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Partial Building Collapse – Surfside, FL

Current Situation: On Thursday morning, June 24th, a partial building collapse occurred at the 13-story Champlain Towers South condominiums in Surfside, FL. A multi-jurisdictional Search and Rescue response operation is ongoing.

Lifeline Impacts: (FEMA Region IV)

Safety & Security:

- 72 of the 156 units were involved in the collapse; remaining structure is compromised
- 150 (-2) individuals remain unaccounted for

Food, Water, Shelter

- Residents in unaffected portions of the structure have been evacuated
- ARC using 16 (-1) hotels rooms to sheltering of 33 (-6) survivors (ARC Midnight Shelter Count as of 7:00 a.m. ET, June 29)

Health & Medical

- 11 (-1) injuries / 11 (+2) fatalities (EM-3560 Daily Snapshot as of 8:00 a.m. ET, June 29)

FEMA / Federal Response

- Region IV RWC is monitoring; IMAT-1 deployed; RRCC rostered
- Emergency Declaration FEMA-3560-EM-FL was approved June 25
- Initial Operating Facility (IOF) opened June 28
- FEMA is coordinating with all on-site incident management
- Deployed FEMA Resources:
 - US&R
 - Deployed (4) structural engineers (State Request)
 - Deployed (1) Incident Support Team (IST) Mission Ready Package-Command-IST; 12 system personnel/3 FEMA personnel to support search and rescue operations (State Request)
 - VA-TF2, OH-TF1, & PA-TF1 assets on alert for national-level response
 - 4 (+1) FEMA LNOs deployed to FL; 2 (+1) from US&R, 1 from FIMA, and 1 from Region IV
 - ESF #15 (External Affairs): Team Leader deployed
 - MERS personnel and equipment deployed
- FEMA Logistics: Staging Management Team on alert
- Individual Assistance (IA) registration intake/helpline opened; IA staff is onsite
- USACE: ESF #3 Team Leader, 3 Geotechnical/Structural Safety Specialists, & 2 Debris SMEs enroute



State / Local Response:

- FL EOC at Partial Activation (COVID-19); Governor declared State of Emergency
- Miami-Dade County EOC at Partial Activation (Partial Building Collapse); signed Local State of Emergency
- FL US&R: TF1, TF2, TF3, TF4, TF-5, TF6, TF-7, and TF-8 deployed as state assets
- FL Crisis Response Team mobilized
- State of Florida's ESF-4/9 coordinating additional chaplains, mental health services, and other critical incident stress management resources for the US&R responders (EM-3560 Daily Snapshot as of 3:00 p.m. ET, June 28)

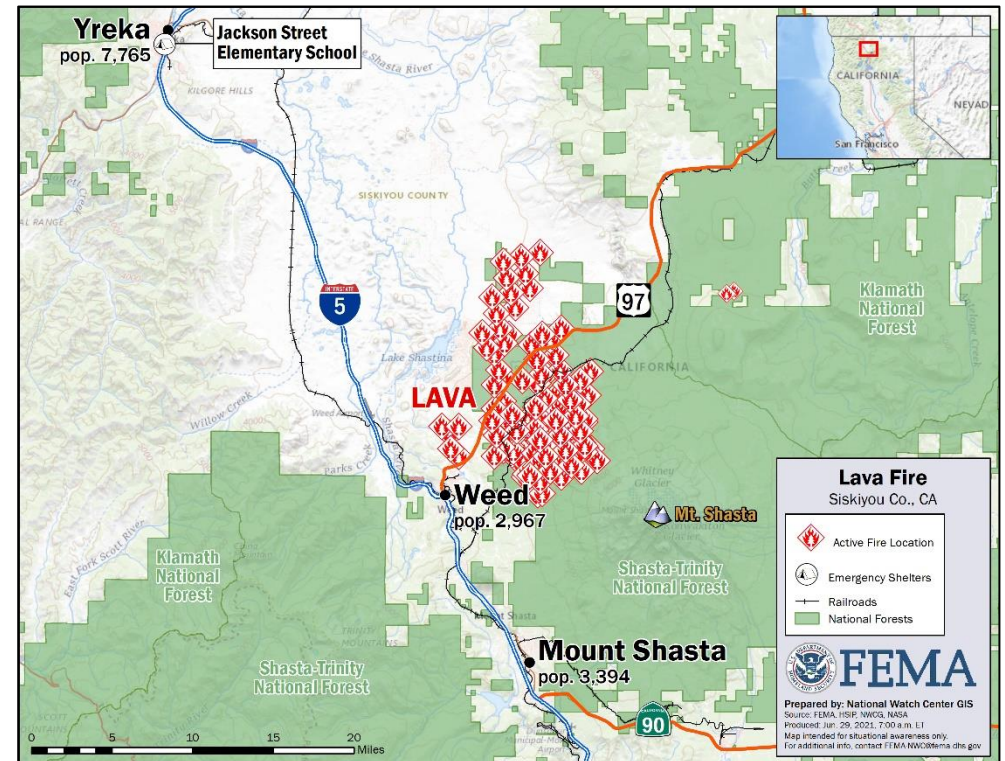

Situation:

