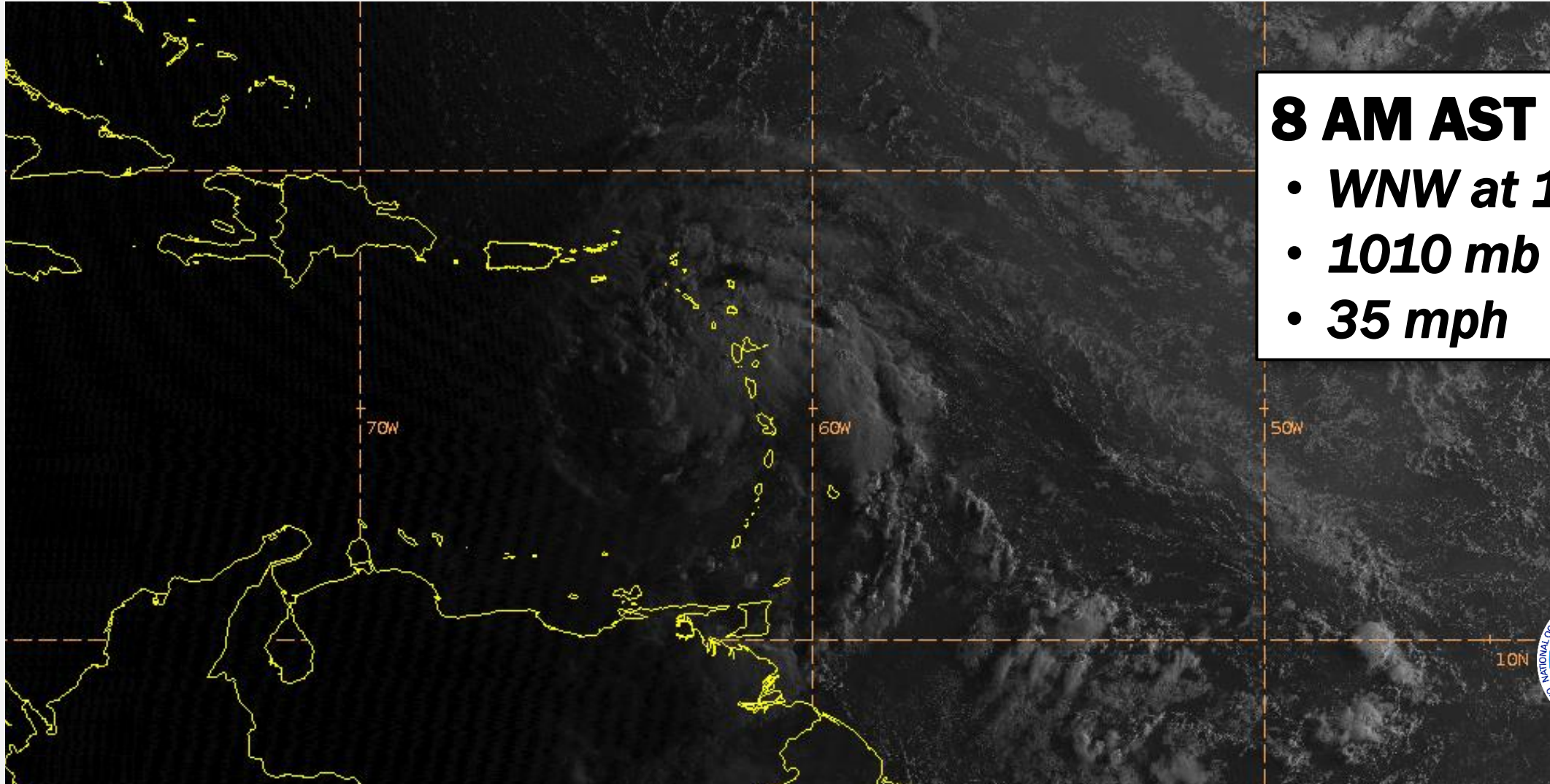

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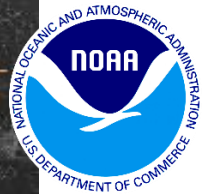

