A North Dakota Game and Fish Department Grant Program to Assist with the Development of High School Clay Target League Teams

The Game and Fish Department is offering grant dollars to help with start-up costs for new high school clay target shooting teams that are forming in the current calendar year. (This is a separate fund from the grant that Game and Fish has established to provide larger grants for clay target shooting infrastructure development, and is also separate from the Encouraging Tomorrow's Hunters event grant)

1) Who can apply grant funds?

Teams that are forming to participate in the ND High School Clay Target League. (team can include individuals who have competed in the past, but must be a newly formed team in the current year)

2) What is eligible for funding?

Grant funds can be used to reimburse teams for the following expenses: a) hearing protection b) eye protection c) shooting apparel such as vests, team shirts, hats d) magnetic barrel rests e) shell pouches. Grant funds will cover 75% of the costs of the above items, up to a **maximum of \$1000** (Ex: if expenses are \$800 total, the grant will reimburse \$600).

3) What is **not** eligible for funding or reimbursement.

Food, beverages, targets, ammunition.

4) Grant Process

Applications must be submitted to Marty Egeland at 100 N. Bismarck Expressway by April 1. Successful and unsuccessful applicants will be contacted by April 15.

5) Fund Reimbursement Process

Reimbursement is provided after the event and contingent upon the following being provided to the Department prior to December 31: 1) Receipts for reimbursable items 2) photographs of team 3) A brief written report highlighting the event/activity on how it went. 4) List of youth names and ages that participated.

6) Indemnification and Insurance Coverage Requirements Indemnication

The state and grantee each agrees to assume its own liability for any and all claims of any nature including all costs, expenses and attorneys' fees which may in any manner result from, or arise, out of this agreement. Insurance

Grantee shall secure and keep in force during the term of this agreement, from insurance companies, government self-insurance pools or government self-retention funds, authorized to do business in North Dakota, the following insurance coverages:

- a) Commercial general liability, including premises or operations, contractual, and products or completed operations coverage (if applicable), with minimum liability limits of \$250,000 per person and \$1,000,000 per occurrence.
- b) Automobile liability, including owned (if any), hired, and non-owned automobiles, with minimum liability limits of \$250,000 per person and \$1,000,000 per occurrence.
- c) Workers compensation coverage, if applicable, meeting all statutory requirements

(Grants will be prioritized according to the proceeding criteria. Any grants failing to meet the minimum requirements may be rejected.)
