Winter Storm - Midwest to Northeastern U.S. - FINAL @@@@@@@@

<u>Current Situation</u>: The powerful nor'easter that produced 20 to 30 inches of snow over portions of Northeast U.S. continues to move toward the Canadian Maritimes. This storm resulted in widespread travel and business disruptions; however, no major power outages or property damage have yet been reported/identified.

<u>Lifeline Impacts</u>:

Health and Medical:

- Testing and vaccination sites
- Region II: NJ & NY: all resumed operations
- o Region III: DC, VA, & MD: expected to re-open today


Energy: Minimal power outages across the impacted Regions (DOE Eagle-I)

All State EOCs have deactivated for this event


FEMA Response:





Forecast Snowfall






Ice Accumulation Forecast





