• The fire began on July 4 and is burning on federal, state, and private land in Douglas County (pop. 48,000)


Impacts:

- Threatening 800 homes (all primary), 5 mixed commercial/residential properties, 325 commercial properties and minor structures, a water treatment plant, power distribution lines and substations, cellular communication towers, and Highway 395
- 1 shelter open with 13 occupants (ARC Midnight Shelter Count as of 7:00 a.m. ET)

- NV EOC at Full Activation (COVID-19)
- Region IX RWC is monitoring
- FMAG approved July 22



Central Pacific




Eastern Pacific

Atlantic




Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- 5-day formation chance: Low (30%)




National Weather Forecast






Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall





Hazards Outlook – Jul 25-29







