### **Vocational Rehabilitation Services**

Through the NC Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS), Vocation Rehabilitation (VR) is a state program that helps people with physical, sensory, mental, emotional, or learning disabilities find, get, or keep a job. Find out more information about VR services by visiting the state's website. There is an application to determine eligibility for VR services and they are not managed by the school IEP team but can work with the team on setting and accomplishing goals. #### **Pre-Employment Transition Services**

One of the services DHHS offers is called Pre-Employment Transition Services (Pre-ETS). This program is offered at no cost to the students who are eligible for special education-related services, are between ages 14-24, and enrolled in traditional/alternative secondary or postsecondary program. The purpose of the program is to provide assistance with identifying disability-related barriers to employment through a Needs Assessment and creating a plan to achieve employment-related goals. The school IEP team will discuss and obtain permission from a parent before making a referral for Pre-ETS, or any VR service. The school IEP team is not responsible for VR services or implementation of the VR plan but can work collaboratively, with permission, with the agency for the benefit of the student. Talk to your IEP team to learn if Pre-ETS is appropriate for your child. Start the discussion early, age 14, to allow the most benefit for the child.