SATELLITE LOOP



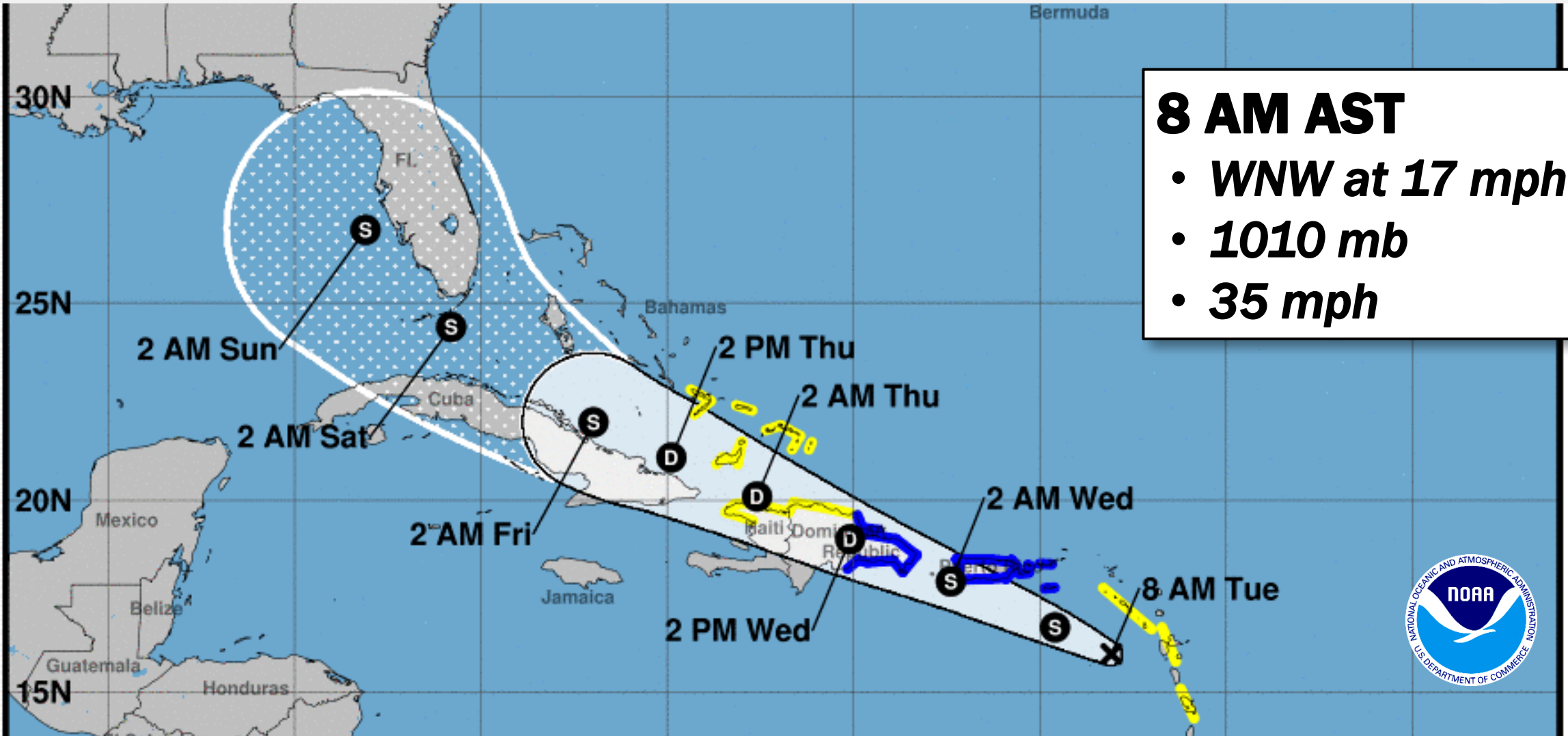

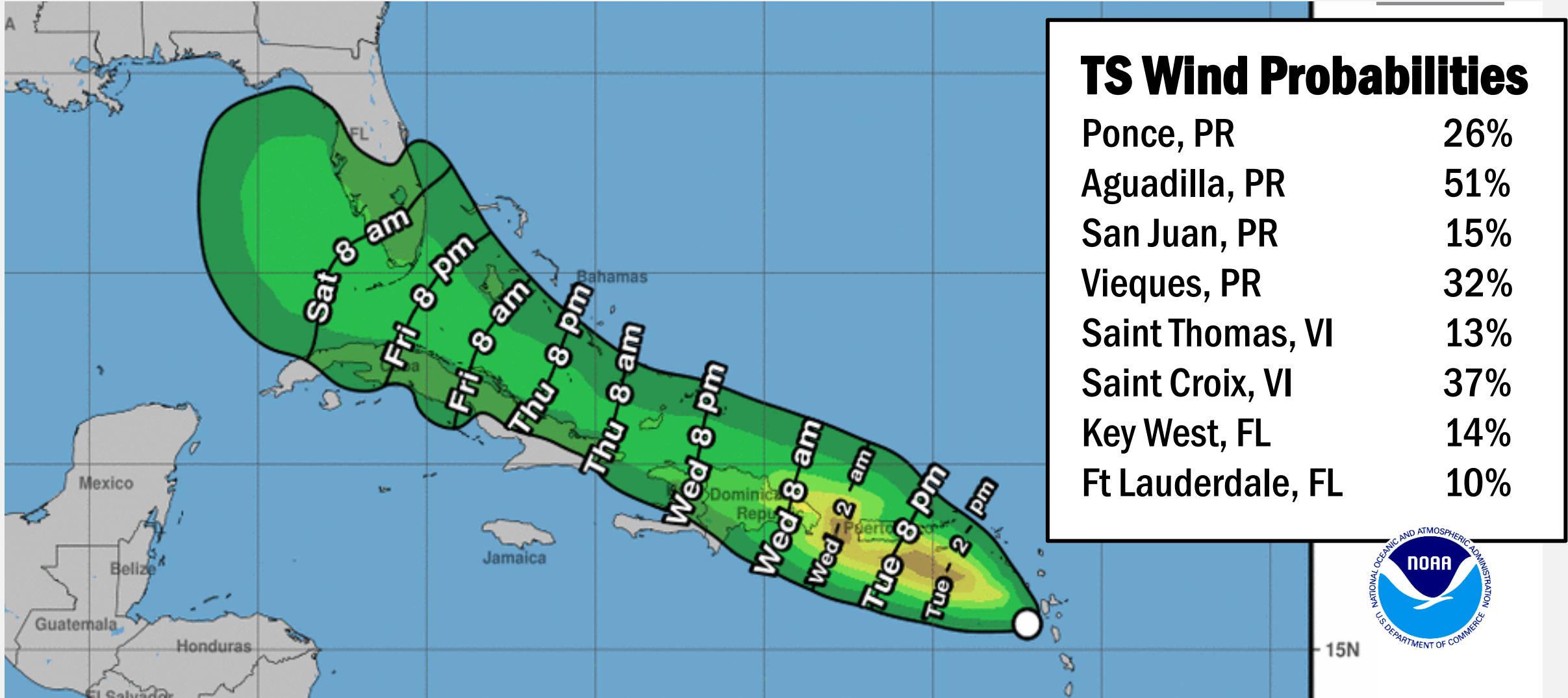

FORECAST TRACK



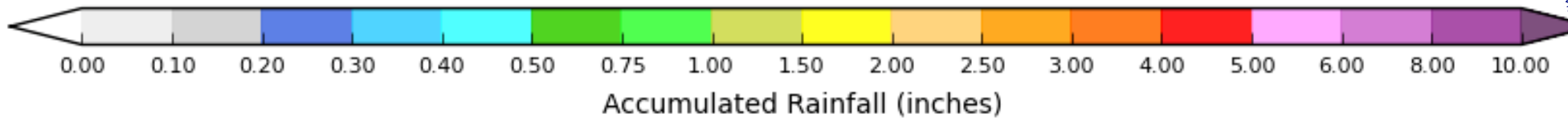
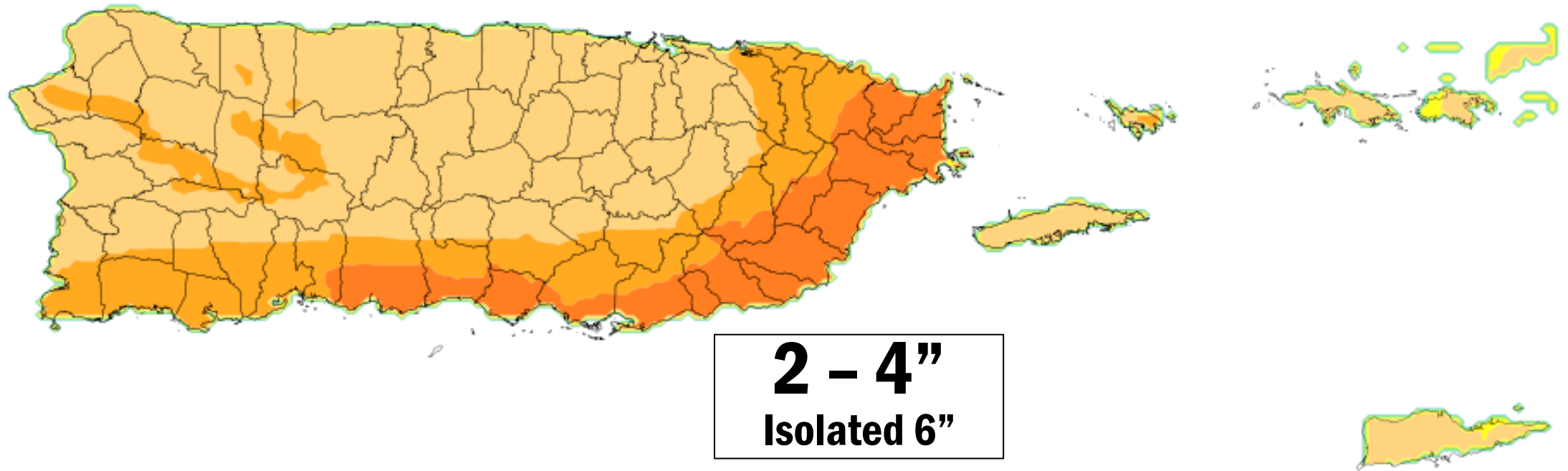

