Hazard Monitoring

- Heavy rain and flash flooding possible – Northern Intermountain, Central Great Basin, Central Rockies, Central Plains, Middle Mississippi Valley to Ohio and Tennessee valleys
- Tropical Activity:
 - Eastern Pacific:
 - Tropical Storm Hilda
 - Tropical Depression Nine- E
 - Disturbance 1: High (70%)

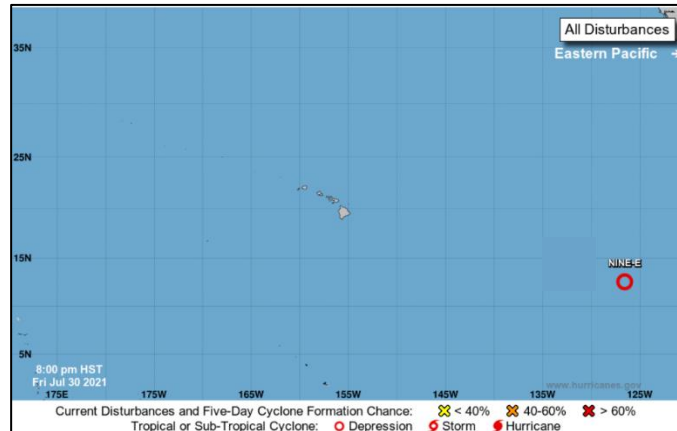

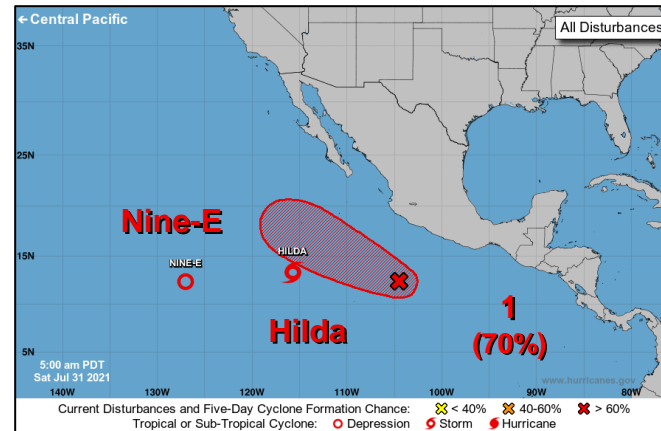
Tropical Outlook – Five Day

Central Pacific



- No significant activity

Eastern Pacific



Tropical Storm Hilda (Advisory #3 as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

- 765 miles SSW of the southern tip of Baja California
- Moving WNW at 14 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 50 mph
- Expected to become a hurricane by tonight or early Sunday
- Tropical storm force winds extend 115 miles

Tropical Depression Nine-E (Advisory #3 as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

- 1,340 miles WSW of the southern tip of Baja California
- Moving W at 6 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 30 mph
- Forecast to become a tropical storm in a couple of days

Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located about 400 miles SSW of the coast of southern Mexico
- A tropical depression is likely to form in a couple of days
- 48-hour formation chance: **Medium (60%)**
- 5-day formation chance: **High (70%)**

