## New Significant Incidents / Ongoing Ops

- COVID-19

## Hazard Monitoring

- Heavy rain and flash flooding possible – southern Texas, Mid-Atlantic, and Northeast
- Severe thunderstorms possible – Mid-Atlantic to the Northeast
- Elevated fire weather and isolated dry thunderstorms – Central Great Basin, Northern Intermountain, and Northern Plains
- Tropical Activity:
  - Eastern Pacific: [Tropical Depression Blanca](#); [Disturbance 1](#)

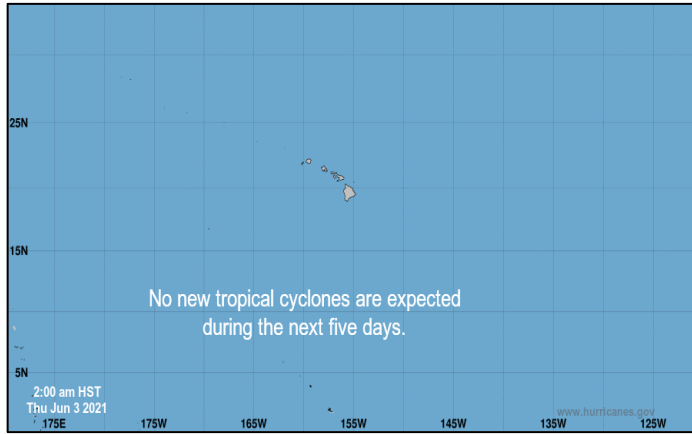

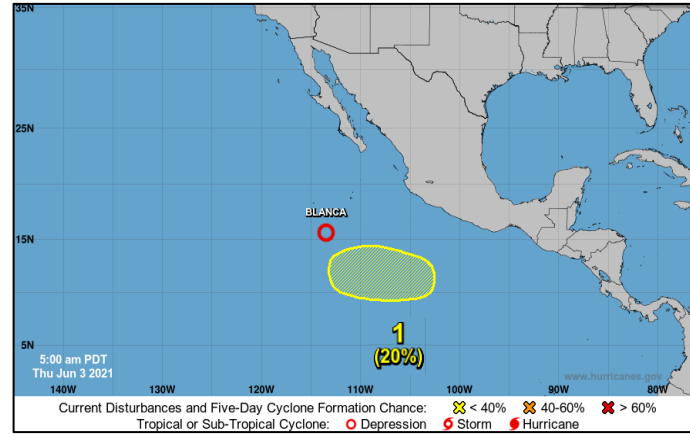

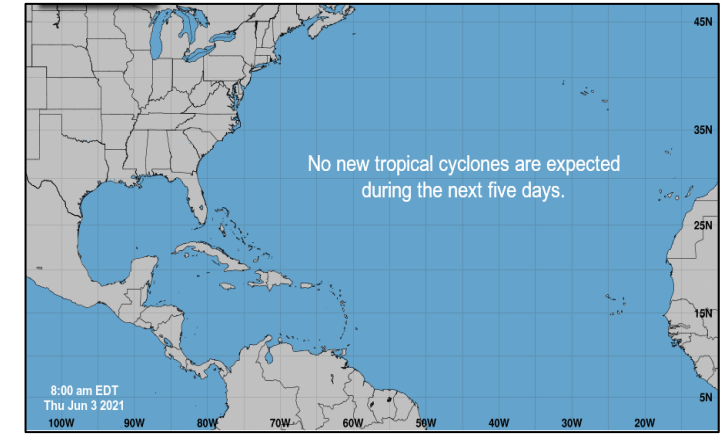

### Tropical Depression Blanca (as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

- 555 miles SSW of the southern tip of Baja California, Mexico
- Moving W at 5 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 35 mph
- Likely to degenerate into a remnant low later today or tonight

### Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

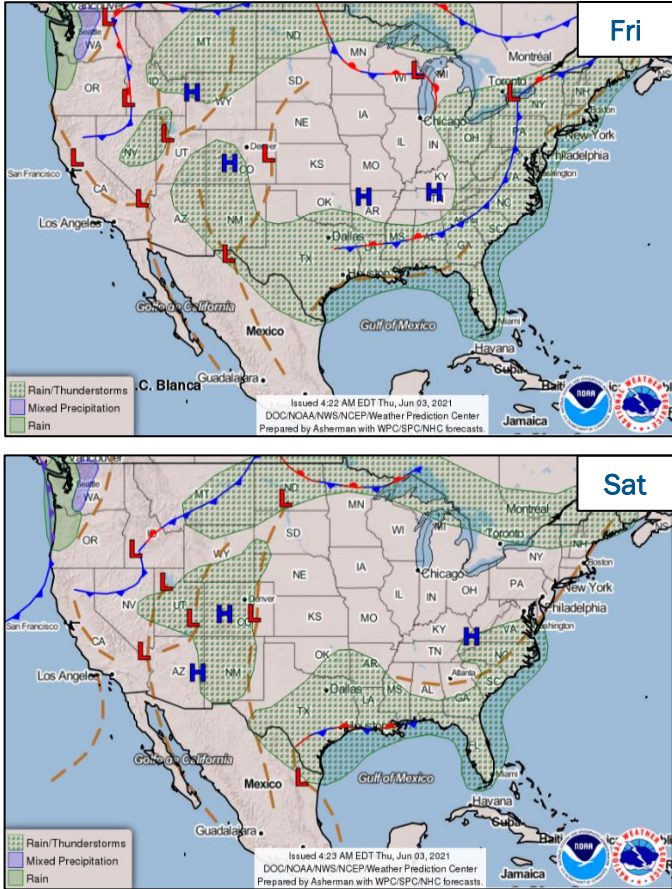
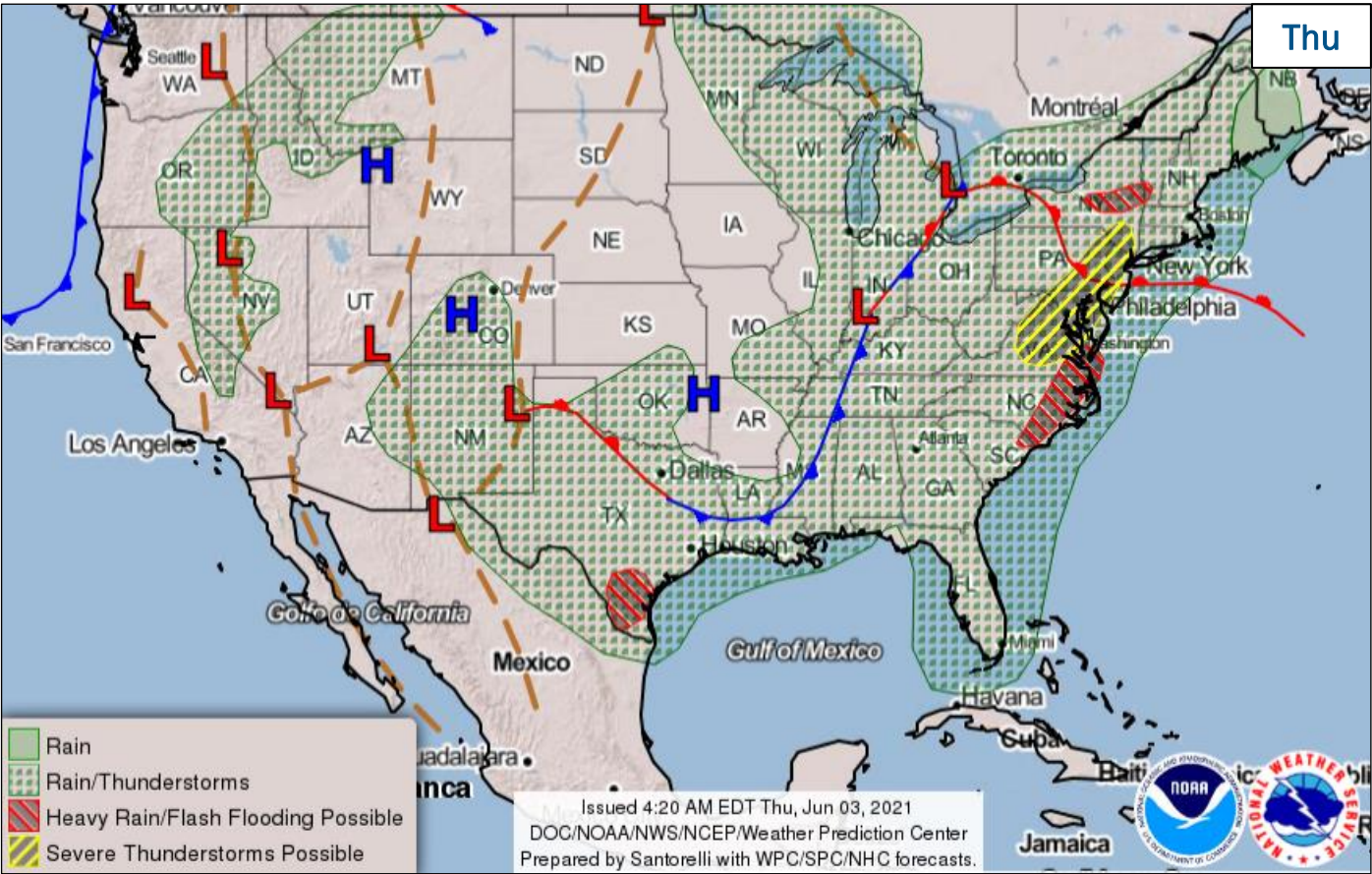
- Expected to form several hundred miles offshore of the SW coast of Mexico
- Gradual development possible early next week
- 48-hour formation chance: Low (near 0%)
- 5-day formation chance: Low (20%)