- The fire was started by lightning on June 24 and has burned in excess of 14,000 acres of State and Private land around Lake Shastina, Mt Shasta Vista, and Carrick, CA (combined pop 10k).
- An unreported percent of the threatened homes are primary residences, and the remainder are secondary residences. The fire is also threatening a water supply, power lines, and a major north-south rail line in the area. State Route 97 is closed in several places. Union Pacific Rail Line are closed.
- 1 shelter open / 15 occupants *(ARC Midnight Shelter Count as of 7:00 a.m. ET, June 29)*

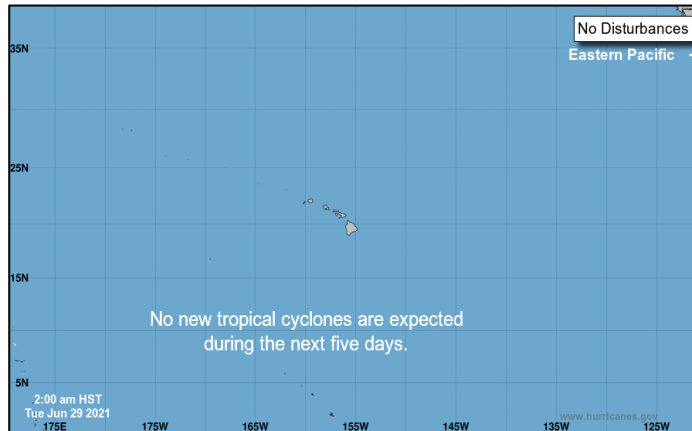

Central Pacific



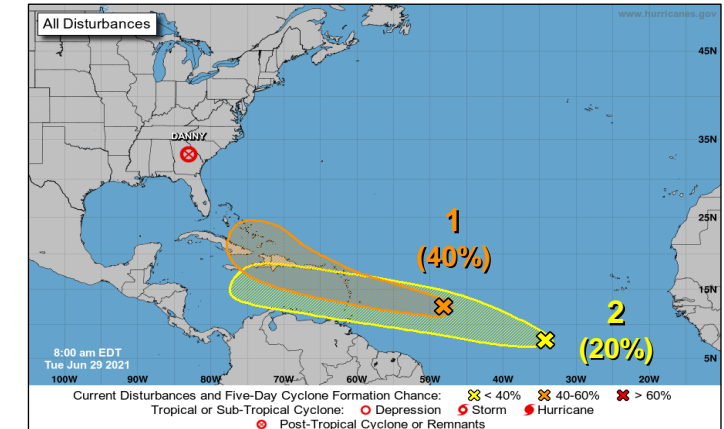

Tropical Storm Enrique (Advisory #17A as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- About 150 miles ESE of Cabo San Lucas, Mexico
- Moving NW at 6 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 50 mph
- Weakening is forecast over the next couple of days
- Tropical-storm-force winds extend 70 miles

Atlantic



Remnants of Danny (Advisory #4 as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

- Remnants located 95 miles ESE of Atlanta, GA
- Moving WNW at 17 mph
- Will produce 1-3 inches of rain; expected to dissipate today
Maximum sustained winds 25 mph

Disturbance 1 (As of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- About 850 miles east of the Lesser Antilles
- Moving W to WNW at 15-20 mph
- 48-hour formation chance: Low (30%)
- 5-day formation chance: Medium (40%)

Disturbance 2 (As of 8:00 a.m. ET)

