Colonial Pipeline Cyber-Attack

<u>Current Situation</u>: As of 4:40 p.m. May 13, Colonial Pipeline completed restart of the entire pipeline system and commenced product delivery to all markets served by Colonial; decline of gasoline outages expected over the weekend as Colonial resupplies terminals. Currently there are no requests for FEMA assistance.


- (May 12/13) two vessels arrived in Baltimore, MD, and Norfolk, VA (DOE, SITREP #8 5/15/2021)
- (May 14) 370,000 barrels of gasoline arrived in Yorktown, VA
- Citgo plans to move 200,000 barrels of jet fuel, gasoline, and ultra-low sulfer diesel from Lake Charles,
 LA to Linden, NJ (DOE, SITREP #8 5/15/2021)
- (May 14) Eight fuel barges enroute to Nashville, TN; additional 16 barges scheduled for next weekend (DOE, SITREP #8 5/15/2021)
- (Expected arrival May 18/19) One fuel barge enroute to Nashville, TN, via Hernando de Soto Bridge I-40 on the Mississippi River (DOE, SITREP #8 5/15/2021)

State / Local Response:

- FL and PA at Full Activation (COVID-19)
- AL, AR, DC, GA, MS, NC, NJ, NY, SC, TN, TX, and VA EOCs at Partial Activation (COVID-19)
- DE, KY, LA, MD EOC are Monitoring (COVID-19)
- The Governors of FL, GA, VA, & NC have declared States of Emergency


FEMA / Federal Response Actions and Waivers:

- The FEMA NRCC and Regions II, III, IV, and VI RRCCs are activated for COVID-19
- White House waived the Jones Act to allow foreign tankers to transport fuel (FEMA RIV, 5/14/21)
- Department of Transportation Actions:
 - Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration issued a Regional Emergency Declaration for AL, AR, DC, DE, FL, GA, KY, LA, MD, MS, NJ, NY, NC, PA, SC, TN, TX, WV, and VA
 - o AL, GA, KT, LA, MD, MS, NJ, NC, TN, and VA may issue special permits to vehicles delivering relief supplies including petroleum products
- PA waiver issued alleviating Reformulated and conventional gasoline volatility for DC, MD, PA, AL, DE, GA, FL, LA, MS, NC, SC, and TN





Severe Weather Outlook







Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall





Fire Weather Outlook









