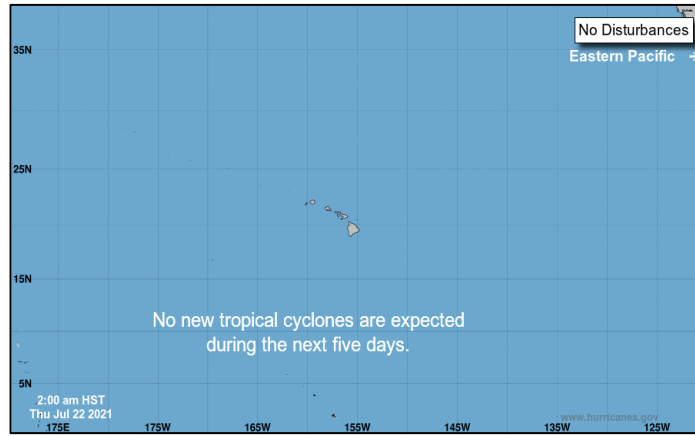

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Tropical Outlook – Five Day

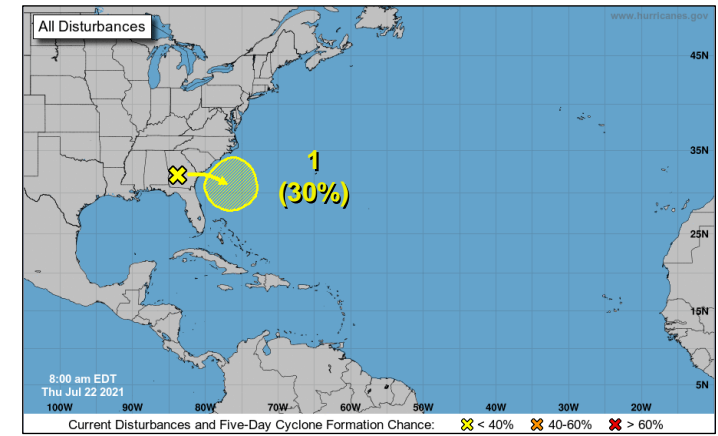

