


## **Tropical Outlook – Five Day**

### **Eastern Pacific**




#### Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Expected to form later this week a couple of hundred miles offshore of the coast of southwestern Mexico
- Moving slowly NW, parallel to the southwestern coast of Mexico
- Conditions are conducive for gradual development, and a tropical depression could form by this weekend
- 48-hour formation chance: Low (near 0%)
- 5-day formation chance: Medium (40%)

### <u>Tropical Depression Carlos</u> (Advisory #11 as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

- 1,700 miles WSW of the southern tip of Baja California
- Moving WSW at 12 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 35 mph
- Slow weakening is expected over the next couple of days, and Carlos is forecast to degenerate to a remnant low by tonight

### **Atlantic**



#### Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)


- Located over the Bay of Campeche
- Should begin to move N by midweek
- Tropical depression likely to form late in the week
- Heavy rains could begin to impact portions of the northern Gulf Coast on Friday
- 48-hour formation chance: Low (20%)
- 5-day formation chance: High (70%)

#### Disturbance 2 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Several hundred miles S of Cabo Verde Islands
- Any development should be slow to occur during next few days
- 48-hour formation chance: Low (10%)
- 5-day formation chance: Low (10%)