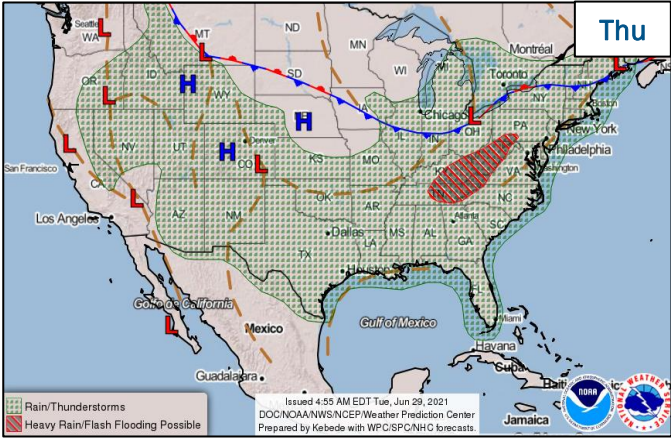
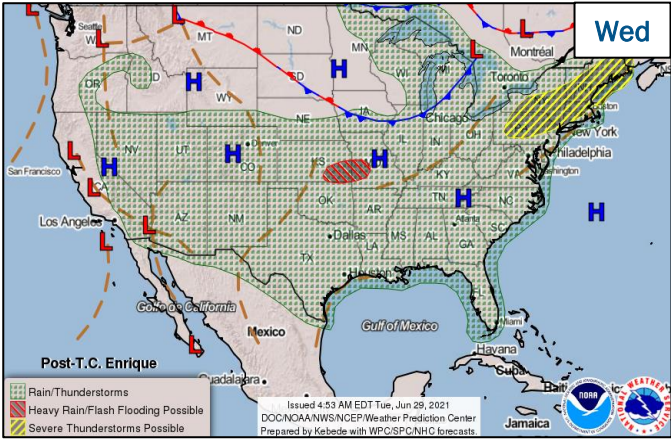
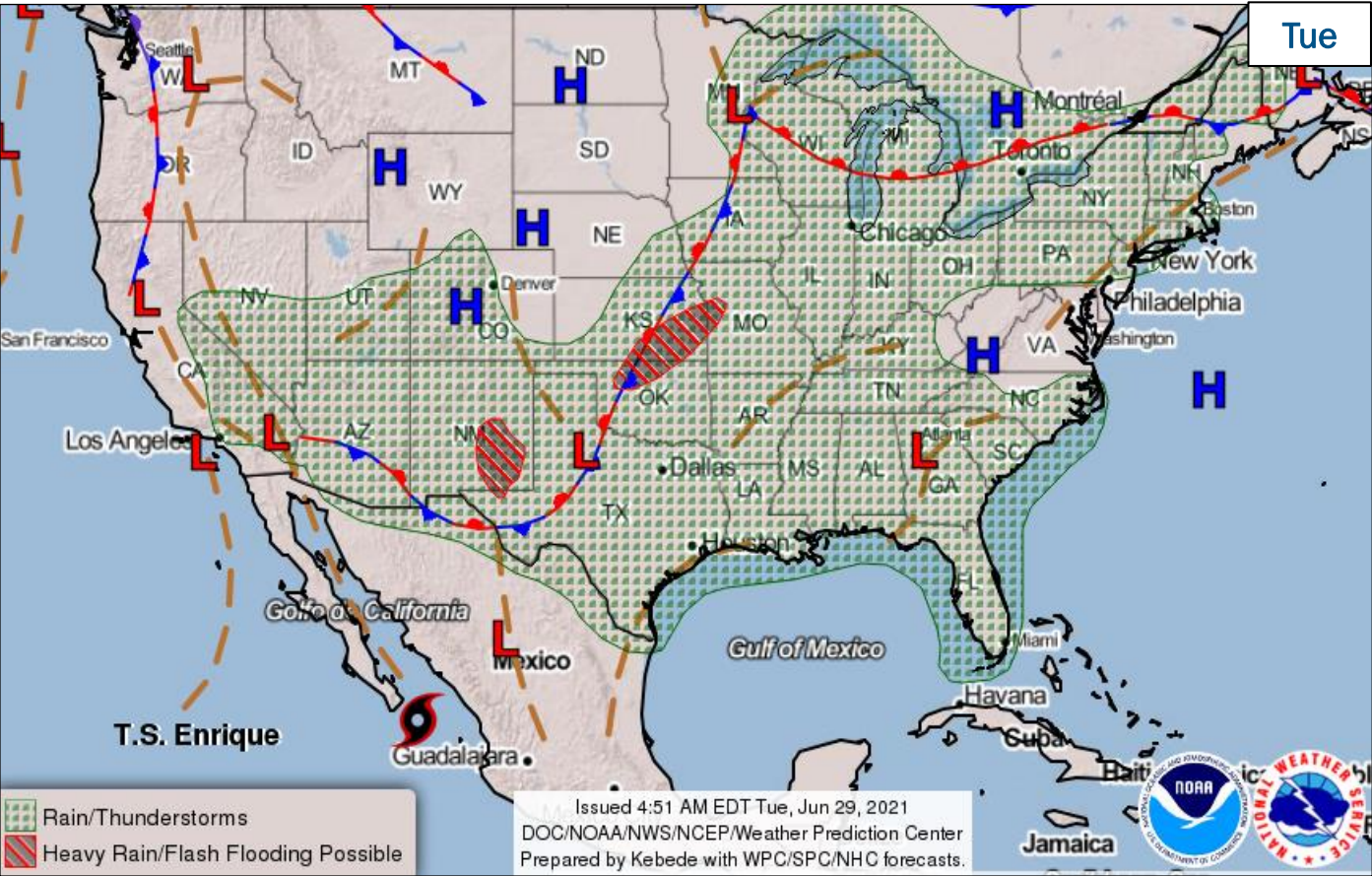
- About 800 miles SW of the Cabo Verde Islands

- 5-day formation chance: Low (20%)