MOST LIKELY ARRIVAL OF TS WINDS



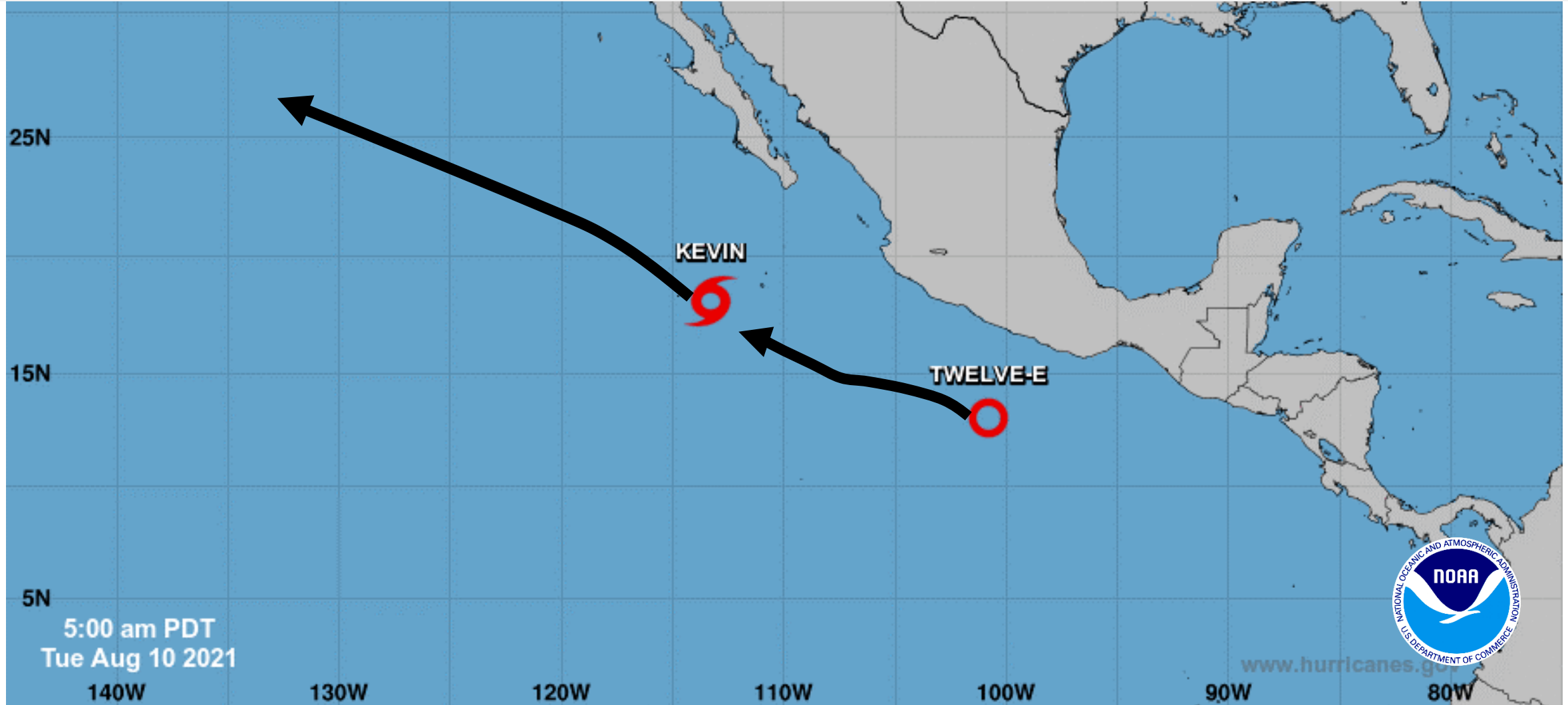

72 HOUR RAINFALL



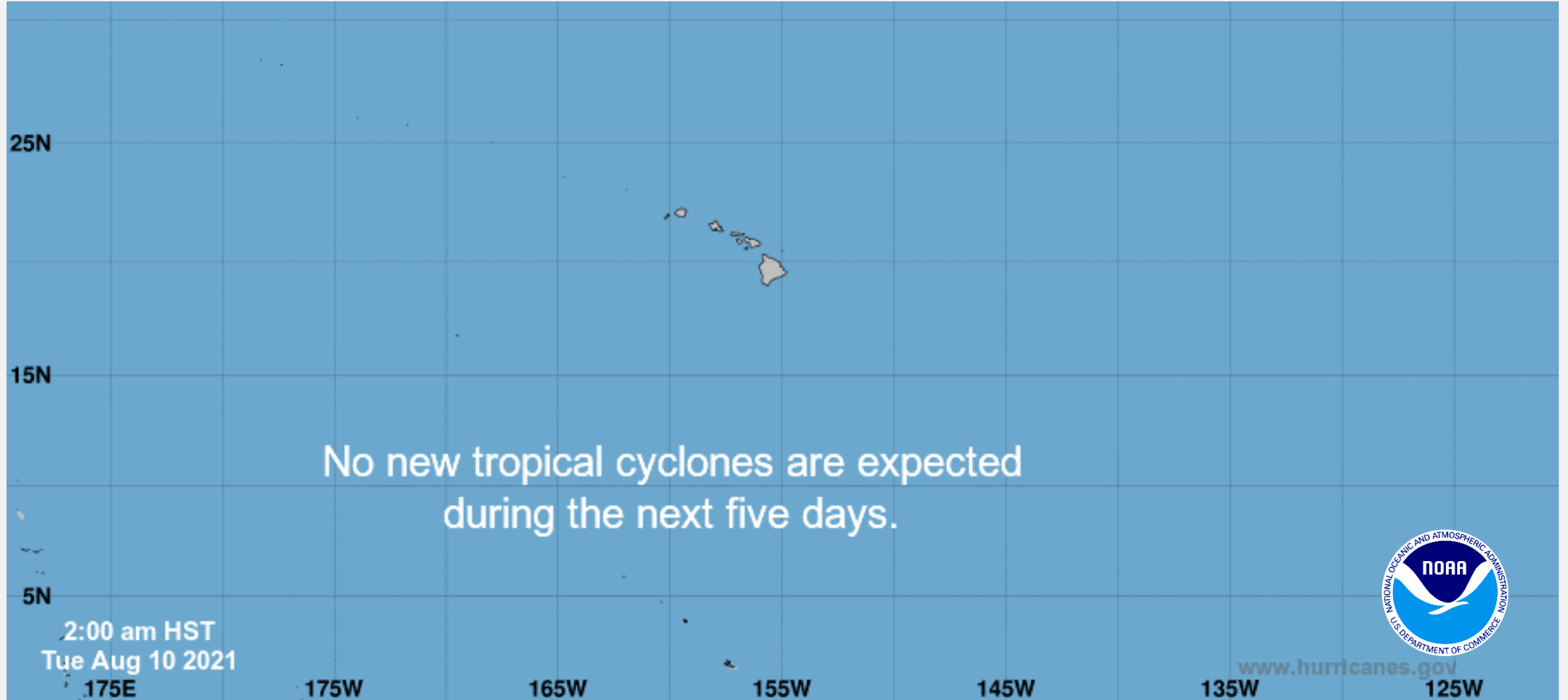

Potential Tropical Cyclone SIX- Atlantic

Preparations and Coordination:

- RWC, TAU, and the Region II Hurricane Program Manager continue to monitor and remain in contact with NWS Eastern Region Headquarters, the National Hurricane Center, and Caribbean coordinators
 - WebEOC and NEMIS incidents were created, and the Surge Account has been funded
 - Should PR opt to activate, FEMA LNOs will report to the EOC today for the duration of the incident
- Held call with Regional Leadership, CAO coordinators, National IMAT and Regional IMAT leads this morning
- Held call with LUMA, working on rostering damage assessment teams
- Key staff from the Region and IMATs are in both PR and USVI supporting other initiatives and can support any emerging response requirements
- Recovery is pre-identifying PDA teams
- IMAT-A is receiving COVID-19 testing today if a post-incident deployment is required