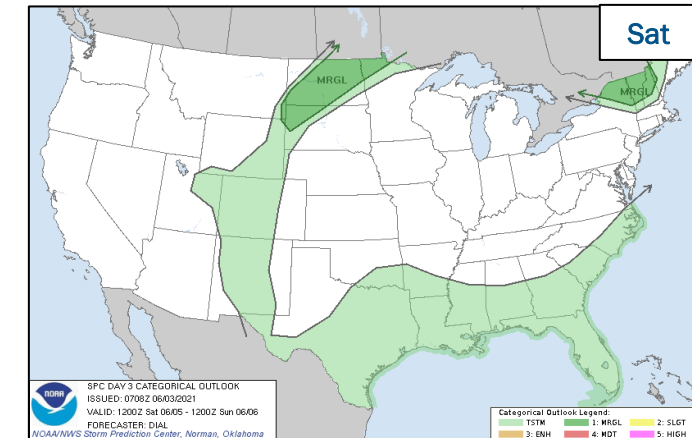
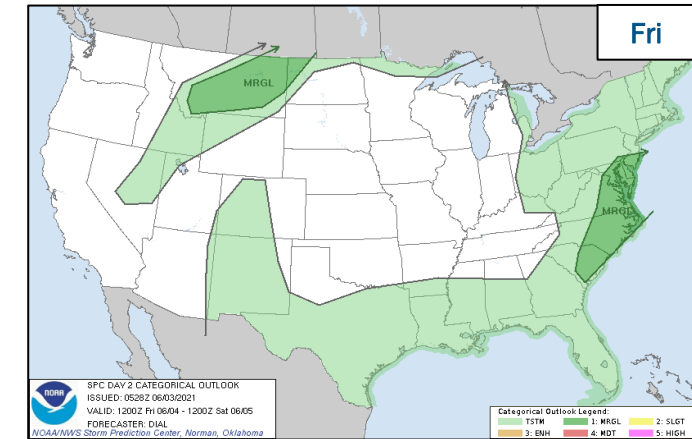
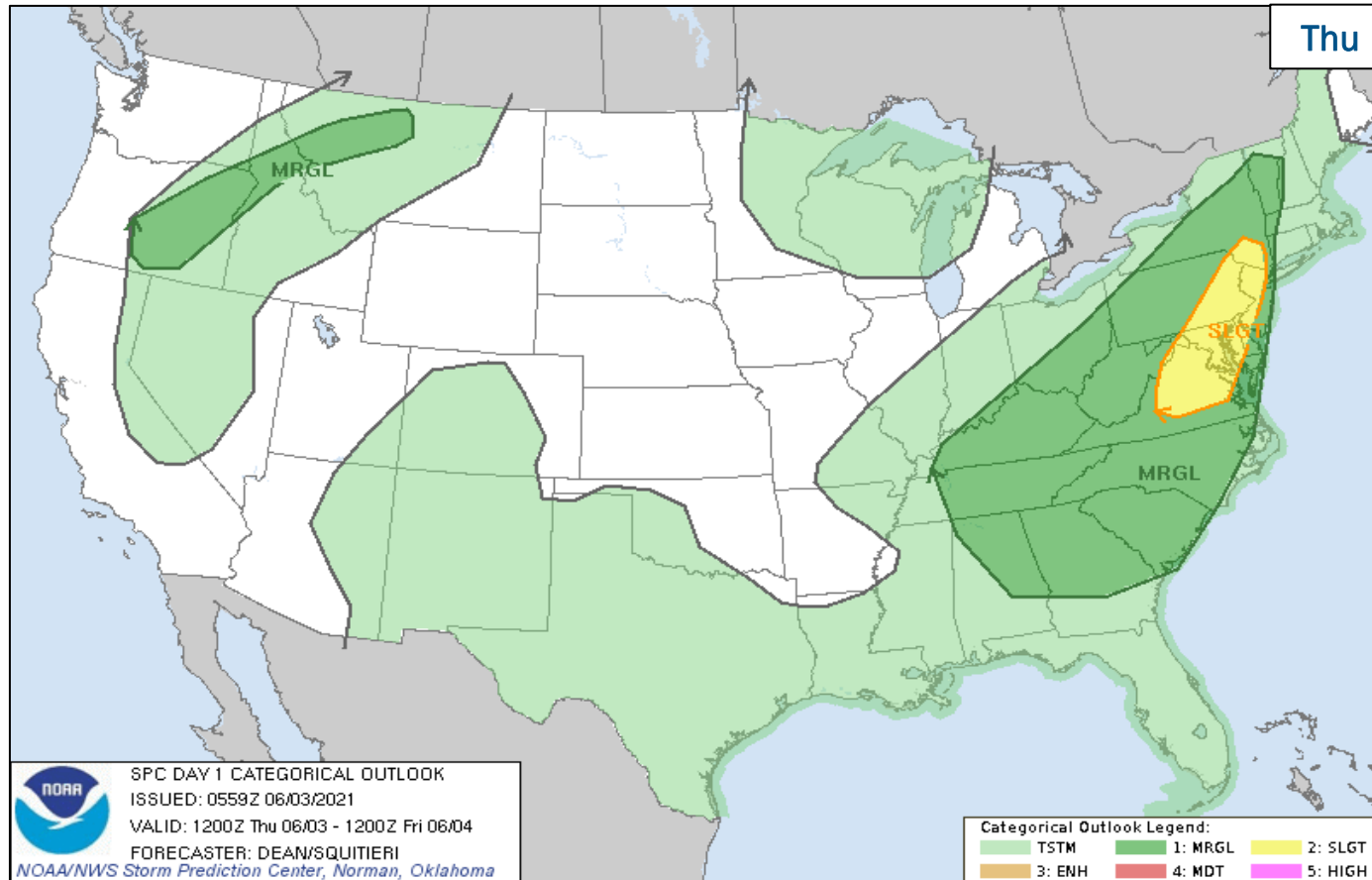