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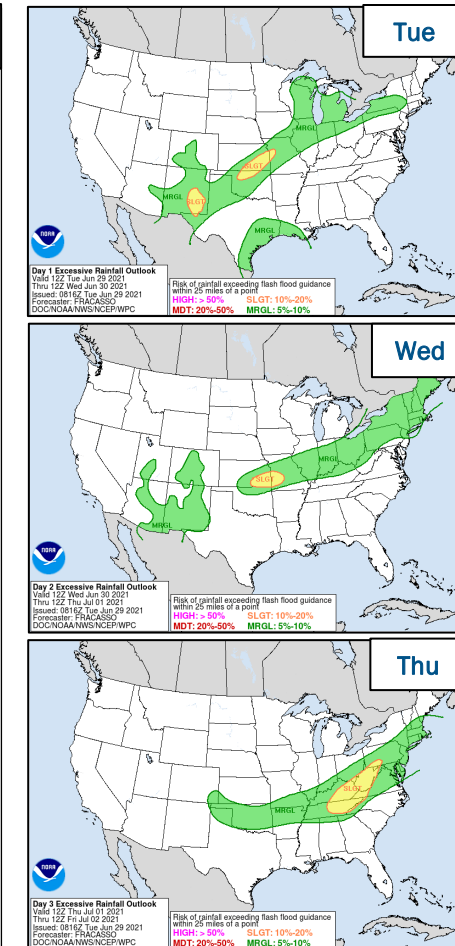
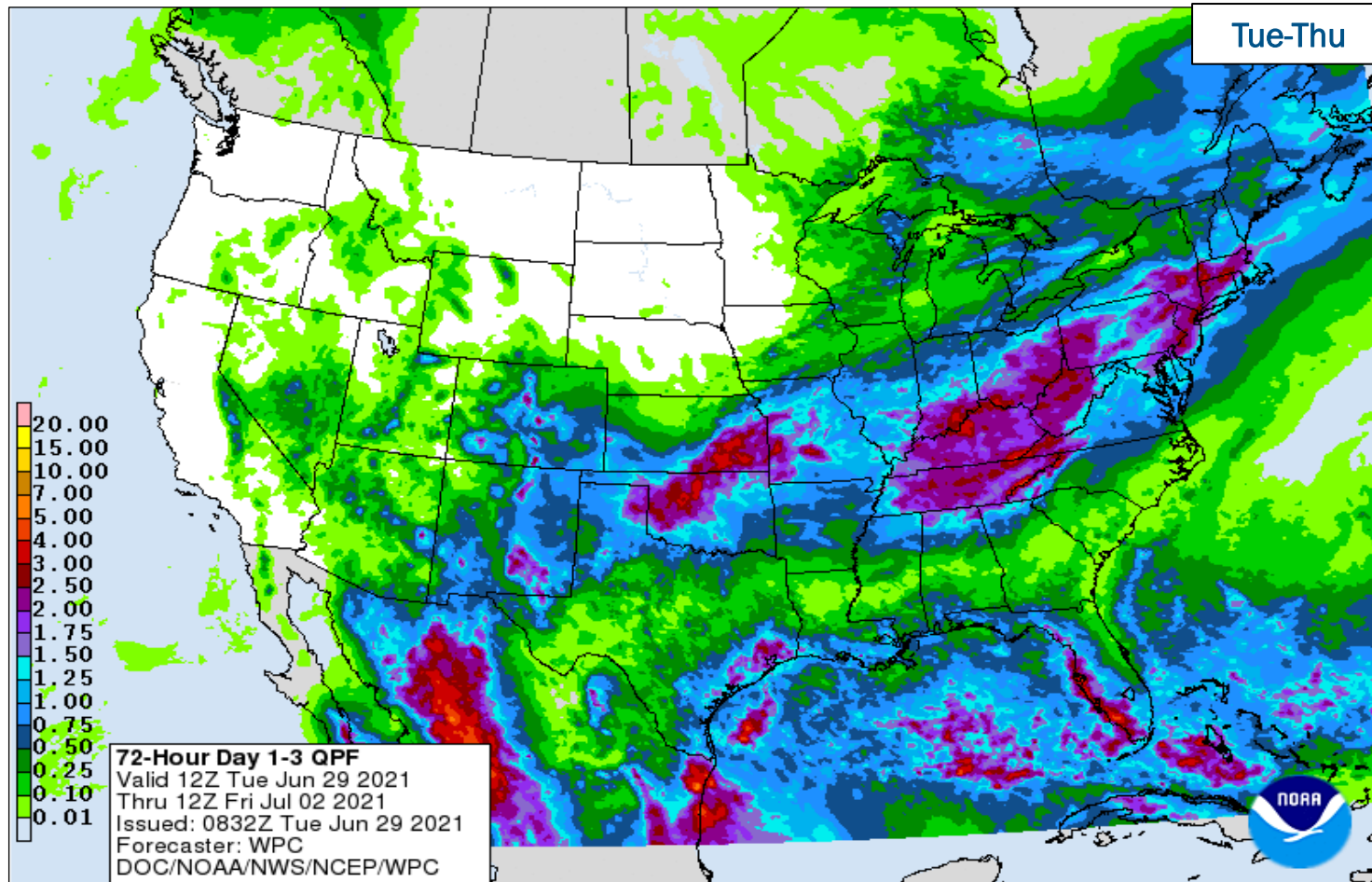
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National Weather Forecast