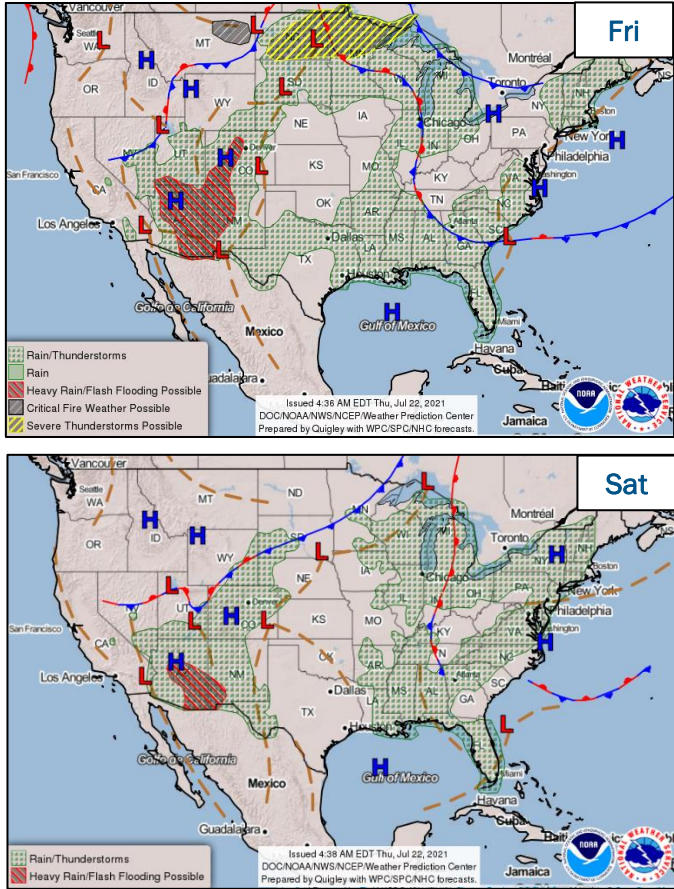
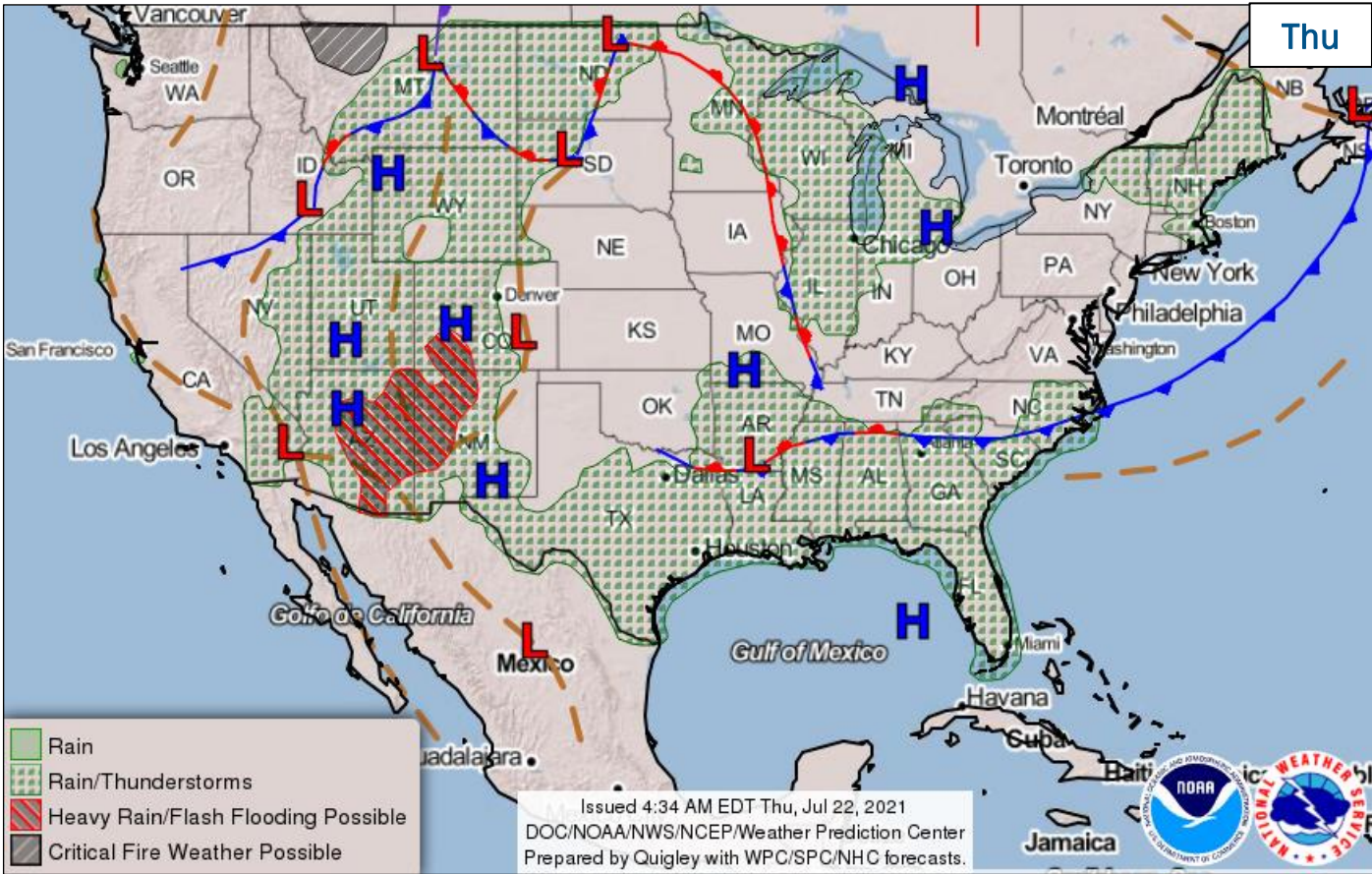
Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- 5-day formation chance: Low (30%)