# Severe Weather Outlook

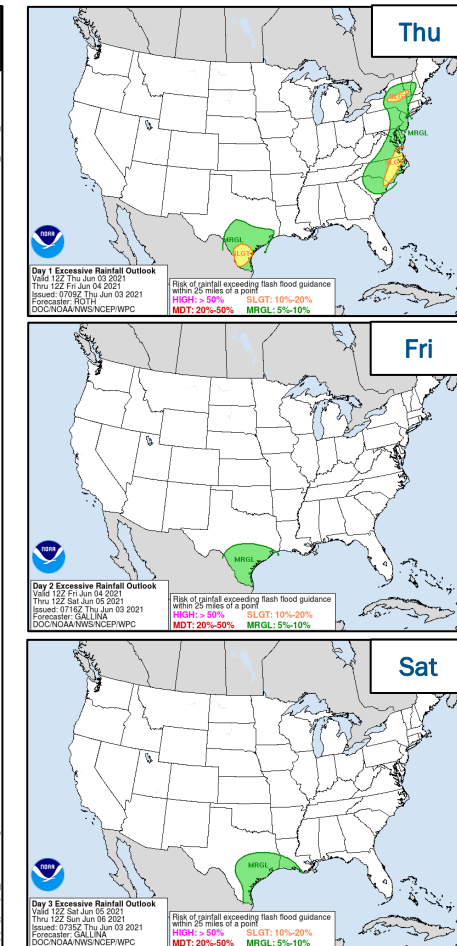
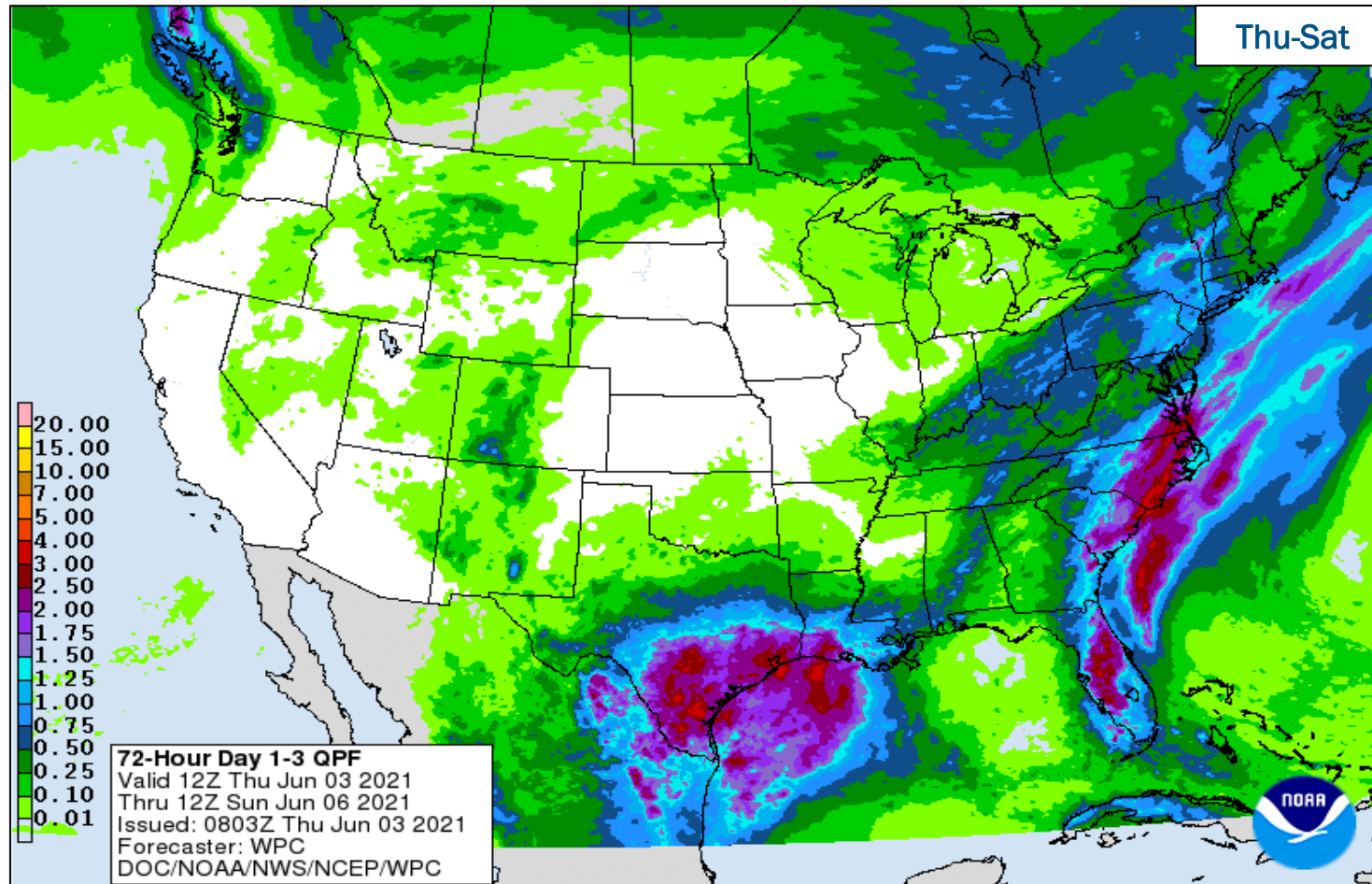