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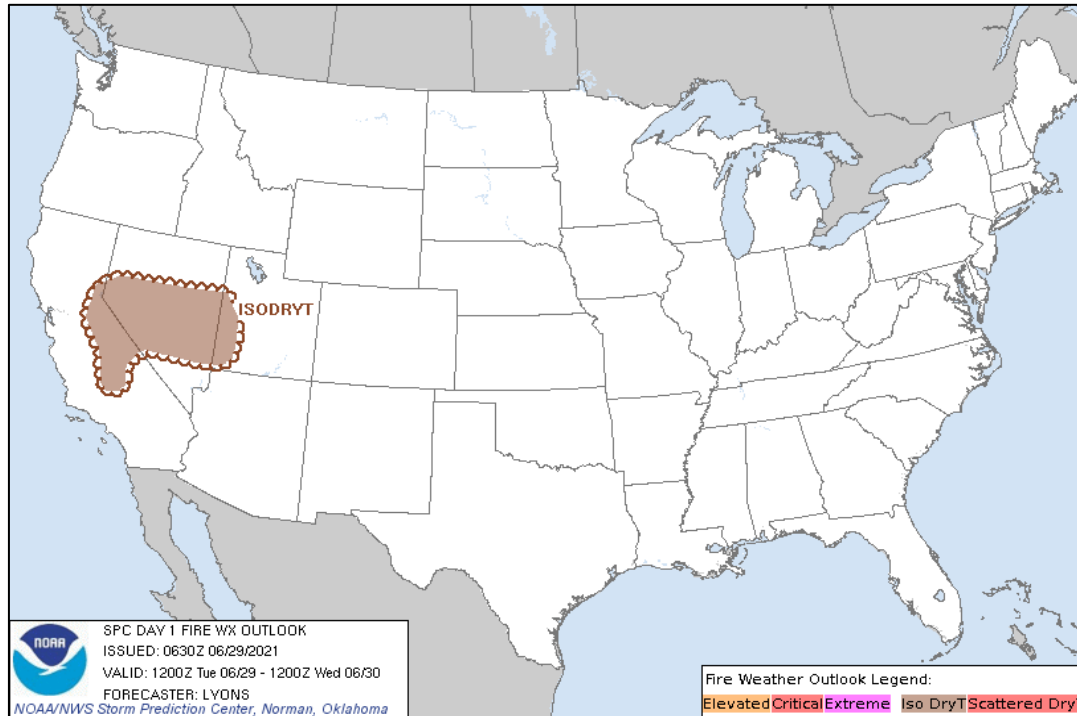
Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall



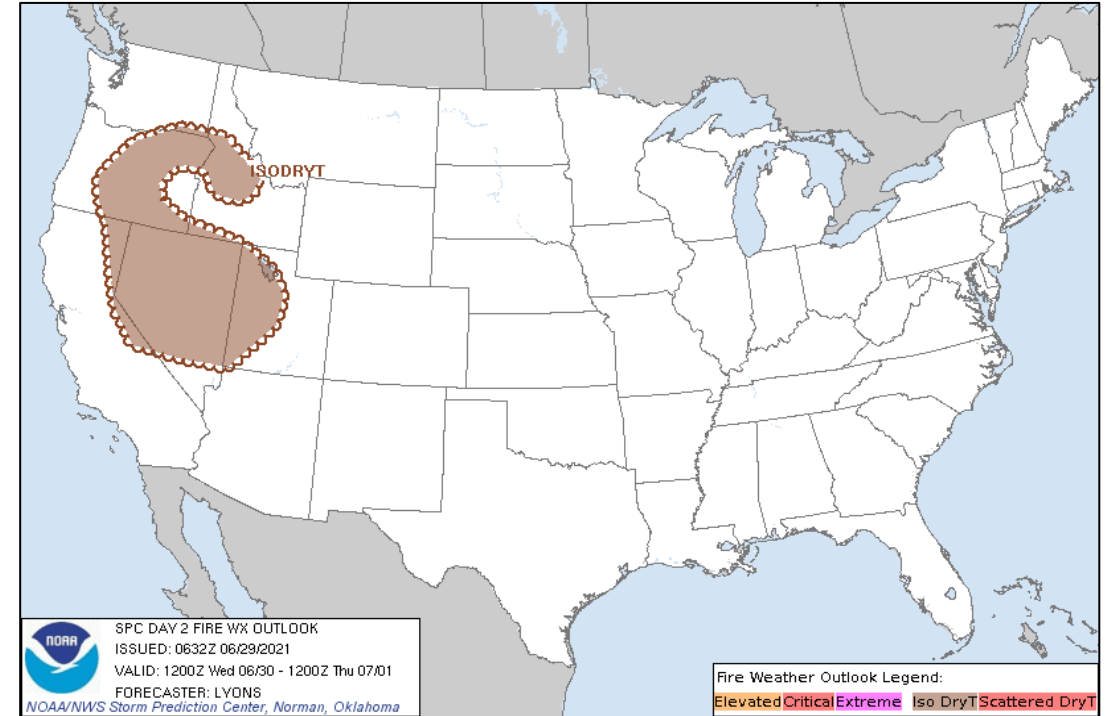
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Fire Weather Outlook