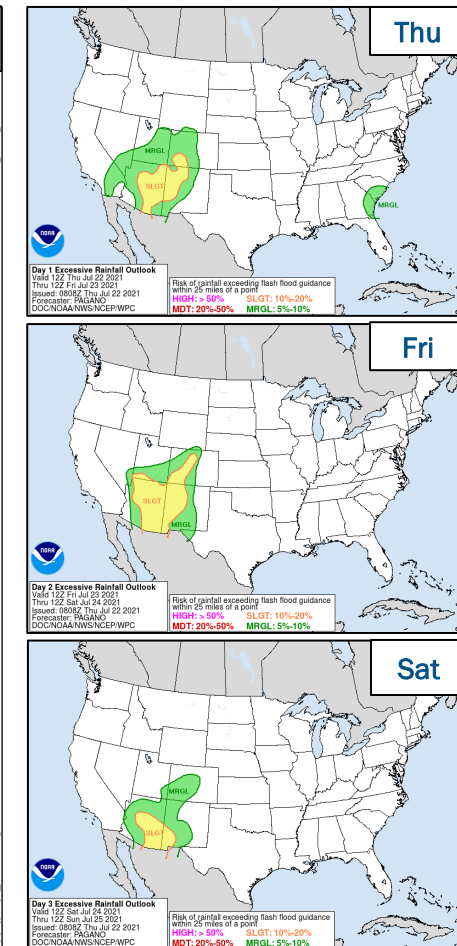
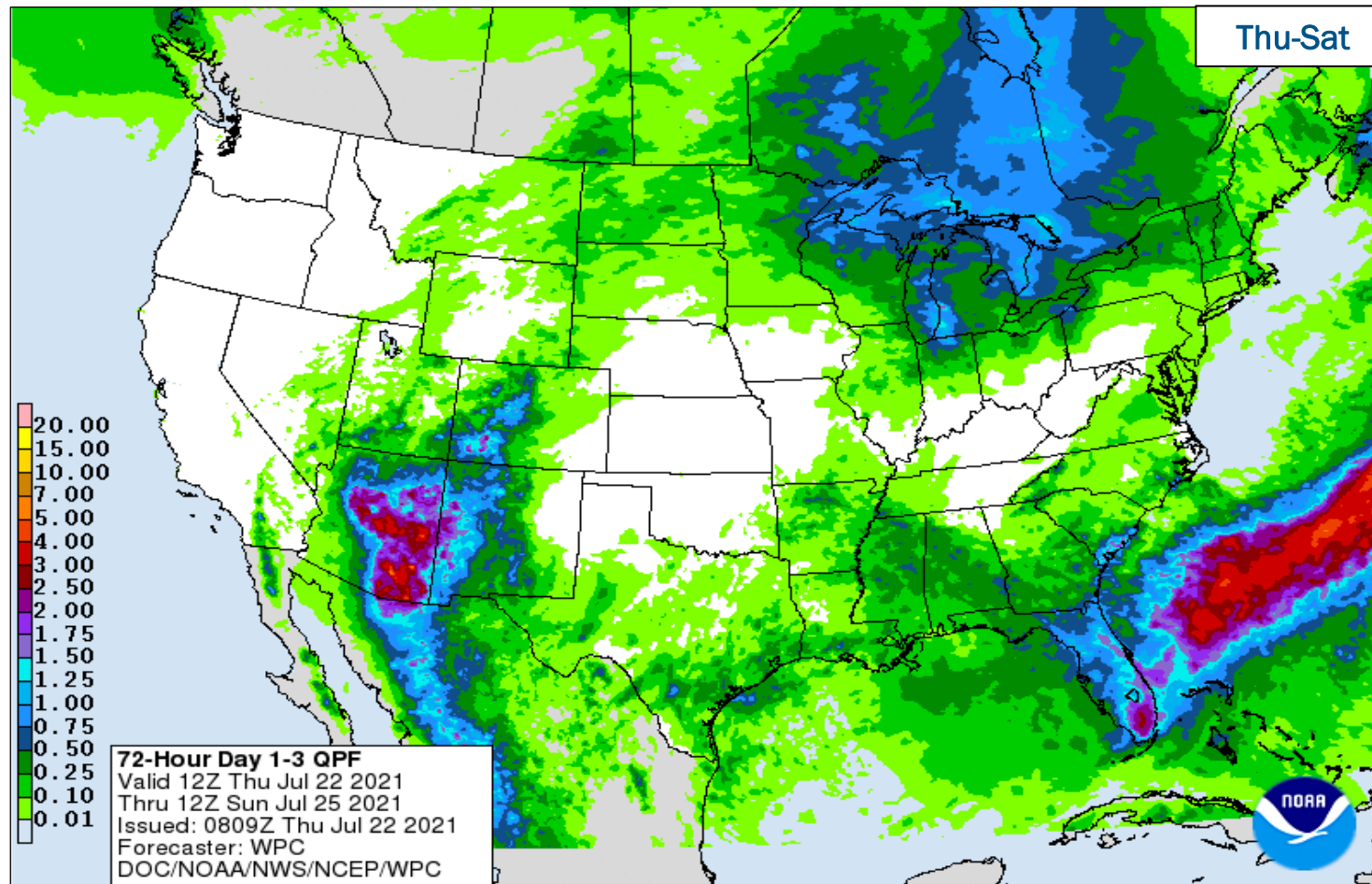
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National Weather Forecast



