Winter Storm - Midwest to Eastern U.S.

<u>Situation</u>: A complex storm system will impact the Mid Atlantic, Northeast, and New England today through Tuesday. Primary threats include heavy snowfall, ice accretion (up to .25 inches), and gusting winds. As of 7:00 p.m. ET yesterday, over 100 million Americans are under a Winter Weather Warning, Watch, or Advisory


Potential Impacts:

- Snow:
 - o 4-8 inches in major cities within the I-95 corridor from DC to NYC
 - o 6-12 inches expected for areas west of I-95
 - 12 inches or more expected near northern MD, eastern PA, and into northern NJ
 - o 8 inches or more forecast from the Chicago and Milwaukee metro areas to northern IN and OH
- Travel will be dangerous to impossible due to low visibility and drifting snow
- Freezing rain and sleet could lead to scattered power outages

State/Local Preparations:

- Region I:
 - o CT, ME, and NH EOCs at Full Activation (COVID-19)
 - o MA, RI, and VT EOCs at Partial Activation (COVID-19)
- Region II:
 - o NY & NJ EOCs at Partial Activation (COVID-19)
- Region III:
 - PA EOC at Full Activation (COVID-19)
 - DC, DE and VA EOCs at Partial Activation (COVID-19); MD EOC at Partial Activation (winter storm and COVID-19)
 - WV EOC at Monitoring (COVID-19)
- Region V:
 - o IL, MN, & WI: Full Activation (COVID-19)
 - o IN, MI, & OH: Partial Activation (COVID-19)






FEMA Response:


- NRCC at Level I (COVID-19)








Snow and Ice Accumulation Outlooks




Forecast Snowfall



Ice Accumulation Forecast




Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall






Atlantic River Flood and Precipitation Forecast




72-hour Precipitation Forecast




Long Range Outlooks - Feb 5 - 9



6-10 Day Temperature Probability







6-10 Day Precipitation Probability


