


Tropical Outlook - Five Day

 No new tropical cyclones expected during the next five days


Eastern Pacific



Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located 900 miles SW of the southern tip of the Baja California peninsula
- Moving NW at 10-15 mph
- Tropical cyclone could form in 2 or 3 days
- Formation chance: 48 hours: Low (30%); 5 days: Med (50%)

Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located a few hundred miles SW of the Cabo Verde Islands
- Moving W at 10-15 mph
- Tropical depression is likely to form by Thursday or Friday
- Formation chance: 48 hours: Med (50%); 5 days: High (90%)

Disturbance 2 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)


- 700 miles west-northwest of the westernmost Azores
- Formation chance: 48 hours: Low (20%); 5 days: Med (40%)



Tropical Storm Peter

Situation (Advisory #11 as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

- 105 miles NNW of the Northern Leeward Islands
- Moving W at 12 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 50 mph
- Slow weakening is forecast during next few days
- Tropical-storm-force winds extend outward up to 175 miles
- Rainfall around the southern periphery of Peter could produce rainfall totals of 1-4 inches with locally higher amounts possible across the Virgin Islands and Puerto Rico






Tropical Storm Rose

Situation (Advisory #9 as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

- 880 miles WNW of the Cabo Verde Islands
- Moving NW at 20 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 45 mph
- Tropical-storm-force winds extend outward up to 90 miles
- Continued slow weakening is expected during the next few days





Tropical Storm Peter - Final

<u>Situation:</u> On the forecast track, Peter is expected to pass north of the <u>Virgin Islands and Puerto Rico today</u>. Rainfall around the southern periphery could produce rainfall totals of 1-4 inches with locally higher amounts possible across the Virgin Islands and Puerto Rico could lead to areas of urban and small stream flooding.



FEMA Region II:

- Region 2 RRCC deactivated and rostered; all ESFs 1, 2, 3, 8, 12, 14, & DC released
- Region 2 IMAT A & B, DEC, LNOs, Virgin Islands and PR Light Force Packages, all ESF and DCE demobilized; IMAT A & B will remain for in USVI and PR for training


FEMA/Federal:

- NRCC at Level III (COVID); postured to support increased staffing, if required
- Region V IMAT deployed to DC Caribbean in Puerto Rico
- National IMAT Blue, National IMAT Gold, and two back-up Regional IMATs available
- SMT and ISB teams deployed to Puerto Rico
- FEMA NWC coordinating reporting and awareness with Region II and NHC










