
Situation:

- The fire began on July 13 and is burning on federal, state, and private land
- Threatening the communities of Cashmere and Wenatchee (total combined population 37,501)
- Also threatening a critical communication site on Burch Mountain for emergency medical services, law enforcement, and cell phone service in the area; Chelan and Douglas counties public utilities; multiple roads and bridges; and various environmental and cultural resources such as the Swakane wildlife refuge and local hiking trails

Response:

- WA EOC at Partial Activation (wildfires and COVID-19)
- Region X / Bothell MOC are monitoring
- FMAG approved July 14, 2021







Tropical Outlook - Five Day

Atlantic






Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- · Located well offshore of the coast of southern Mexico
- Moving W or WNW at 15 mph
- Conditions are expected to be conducive for gradual development over the next several days
- Tropical depression is likely to form this weekend
- 48-hour formation chance: Medium (40%)
- 5-day formation chance: Low (90%)

Hurricane Felicia (Advisory #5 as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

- 730 miles SW of the southern tip of Baja California
- Moving W at 12 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 85 mph (CAT 1)
- Further intensification is expected over the next day or
- Hurricane force winds extend 25 miles; tropical storm force winds extend 80 miles



Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)


- Several hundred miles SSW of Cape Race, Newfoundland
- · Only marginally conducive for development
- 48-hour formation chance: Low (10%)
- 5-day formation chance: Low (10%)



Eastern Pacific – Hurricane Felicia




- 730 miles SW of the southern tip of Baja California

- Hurricane force winds extend 25 miles; tropical storm forece winds extend 80 miles






National Weather Forecast











Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall







