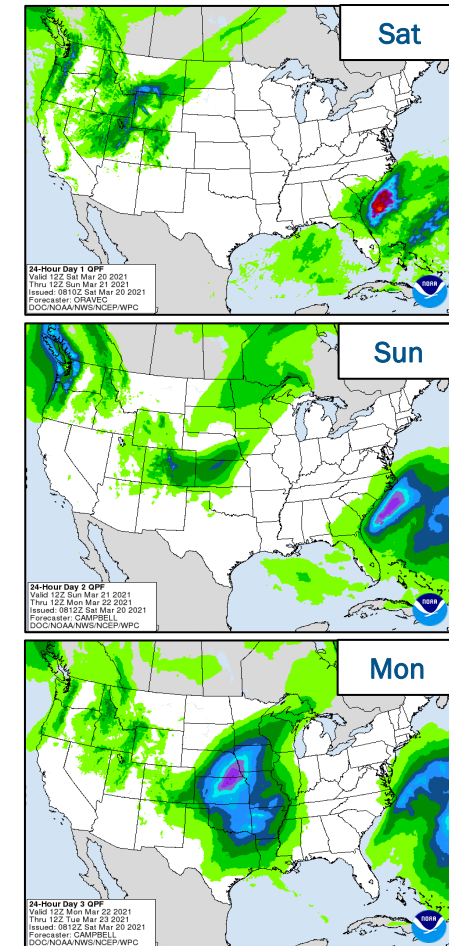
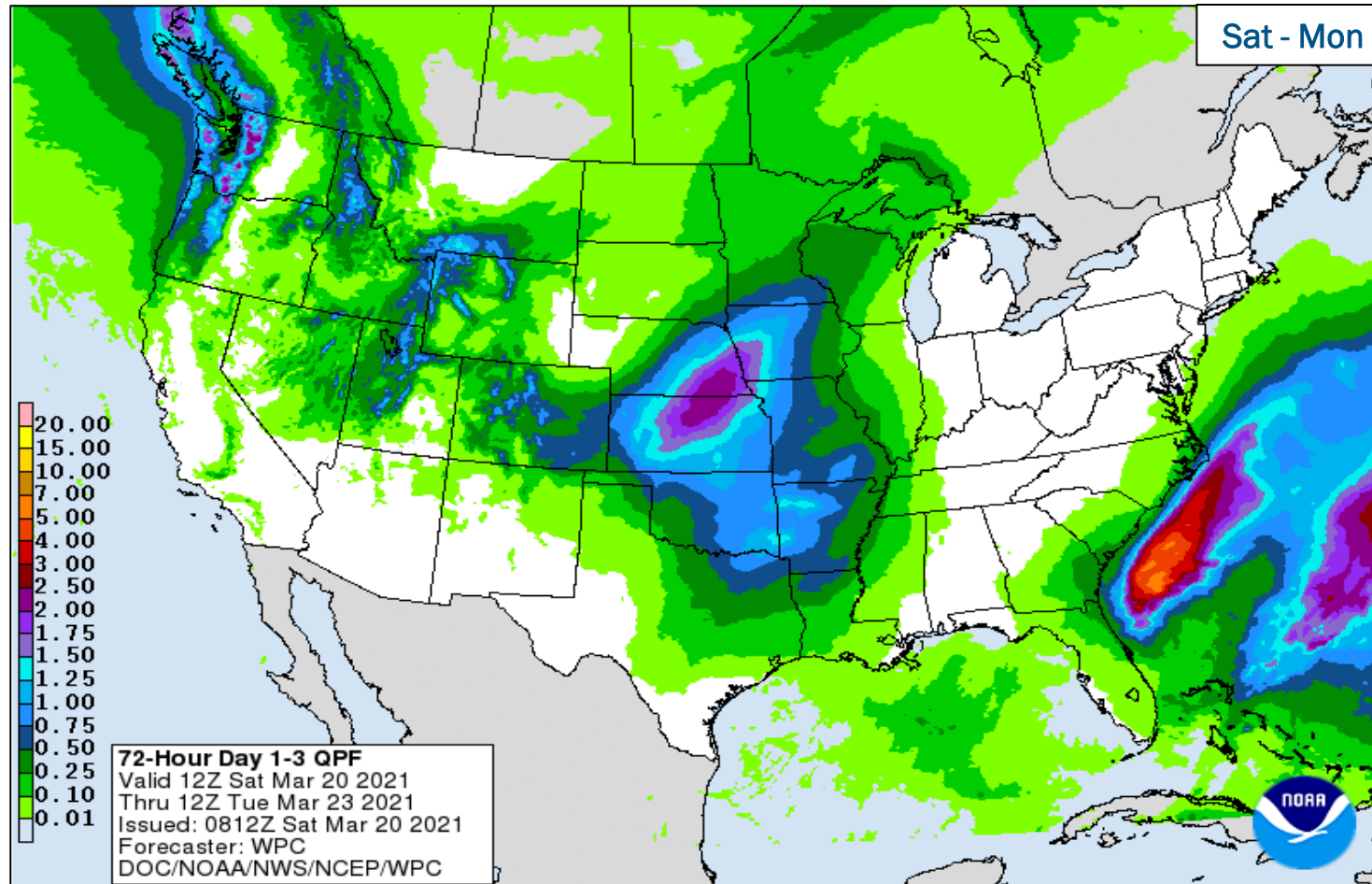
