

#### Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)


- 500 miles SSW of Acapulco, Mexico
- Moving WNW to W at 10 mph
- Conditions conducive for a tropical depression to form at any time during the next couple of days
- 48-hour formation chance: High (80%)
- 5-day formation chance: High (90%)

#### **Disturbance 2** (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- 1,100 miles SW of southern tip of Baja California Peninsula
- Moving W at 5-10 mph
- Little, if any, further development expected
- 48-hour formation chance: Low (10%)
- 5-day formation chance: Low (10%)




### **Tropical Outlook - Western Pacific**



#### Tropical Depression 04W (Warning #3 as of 5:00 a.m. ET)


- 110 miles N of Sonsorol, Republic of Palau; 945 miles WSW of Guam
- Moving W at 13 mph; expected to turn NW overnight and continue on this track through at least Tuesday
- Maximum sustained winds 35 mph
- Will likely become a tropical storm on Monday



- 512 miles SW of Guam
- Moving NW
- Maximum sustained winds 17-23 mph
- 24-hour formation chance: High






### **Severe Weather Outlook**






# **Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall**






# Long Range Outlooks – Jun 4 - 8



6-10 Day Temperature Probability




6-10 Day Precipitation Probability




