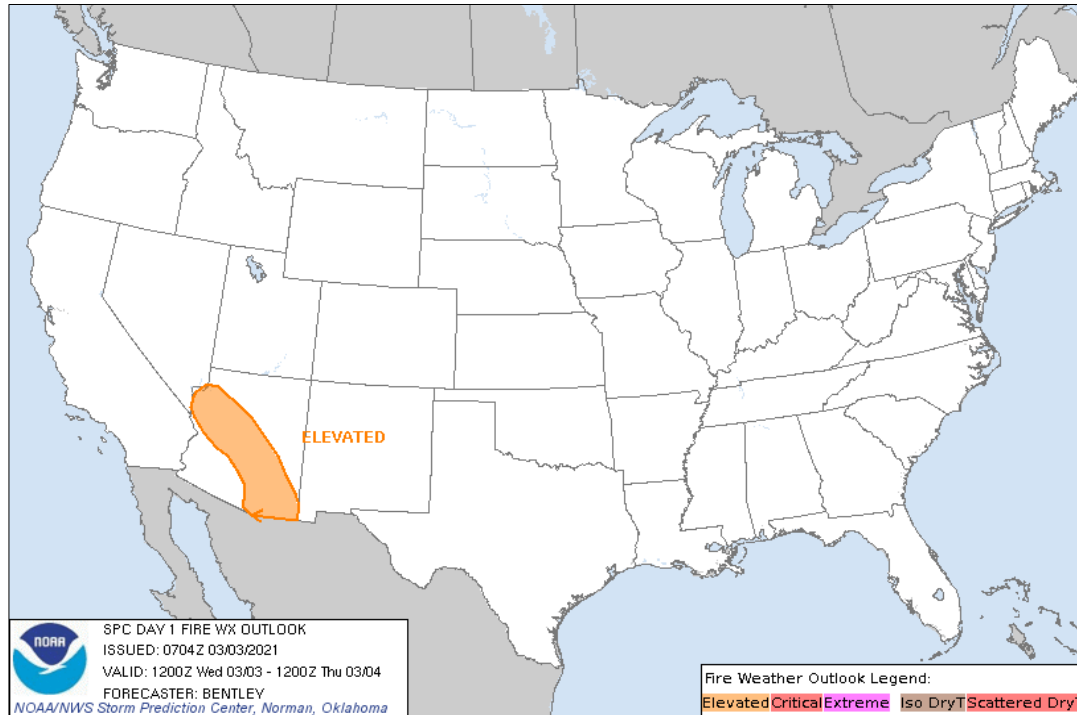
National Weather Forecast



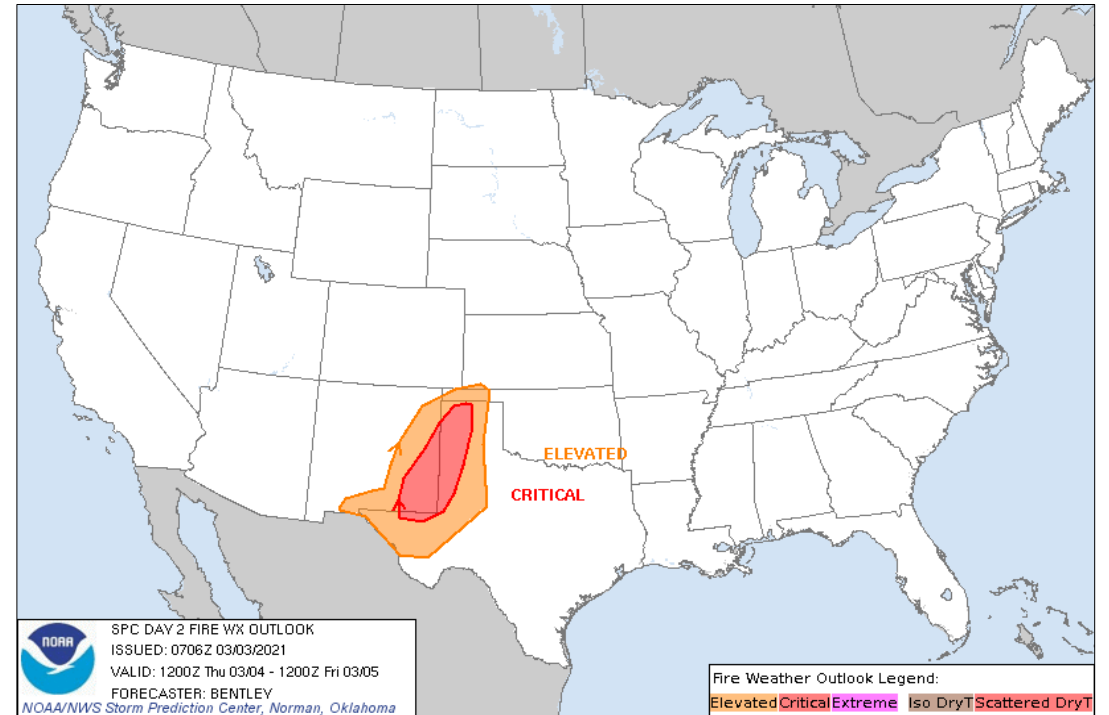

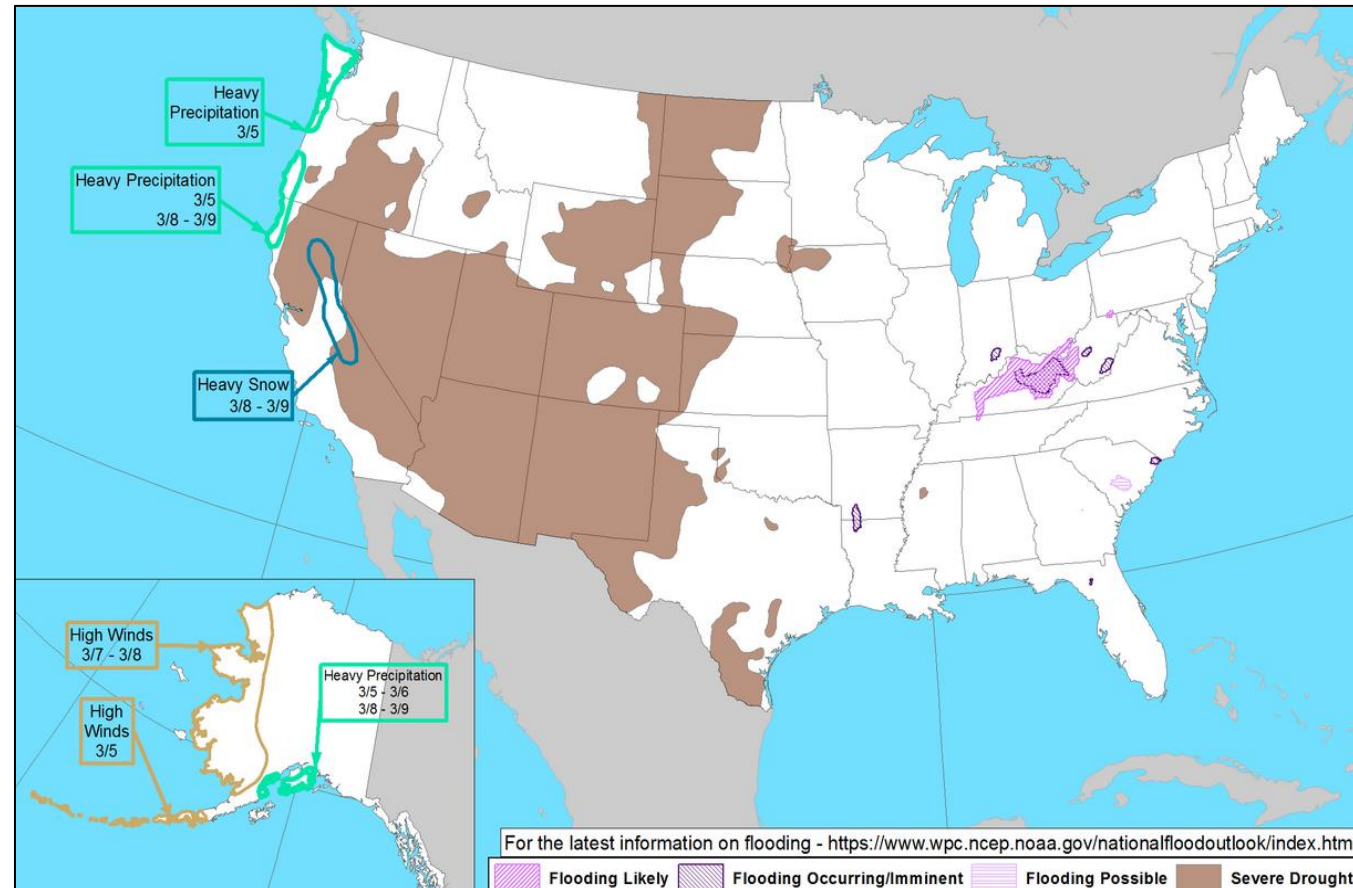

Hazards Outlook – Mar 5 - 9

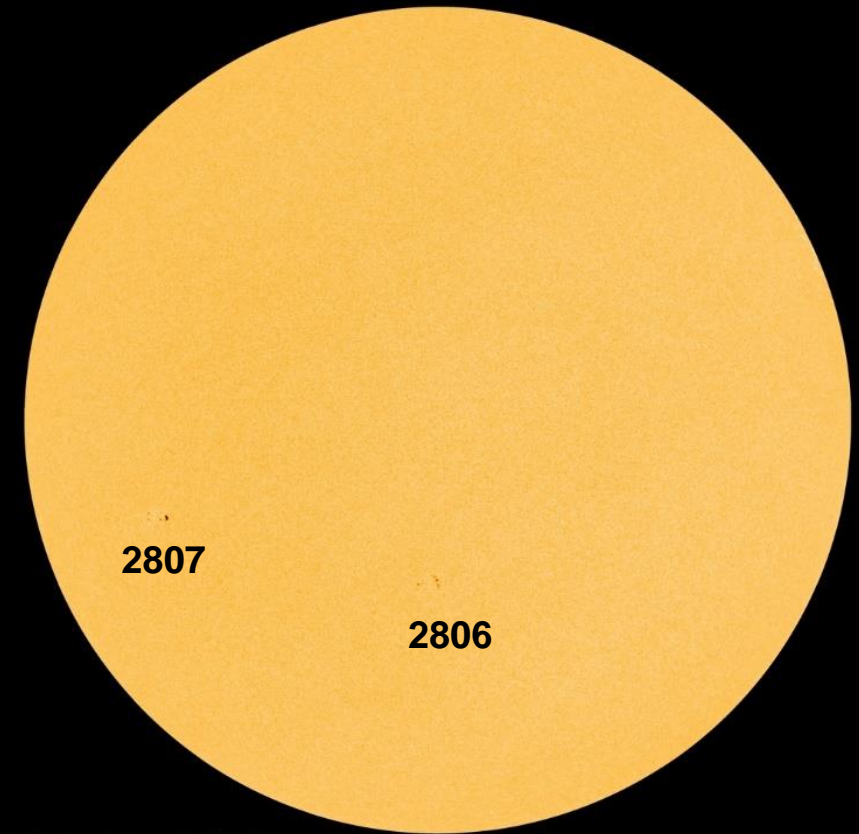

Space Weather Summary/Outlook

Space Weather Type	Past 48 Hours	Forecast: Mar 3	Forecast: Mar 4
Solar Flare (Radio Blackout) R Scale	None	1%	1%
Solar Radiation Storms S Scale	None	1%	1%
Geomagnetic Storms G Scale	G2	G1	None

- Quiet across the R and S scales.
- One small, inactive spot group.
- Energetic particles (electrons) normal, high anticipated.
- Solar wind parameters are enhanced due to influences of a coronal hole high speed stream; G-1 (Minor) storming expected.
- Severe or extreme activity is very unlikely at this time.