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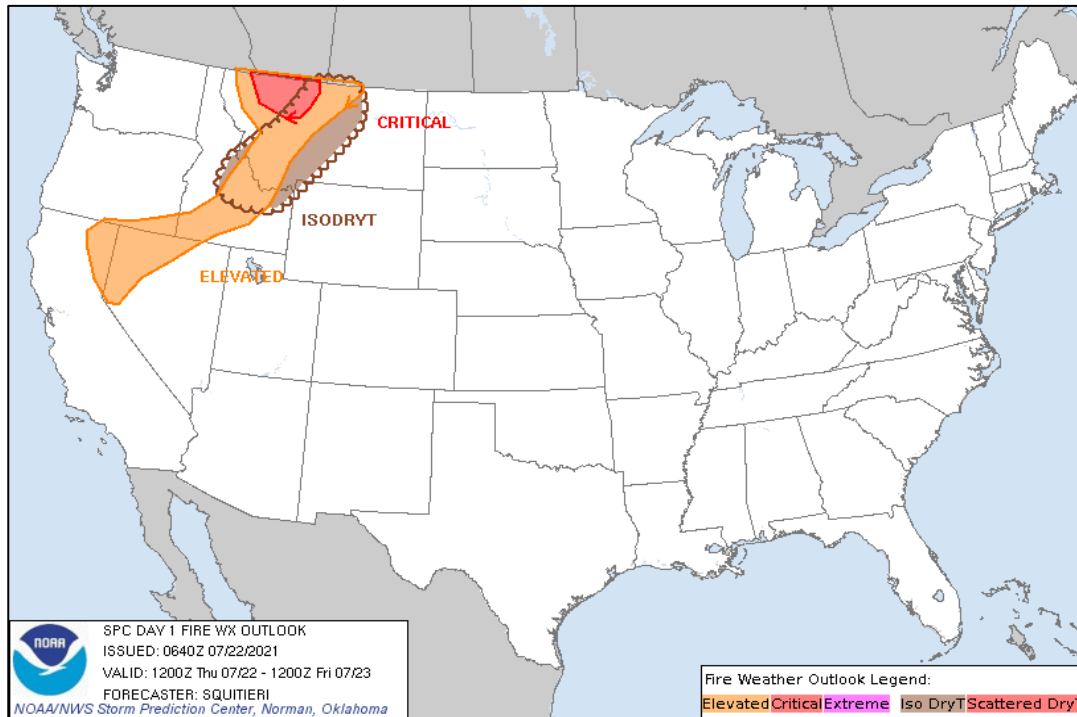
Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall



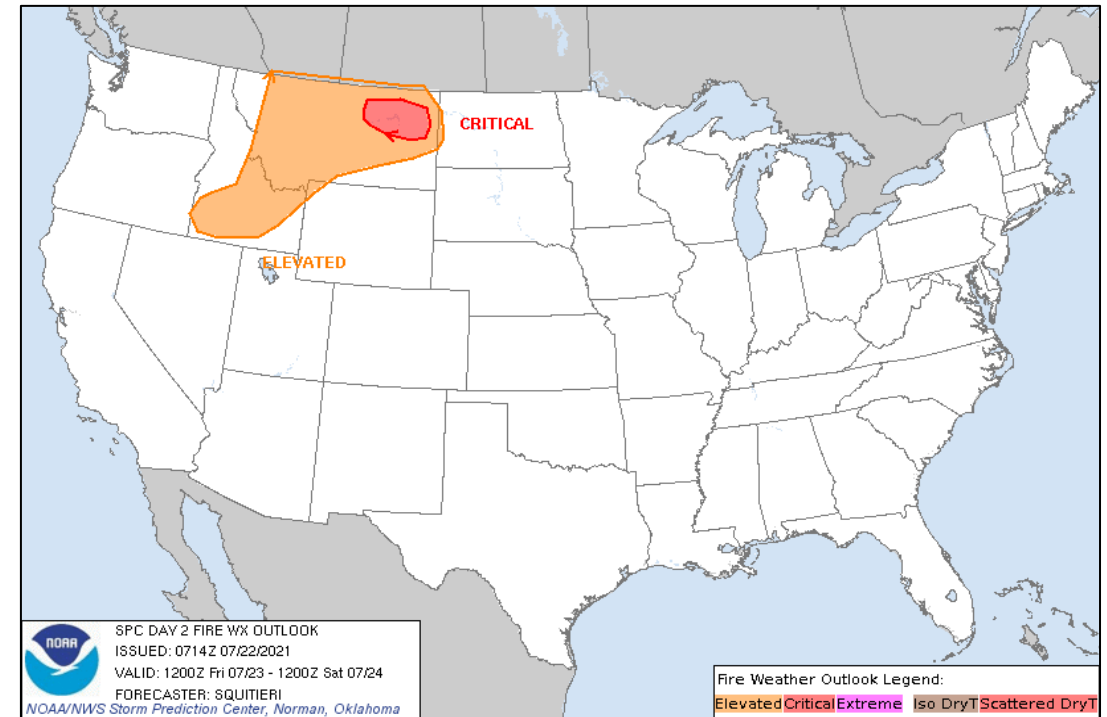
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Fire Weather Outlook

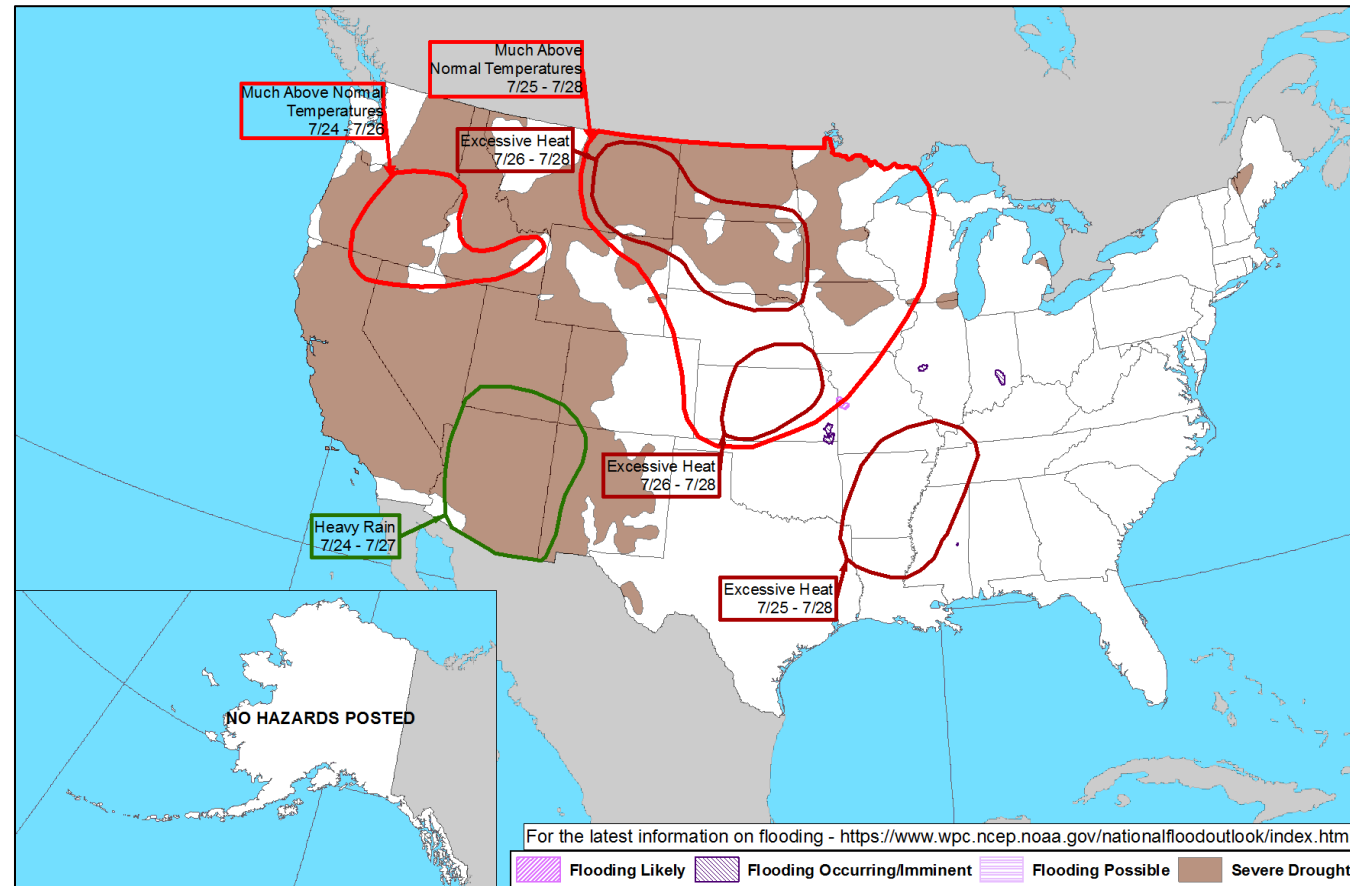
