#### HB317 Data Collection

The HB317 Data collection is underway and continues to be due by July 16, 2021. Of all the student surveys sent out this year, 49% have been completed, 24% are in progress, leaving 27% that have yet to be started. If your district has surveys in progress or have not yet been started, Tom Page will be sending an email as a reminder. If you have questions or need assistance, please let Tom or your regional Consultant for Deaf or Hard of Hearing know as soon as possible. Every student survey needs to be completed, even students for whom you have little to no data (e.g., moved out of district, unknown, etc.). For students like these, you will only need to answer a few initial questions to update us regarding their status this year, but it's important that all students who are eligible as Deaf (DF) or Hearing Impaired (HI) are accounted for.

## LEA Self-Assessment (LEASA)

**The full LEASA will not be a required submission for the 2020-2021 school year.** This is due to COVID related barriers concerning the implementation of the 2020 LEASA improvement plans, the timing of our new State Performance Plan (to be submitted to OSEP February 1, 2022), and skewed data sets.

For the **2020-2021** school year, LEAs will be required to:

- review your 2020 improvement plan
- revise the 2020 improvement plan as needed, based on review and analysis of your LEA's current/data situation
- submit a revised <u>2021 improvement plan</u> (submission portal to open August 1) by October 31, 2021; if no revisions are made, please provide a data-based rationale for maintaining the 2020 plan as written