- Activating an enhanced watch today (DAYTIME ONLY)

Individual Assistance:

- Coordinated with IA Cadre to transfer the 14 IA staff deployed to support the DR-4493-PR (Funeral Assistance Outreach) to the IA Surge for potential IA PDA request

FEMA Public Assistance:

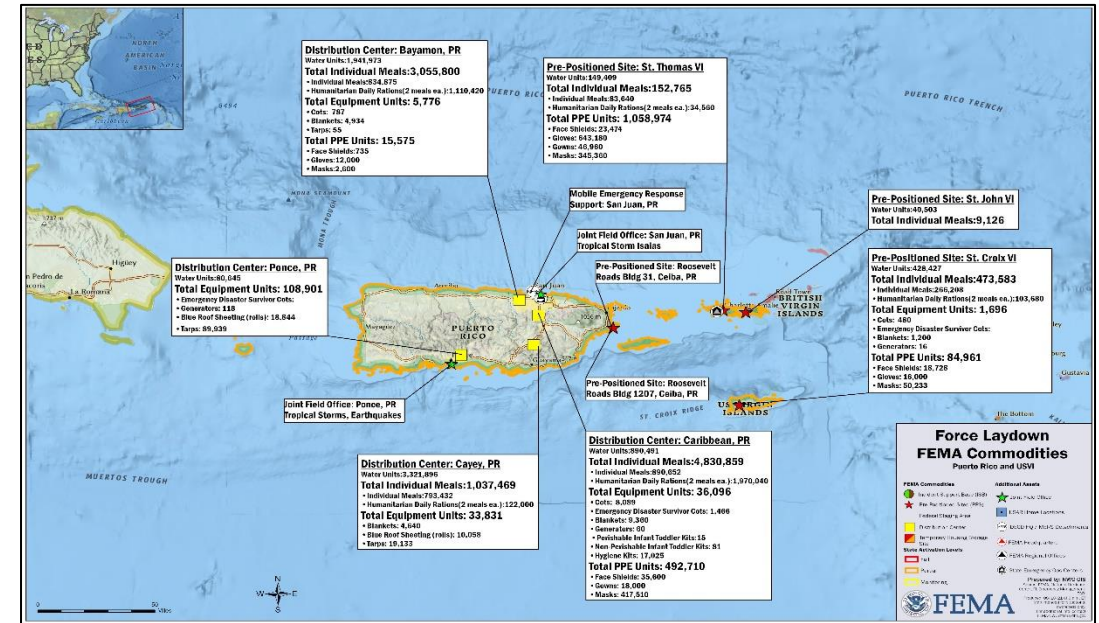
- PA PDA team is being pre-identified and were already trained

Puerto Rico

- PREMB activated to a Level II Partial Activation (COVID-19 and monitoring) tropical conditions

US Virgin Islands

- VITEMA is activated to a Level III Partial Activation in support of COVID-19 and continue to monitor tropical conditions with no unmet needs or requests for Federal assistance



FEMA HQ Support

Response

- NWC - Coordinating reporting with Regions, NHC and water center
- US&R - IST 2h PTDO for CONUS/OCONUS with swift-water rescue
- OIB – 105 personnel available nationally to support. National contracts fully capable.
- MERS - Maynard lead for R2. Sync'd with Regional leadership and understand CONOPS. Completed checks and prepared to deploy.