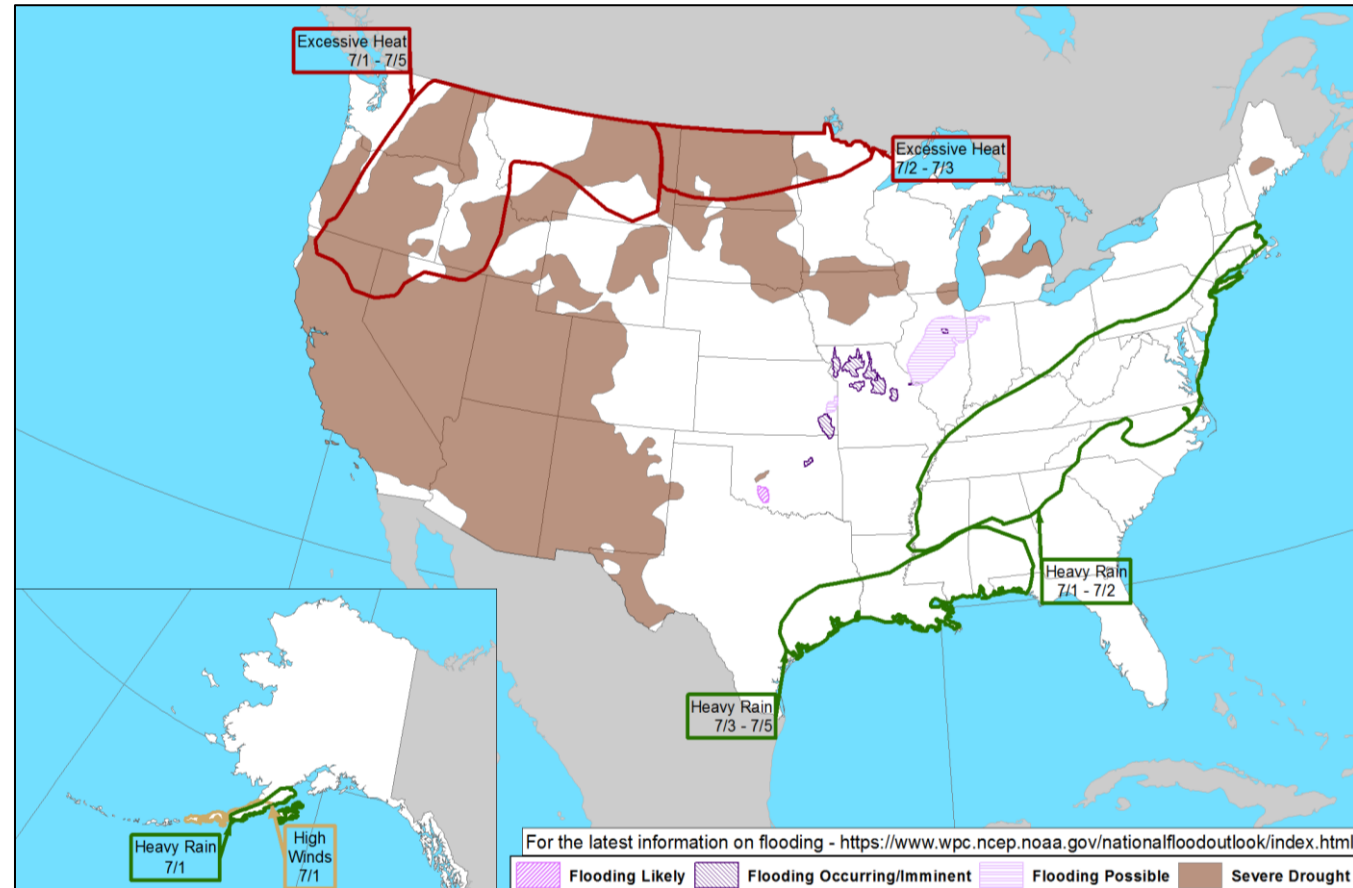

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Hazards Outlook – Jul 1 - 5



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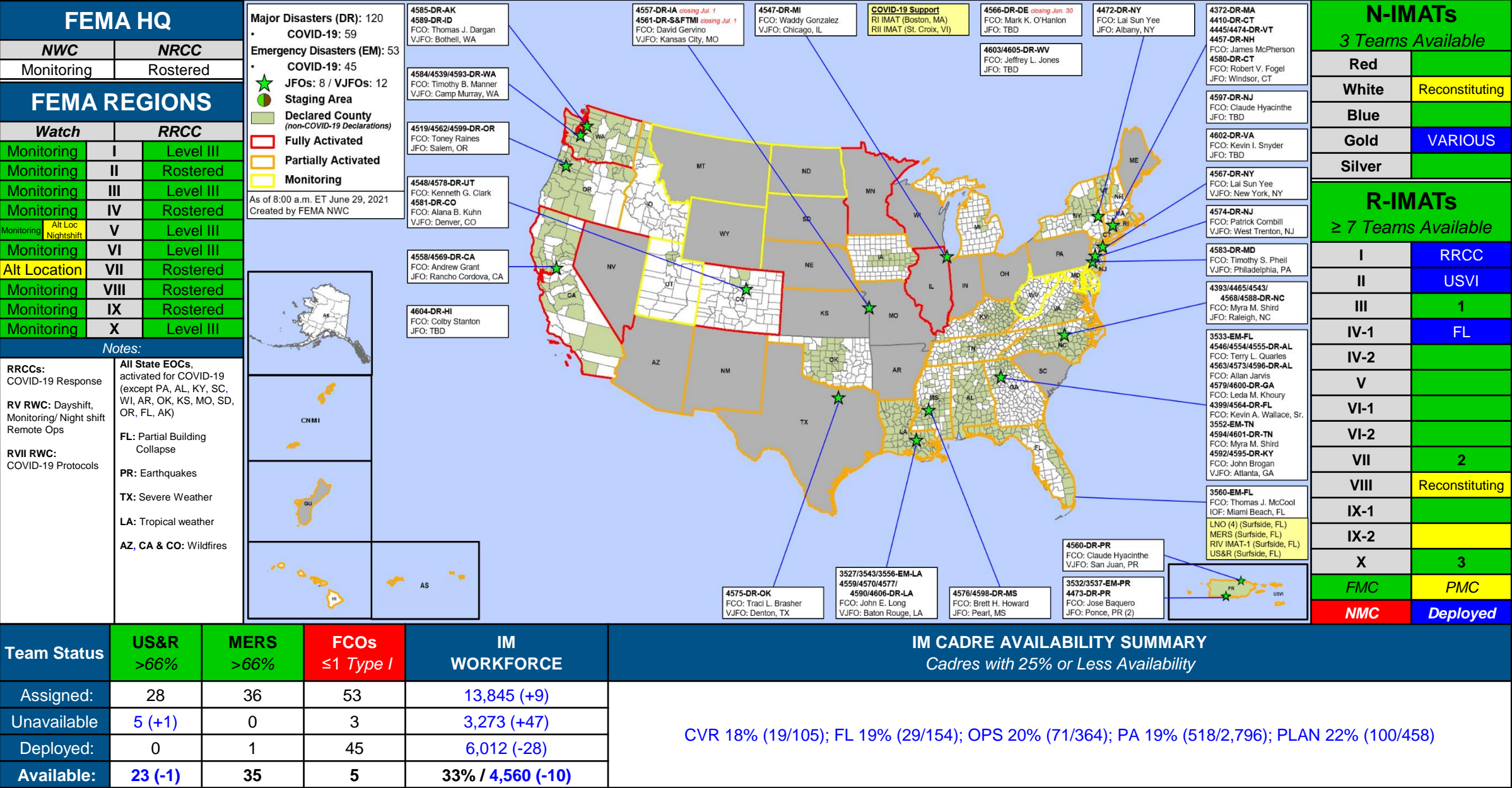

