



Disturbance 2 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)


- 250 miles SSE of the Outer Banks, NC

- Formation chance: 48 hours: Low (10%); 5 days: Low (20%)




National Weather Forecast






Severe Weather Outlook








Post-Tropical Cyclone Nicholas 7-DAY FLOOD HAZARD OUTLOOK