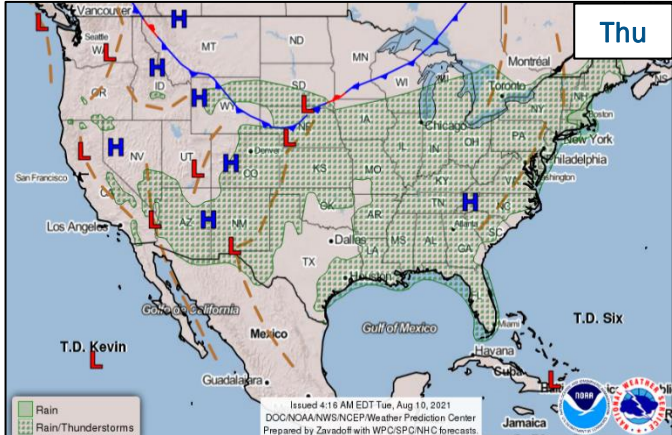
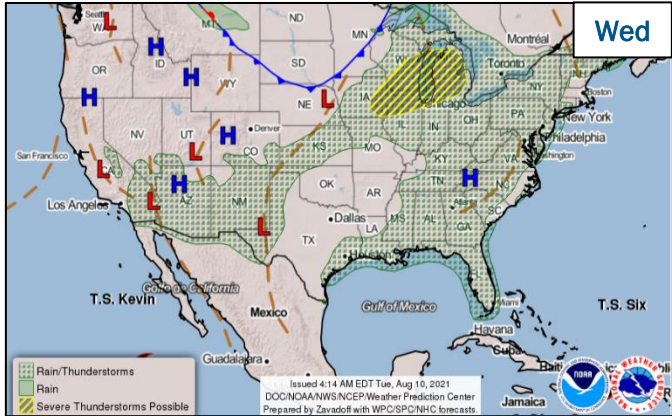
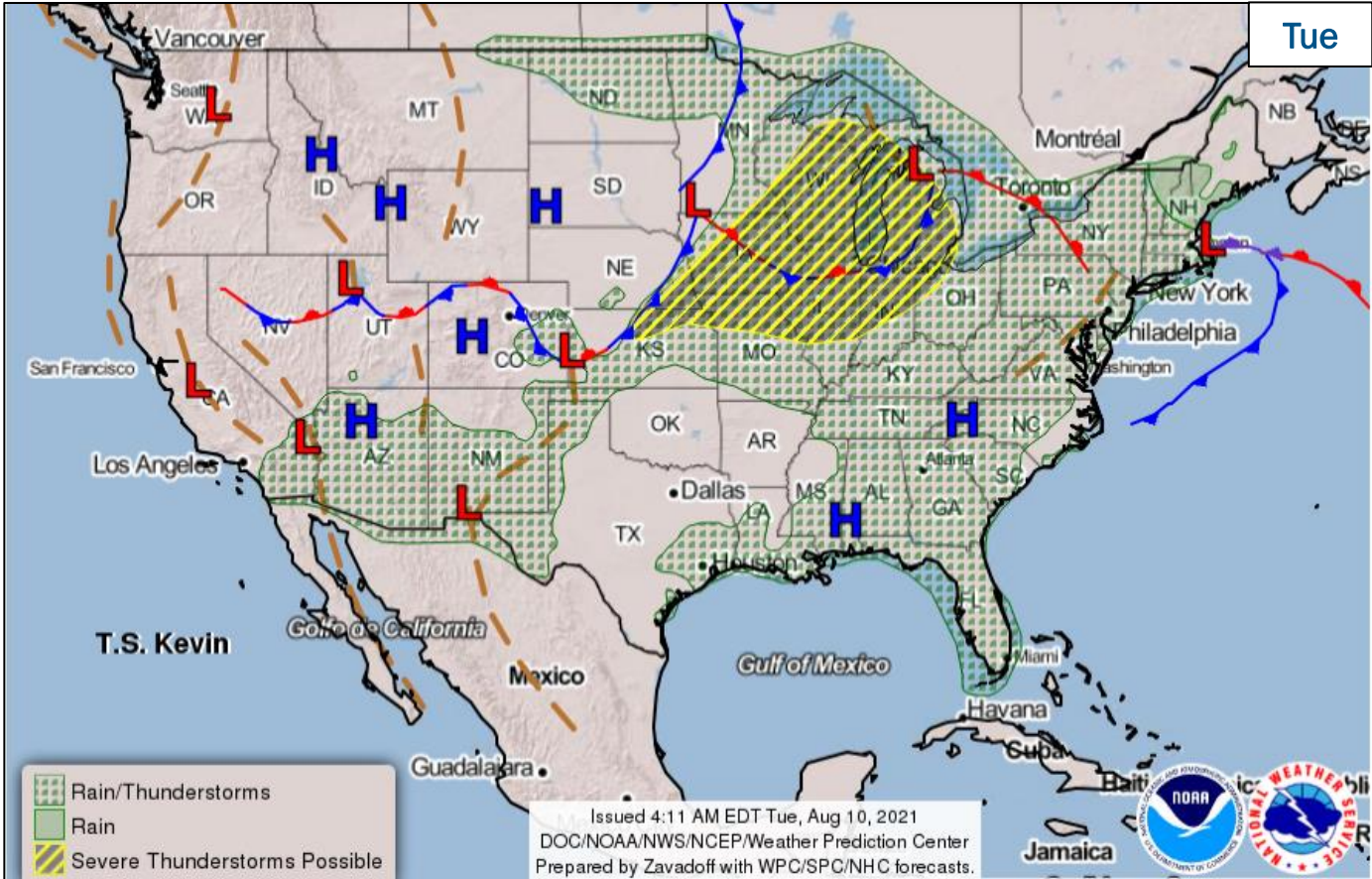

