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# National Current Ops / Monitoring

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## New Significant Incidents/Ongoing Ops:

- COVID-19
- Tornado – Jefferson County, AL

## Hazard Monitoring:

- Heavy rain and flash flooding possible – northern and central CA
- Heavy snow possible – Pacific Northwest to Northern Intermountain, California, Central Great Basin, and Southwest
- Freezing rain possible – Lower/Middle Mississippi Valleys; Great Lakes to Mid-Atlantic

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# Tornado – Jefferson County, AL

## Situation:

- At 11:51 p.m. ET a large tornado touched down near Fultondale (pop. 9k), a suburb 8 miles north of Birmingham (pop. 210k) in Jefferson County, AL. Tornado stretched 10 miles, from Fultondale to Center Point, AL.

## Lifeline Impacts:

### Safety & Security:

- Media reports 2 hotels, mobile home park in Center Point, Fultondale High School, and multiple businesses damaged; several homes possibly collapsed

### Health and Medical


- Media reports one possible fatality and 20 injuries, several critically injured

### Energy:

- 5,900 customers without power in Jefferson County (peak 9,500) (DOE Eagle-I as of 6:15 a.m. ET)

### Transportation

- Several local, state and interstate roads impassable



## State / Local Response:

- AL EOC at Partial Activation (COVID)
- AL EMA survey teams will be sent to the area at daybreak and once it is deemed safe
- AL has not requested FEMA assistance





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
# National Weather Forecast



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
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# Forecast Snowfall

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





Past Year per Week, 01/27/2020 – 01/25/2021. There are currently **1165** Households Occupying **1165** Temporary Units.