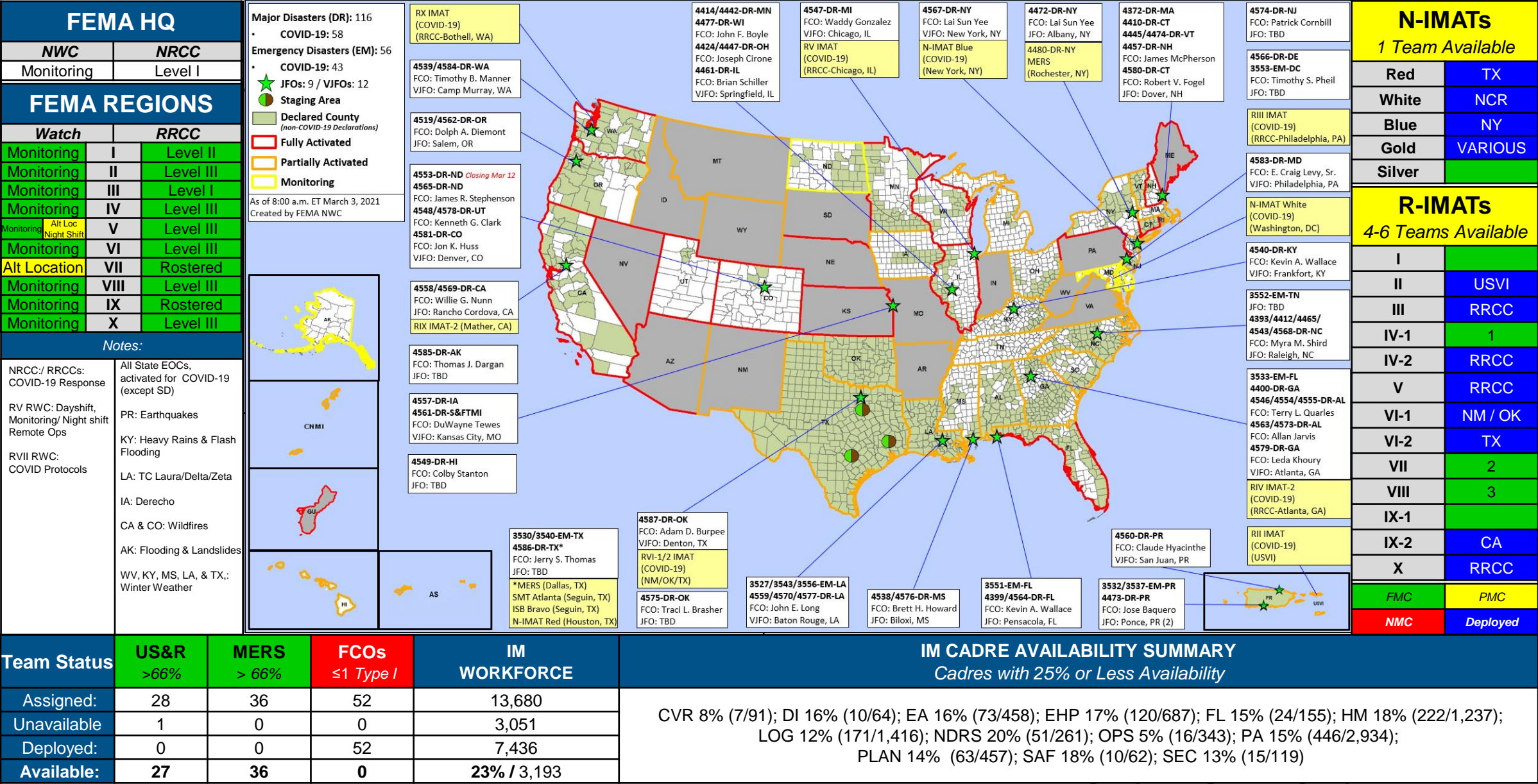