National Weather Forecast



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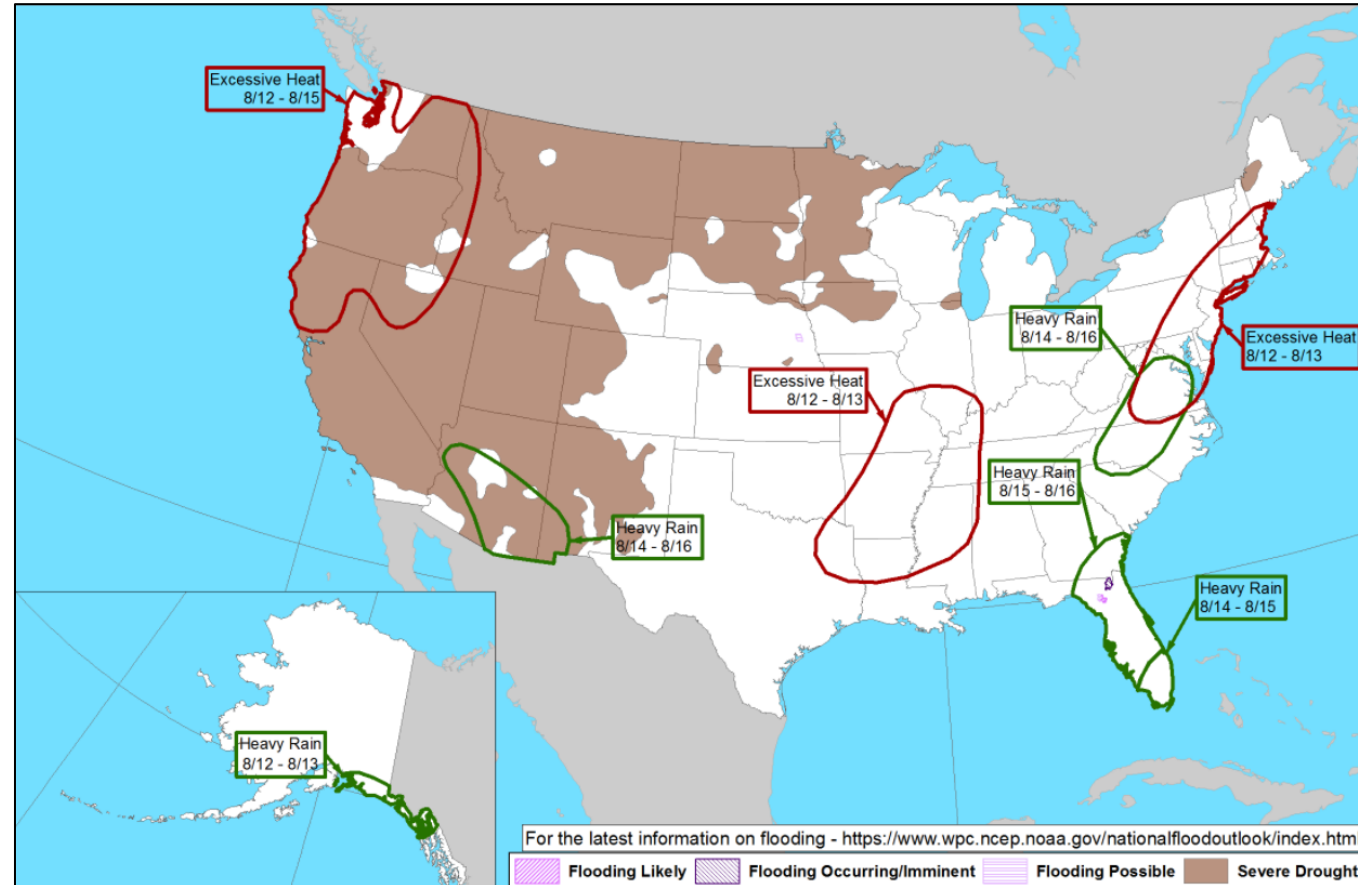
Severe Weather Outlook



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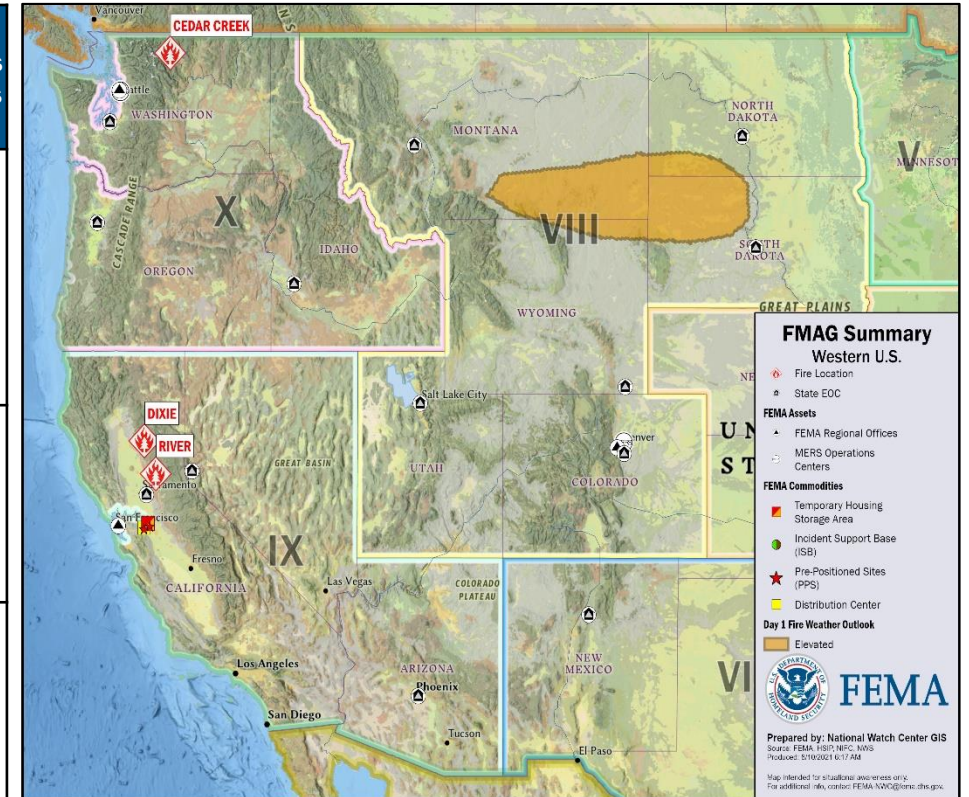

