Hazard Monitoring: New Significant Incidents/Ongoing Ops: Heavy snow possible - Mid-Atlantic to Northeast COVID-19 Freezing rain possible - Central Appalachians to Mid-Atlantic Winter Storm - Mid-Atlantic to Northeast **Disaster Declaration Activity: Event Monitoring:** None None



















Situation: Heavy snow likely to exceed 12 inches across the Northeast. Light periods of snow, sleet, and mixed precipitation today across the Great Lakes, and from the Ohio and Tennessee Valleys to the Northeast.

Lifeline Impacts:

Health and Medical

- Hazardous travel conditions and power outages could impact state vaccination effort but there are no delayed delivery notices on vaccination shipments
- Testing and vaccination sites
 - Region I: Vaccination schedules may need to be modified due to closed vaccination sites but there is enough capacity to get them administered within the week
 - Region II:
 - NJ; all 6 mega sites closed today; vaccinations will be rescheduled
 - NY: State sites are to remain operational at this time
 - NYC: appointments for vaccines canceled for today and rescheduled
 - Region III:
 - DC: vaccine sites closed today and appointments for vaccines rescheduled
 - MD & VA: some appointments for vaccines canceled for today and rescheduled
 - WV: vaccines will be distributed on Tuesday, clinics open on Wednesday
 - Region V: no major impact to COVID sites


Minimal power outages (DOE Eagle-I)

Transportation

- Amtrak modified schedule across the Northeast
- Minor flight delays across the impacted area (FAA)
- Region I:
 - MA: vehicle restrictions on highways



- Region II:
 - NJ: commercial vehicle travel restrictions on multiple interstate highways
 - □ NJ buses, rail (except Atlantic City Rail), light rail and access link service suspended today
- Region III:
 - PA: restricted speed limits and vehicle restrictions on numerous highways



- Region I:
 - o CT, ME, and NH EOCs at Full Activation (COVID-19)
 - o MA, RI, and VT EOCs at Partial Activation (COVID-19)
- · Region II:
 - o NY EOC at Partial Activation (COVID-19); NJ EOC at Partial Activation (COVID-19 and winter storm)
 - NJ Governor declared a state of emergency
- Region III:
 - o PA EOC at Full Activation (COVID-19 and winter storm)
 - DC and VA EOCs at Partial Activation (COVID-19); MD and DE EOCs at Partial Activation (winter storm and COVID-19)
 - o DC and Philadelphia declared snow emergencies
 - WV EOC at Monitoring (COVID-19)
- Region V:
 - o IL, MN, & WI: Full Activation (COVID-19)
 - o IN, MI, & OH: Partial Activation (COVID-19)


FEMA Response:

- NRCC at Level I (COVID-19)
- NWC is monitoring and is in coordination with NRCC, all affected Regional Watches, NWS, HHS SOC, DOE, DOT, and CISA
- Region I RRCC at Level II (COVID-19); Maynard MOC is monitoring
- Region II, III, and V RRCCs at Level III (COVID-19);
- Region II & V RWCs working from alternate location (winter storm); RWCs are monitoring and are in contact with State EOCs
- No requests for FEMA assistance and no unmet needs







COVID-19 Weekly Update (CDC data, as of January 31)

Daily Trends of COVID-19 Deaths




National Inpatient Beds Used - COVID-19 Patients



- FEMA NRCC activated to Level I in support of COVID-19 operations




COVID-19 Vaccine Weekly Update (CDC data, as of January 31)

- Doses Administered in Long-Term Care Facilities: 3,683,718 (+1,116,700)


U.S. COVID-19 Vaccine Administration by Vaccine Type










Snow and Ice Accumulation Outlooks




Forecast Snowfall



Ice Accumulation Forecast




Long Range Outlooks - Feb 6 - 10



6-10 Day Temperature Probability







6-10 Day Precipitation Probability


