

#### Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)


- 1,000 miles SSW of southern tip of Baja California peninsula
- Moving W at 5-10 mph
- Some slow development is possible next few days
- 48-hour formation chance: Low (20%)
- 5-day formation chance: Low (30%)

#### Disturbance 2 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Several hundred miles S of Acapulco, Mexico
- Moving W to WNW at 10 mph
- Gradual development possible next several days
- 48-hour formation chance: Low (20%)
- 5-day formation chance: Medium (50%)




# **Tropical Outlook - Western Pacific**



#### Invest 90W (as of 2:00 a.m. ET)

- 715 miles SE of Guam
- Moving WNW at 7 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 20-26 mph
- May pass close to Guam as a tropical depression early next week and bring heavy rainfall over Guam
- 24-hour formation chance: High




#### *Invest 99W* (as of 2:00 a.m. ET)

- 24-hour formation chance: Medium