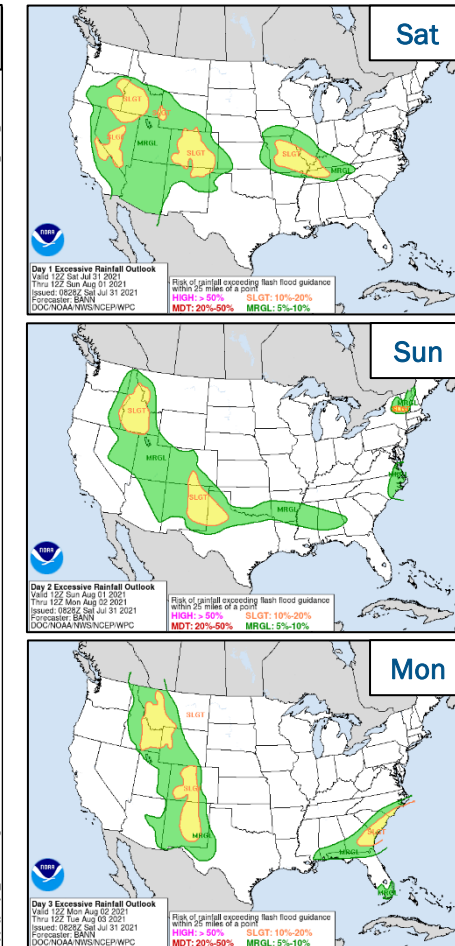
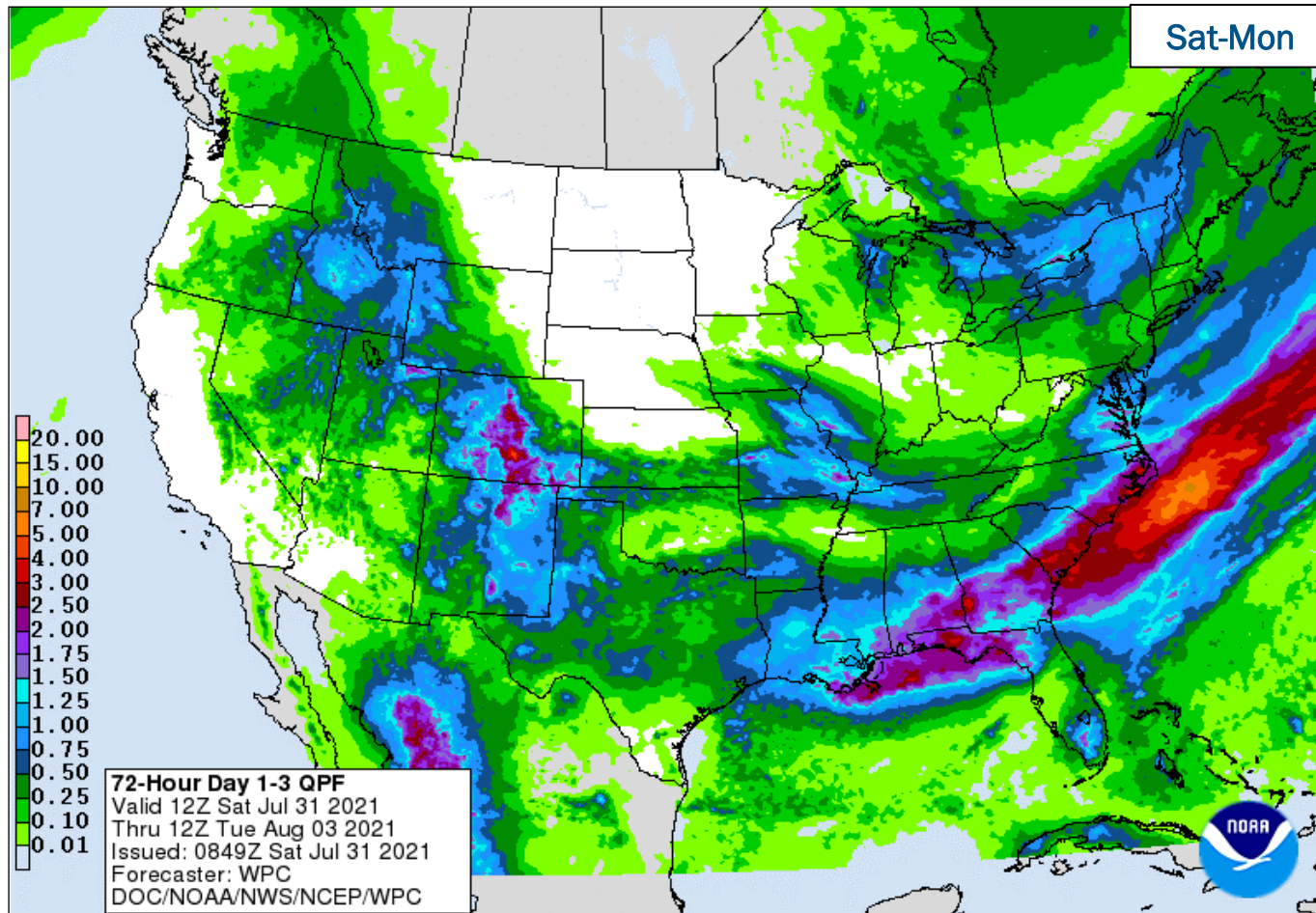
Severe Weather Outlook