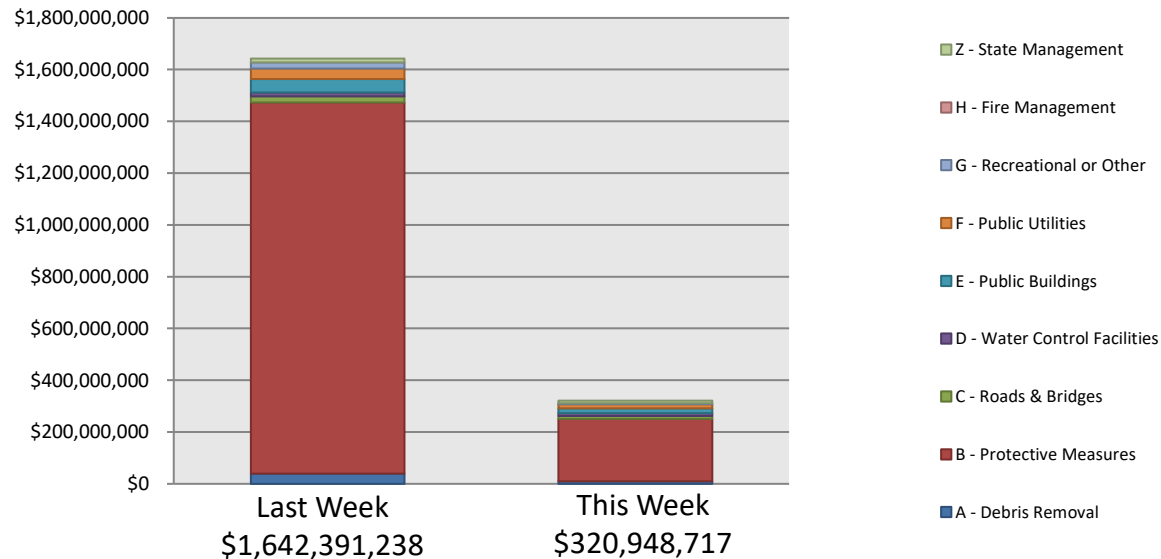

Past Year per Week, 06/29/2020 – 06/28/2021. There are currently **2,354** Households Occupying **2,354** Temporary Units.



