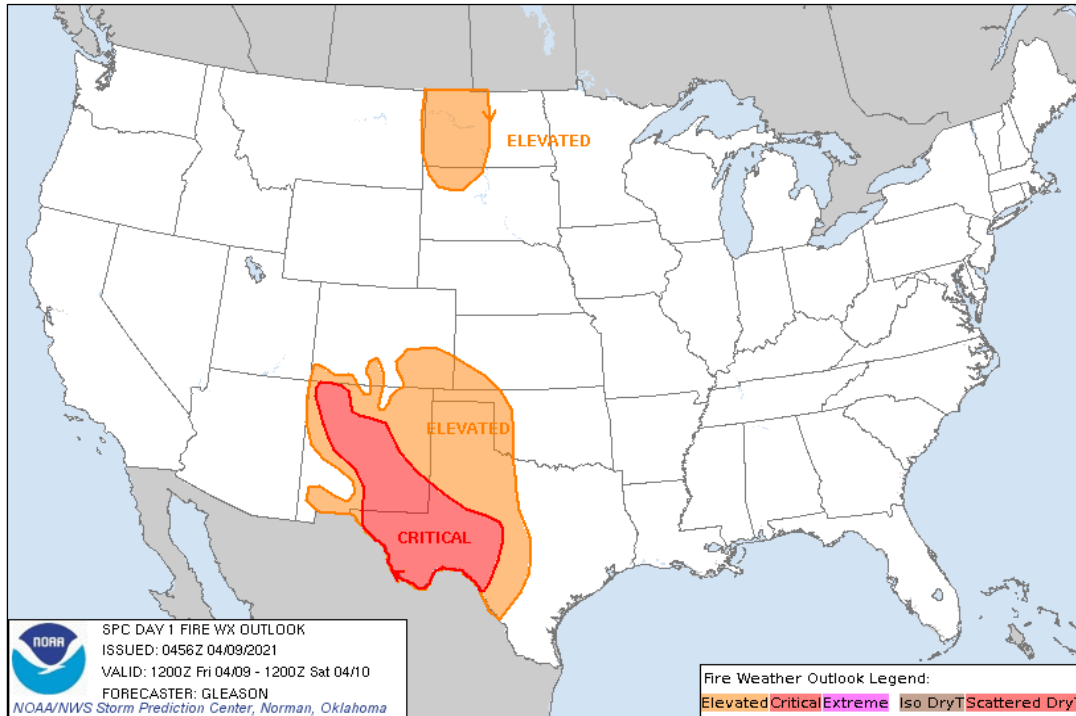

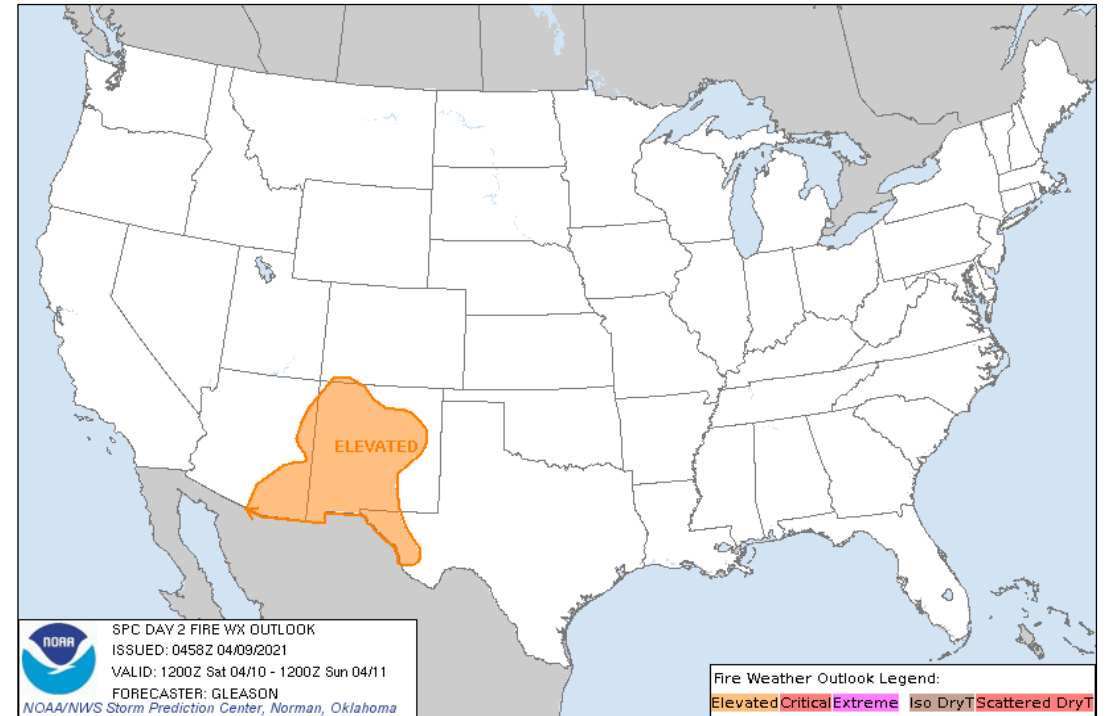

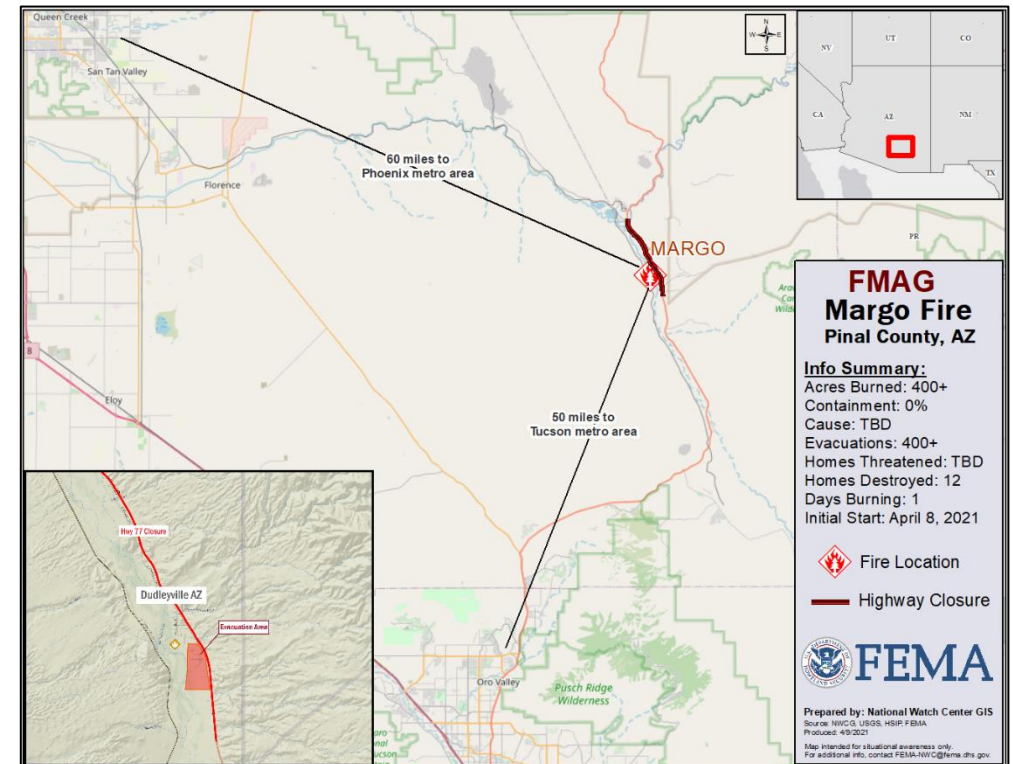

Situation:

- The fire began on April 8 burning on state and local land in and around Dudleyville, Arizona (pop. 1,068)
- Threatening 400 homes and power lines
- Mandatory evacuations in effect
- Road closures in effect including state Route 77
- No CVCs threatened

Response:

- FMAG approved April 8
- AZ EOC at Full Activation (COVID-19)
- Region IX and NWC continue to monitor; IMATs reconstituting