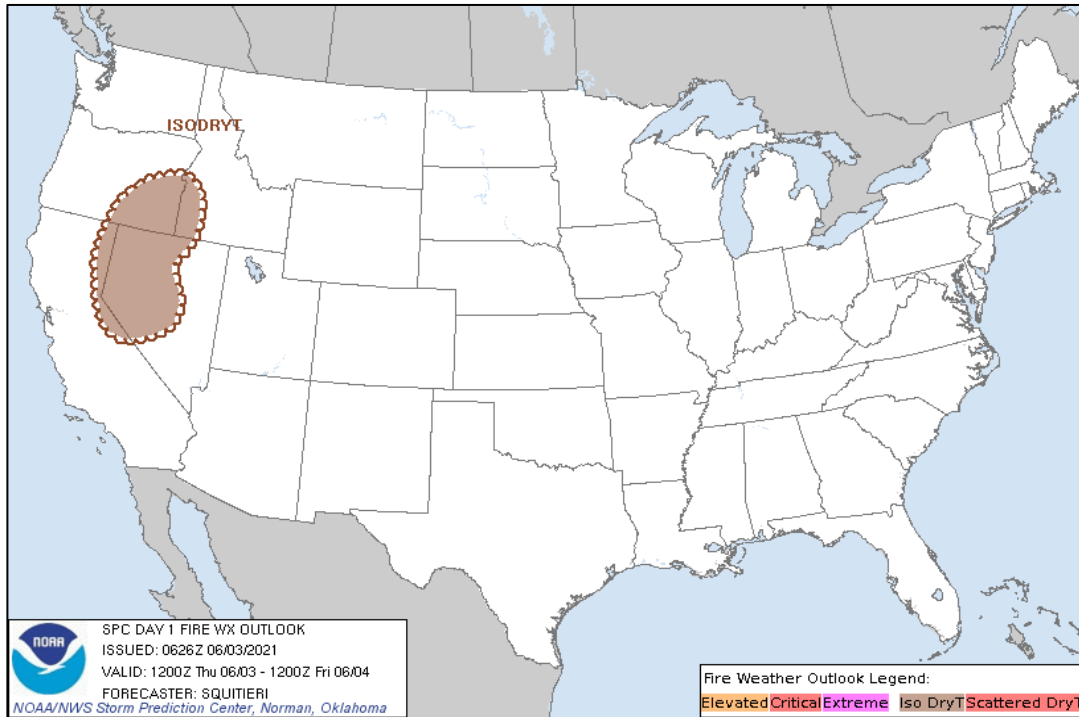


# Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall

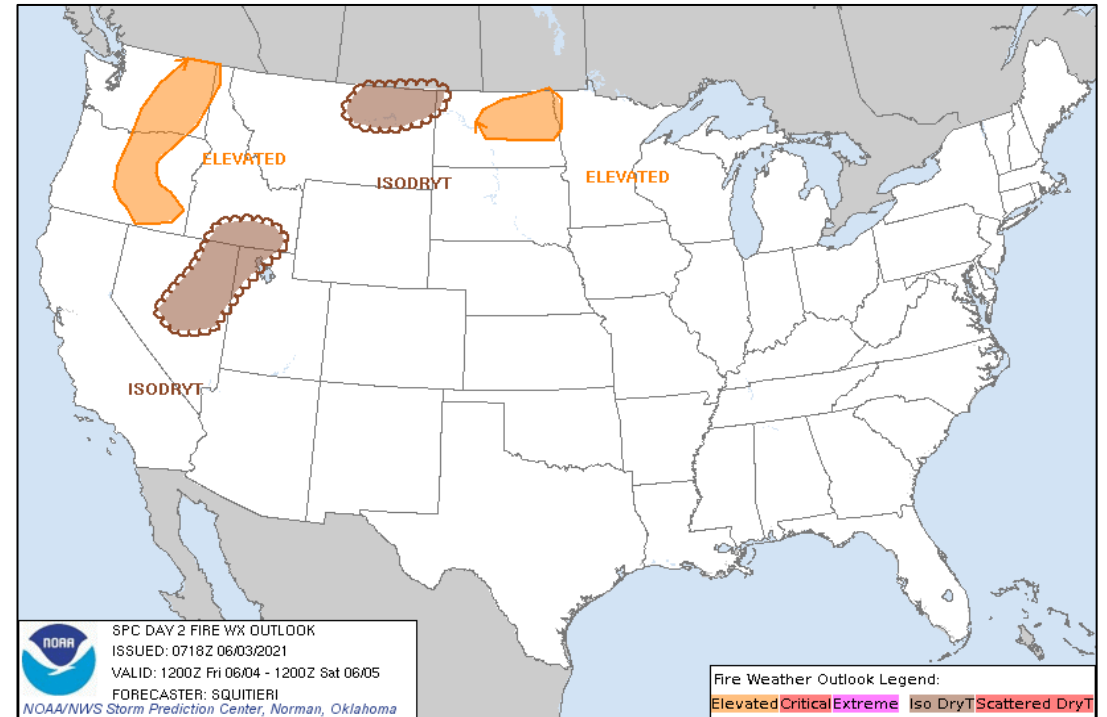