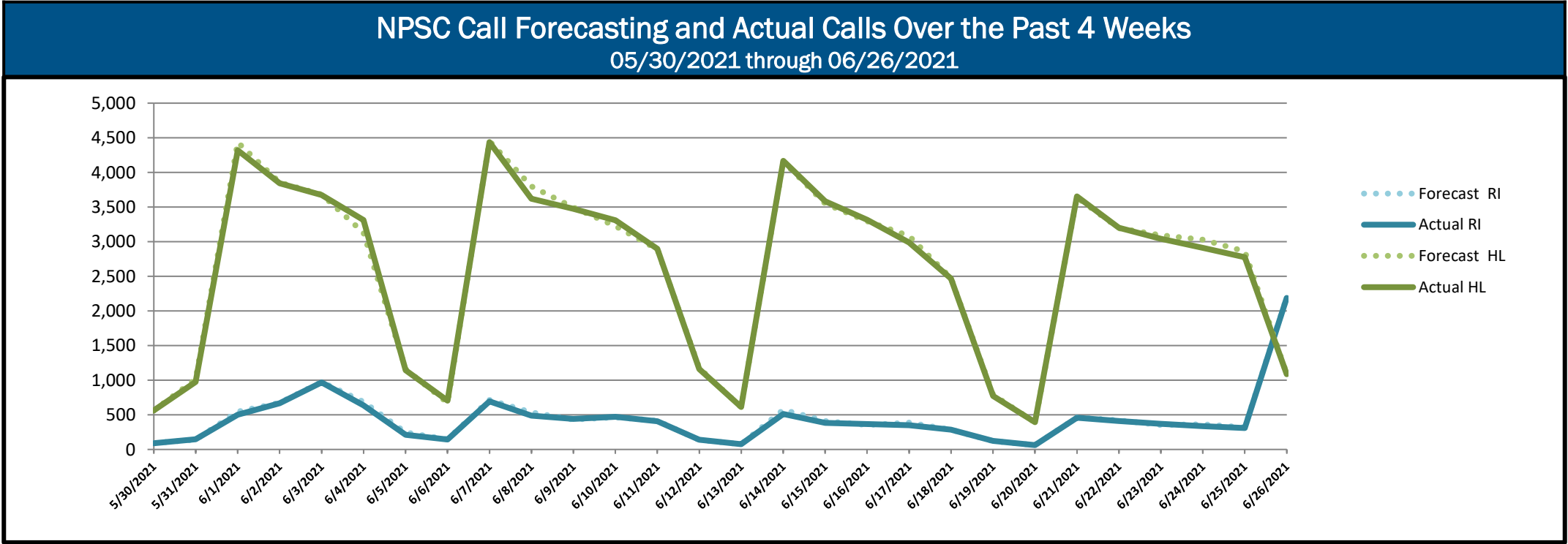

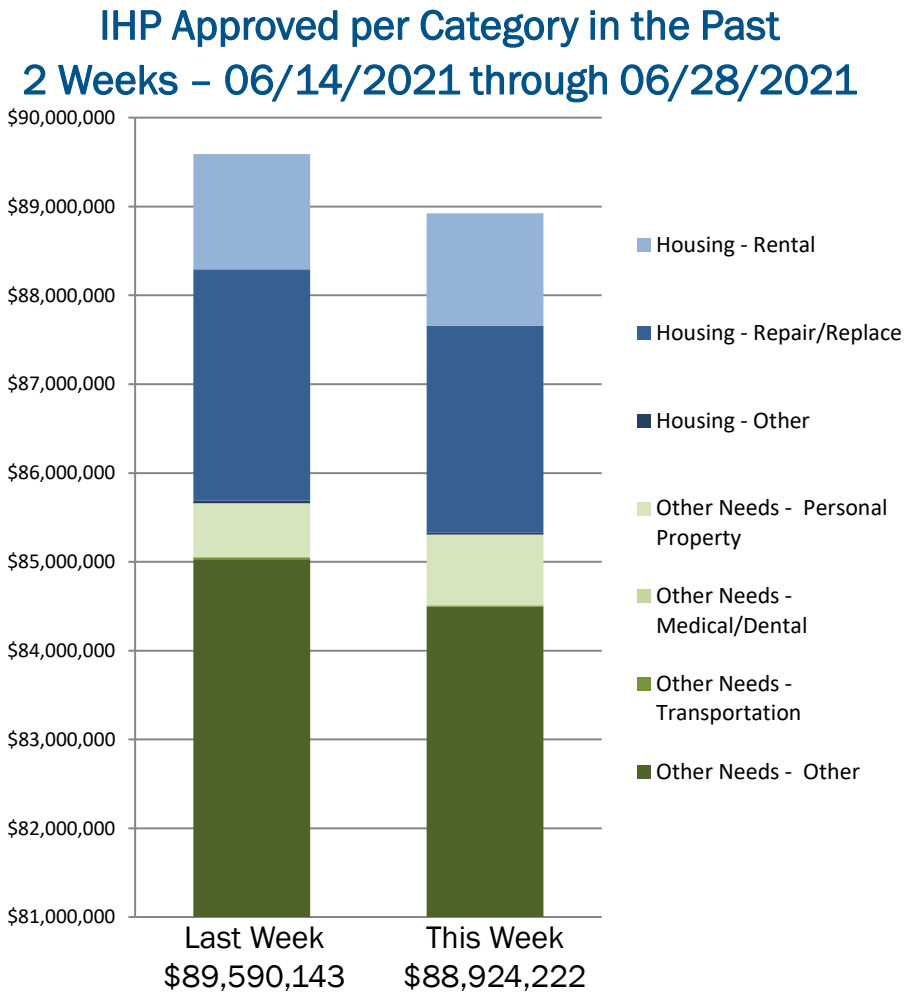