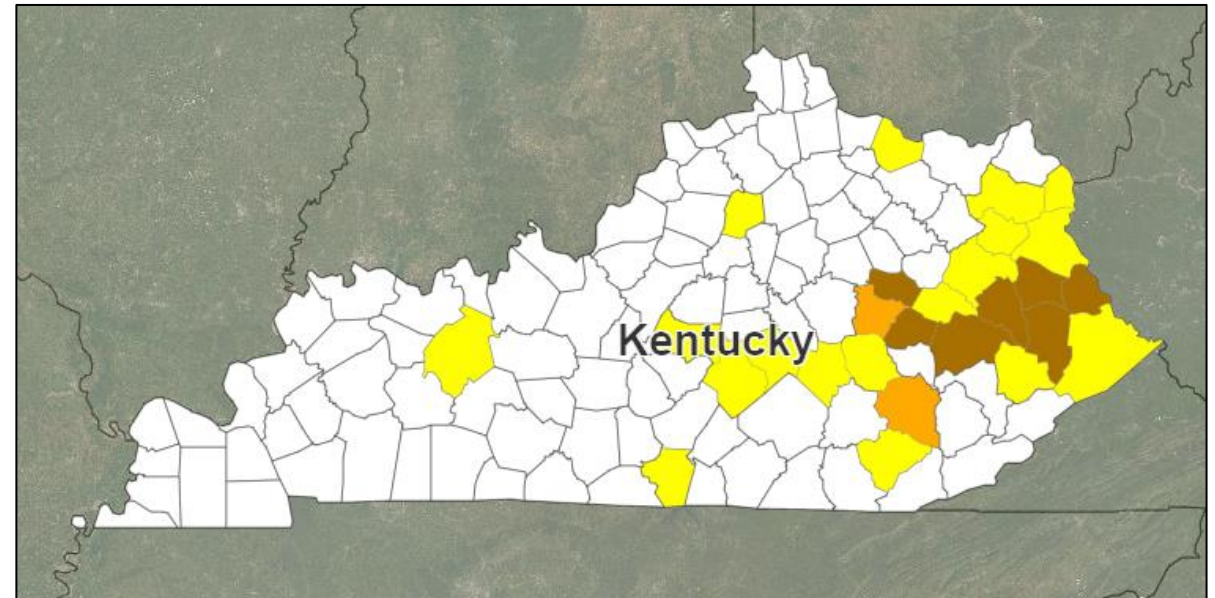

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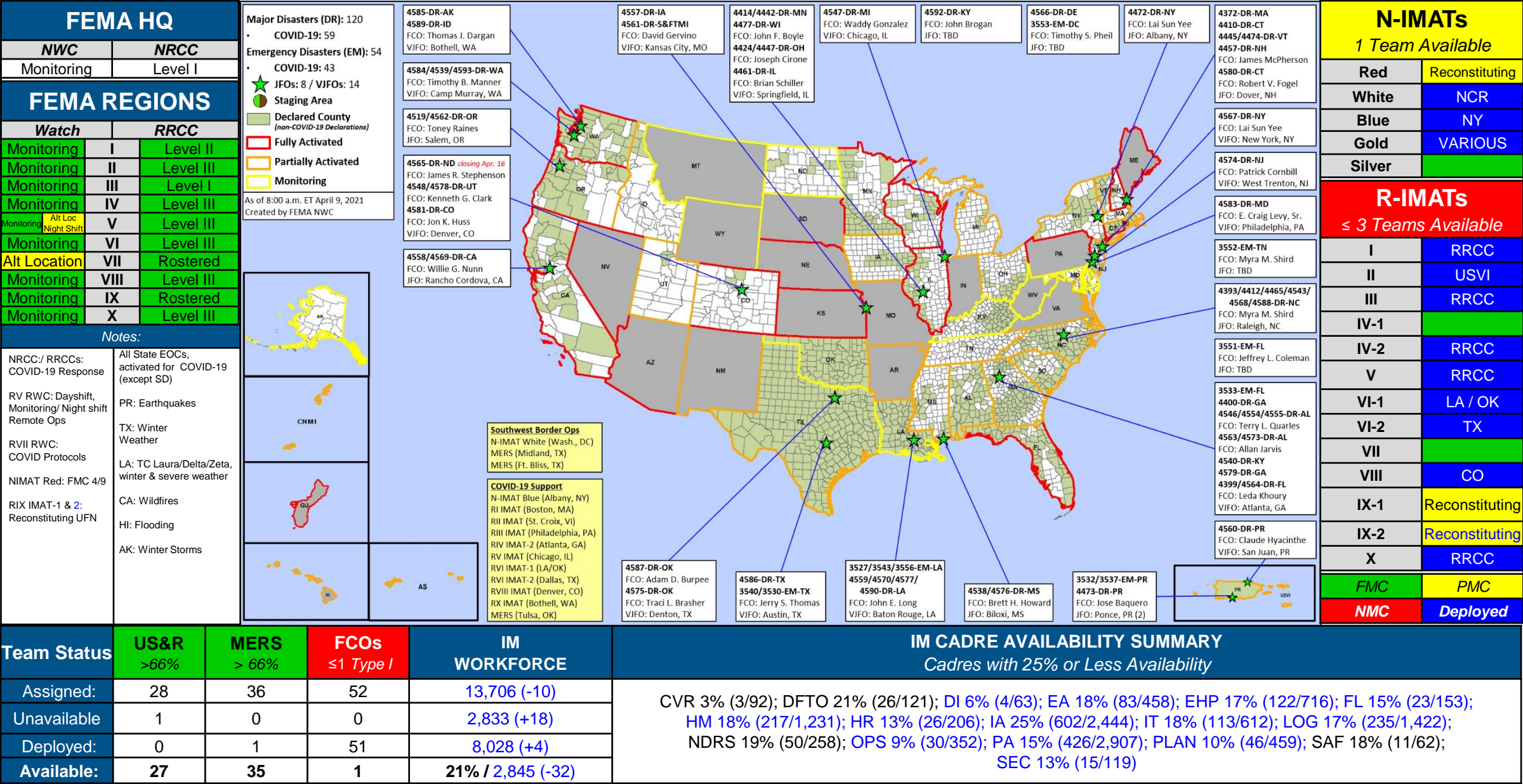