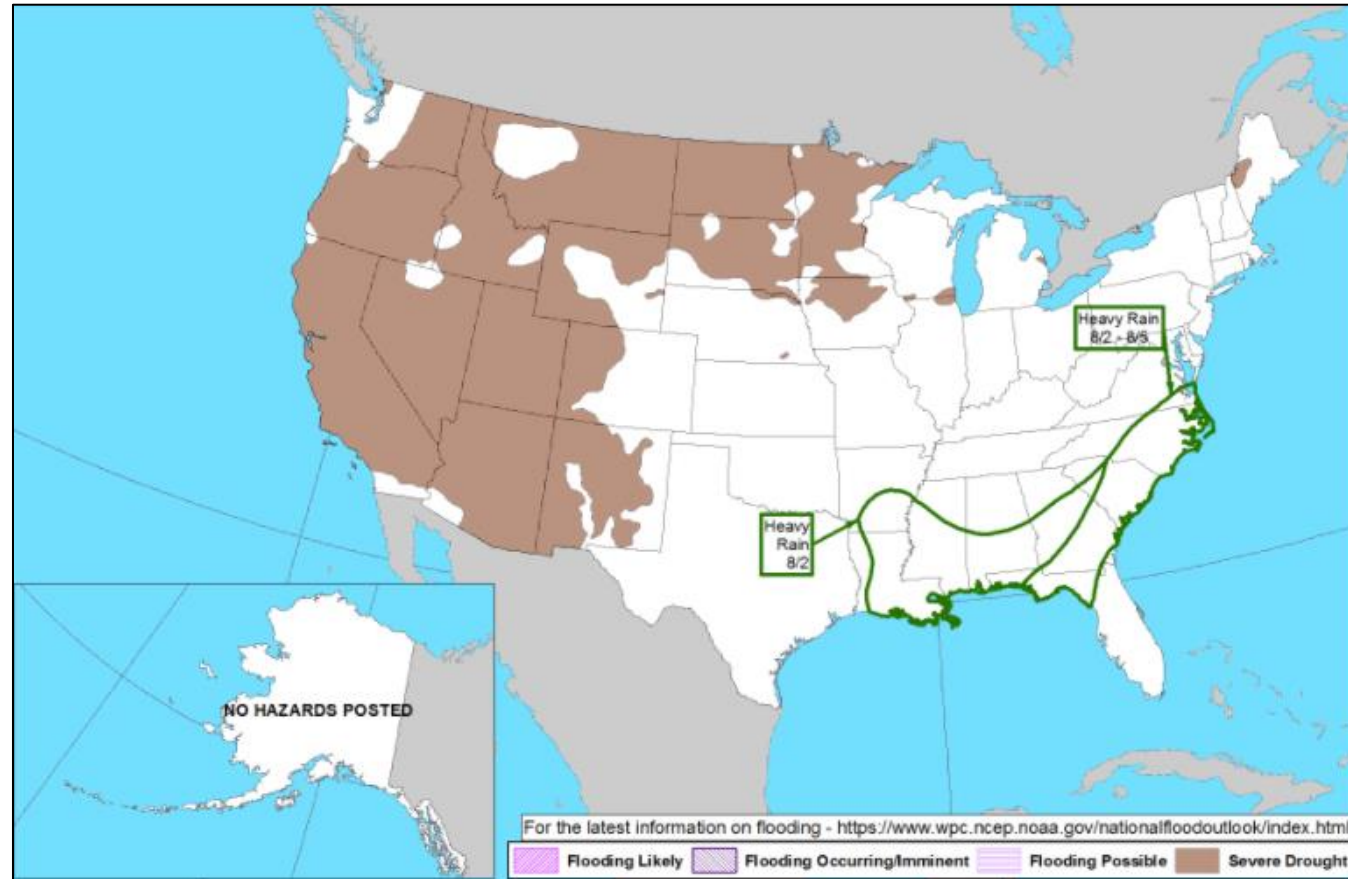
Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall