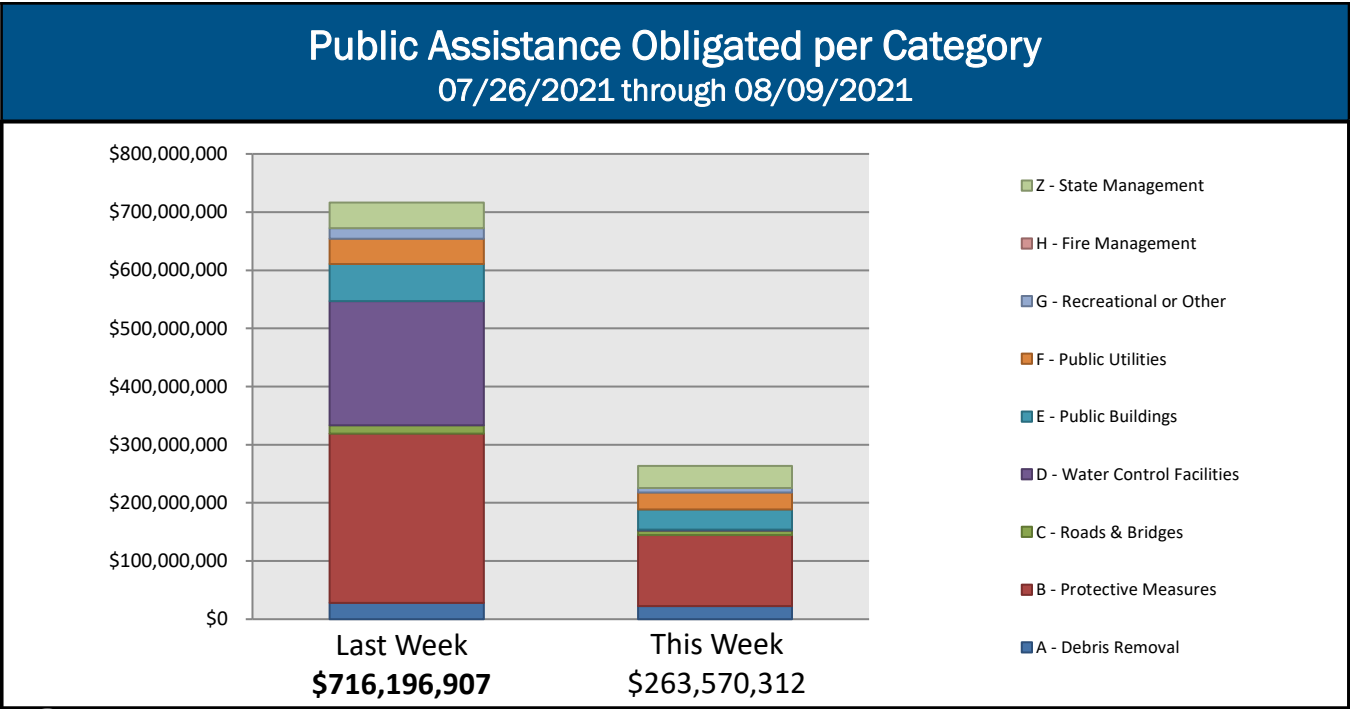

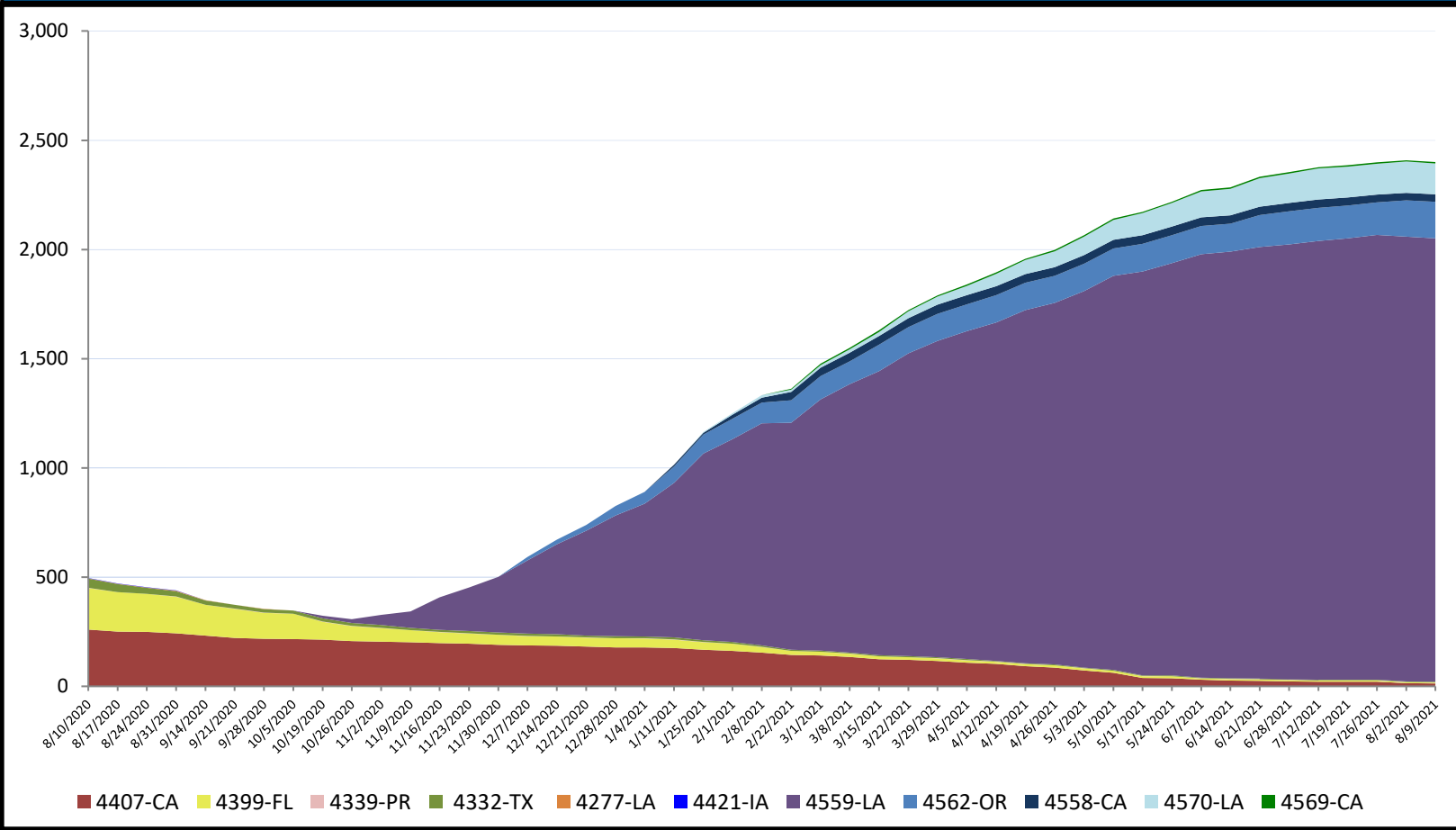

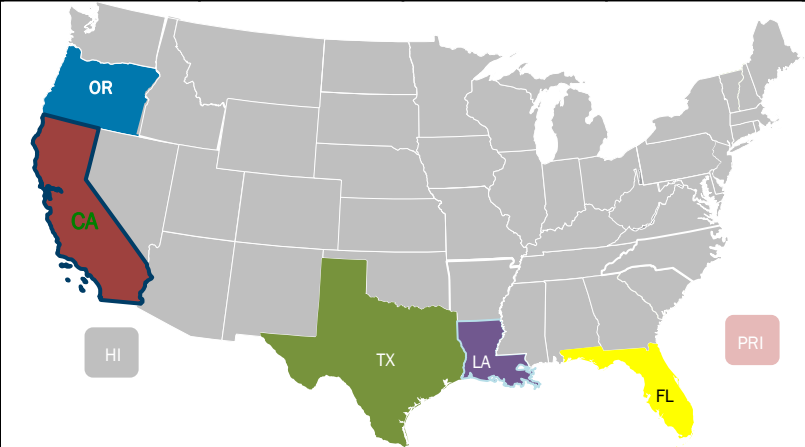

Past Year per Week, 08/10/2020 – 08/09/2021. There are currently **2,400** Households Occupying **2,452** Temporary Units.

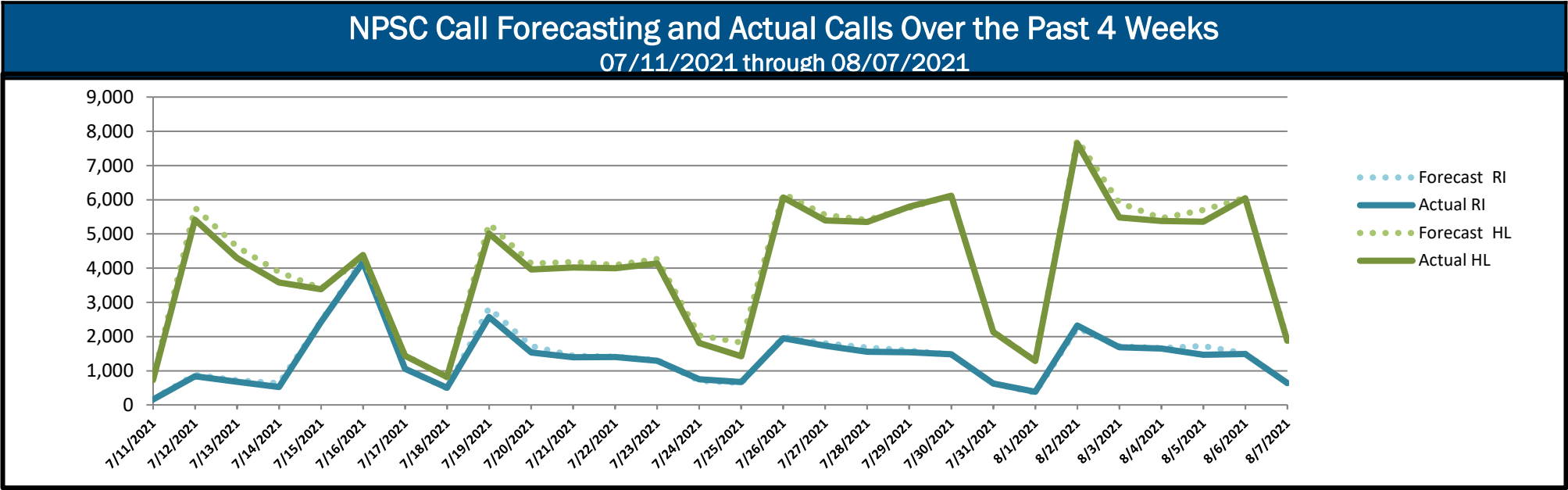

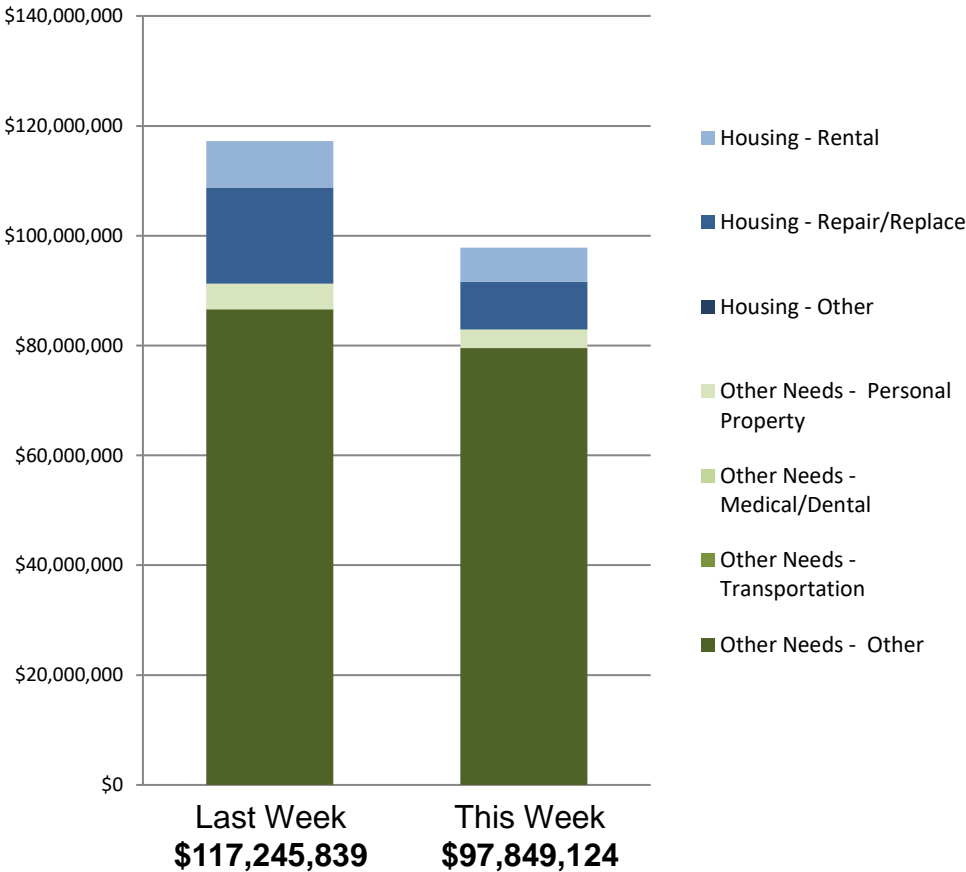