# National Weather Forecast

# Precipitation Forecast

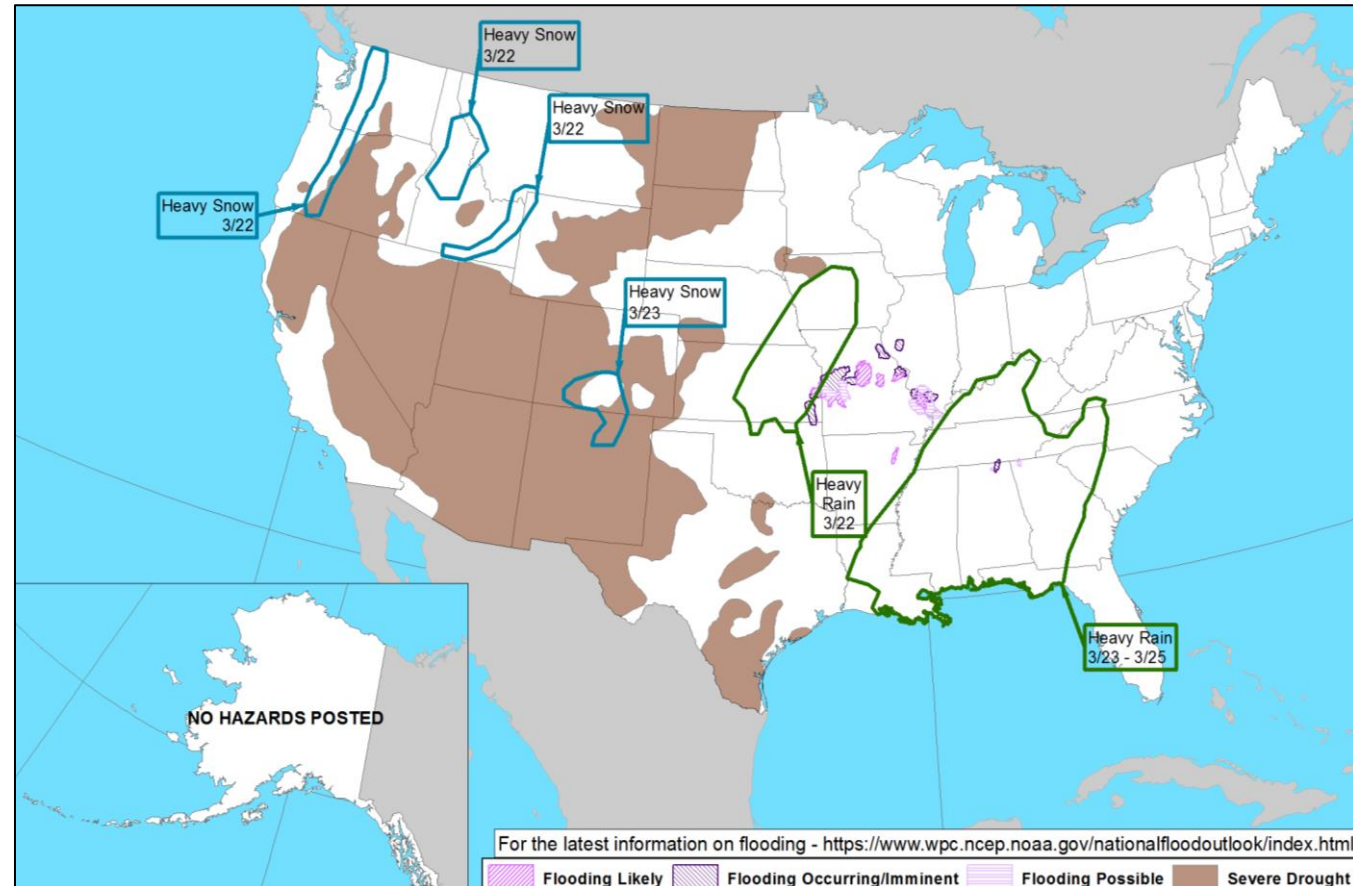

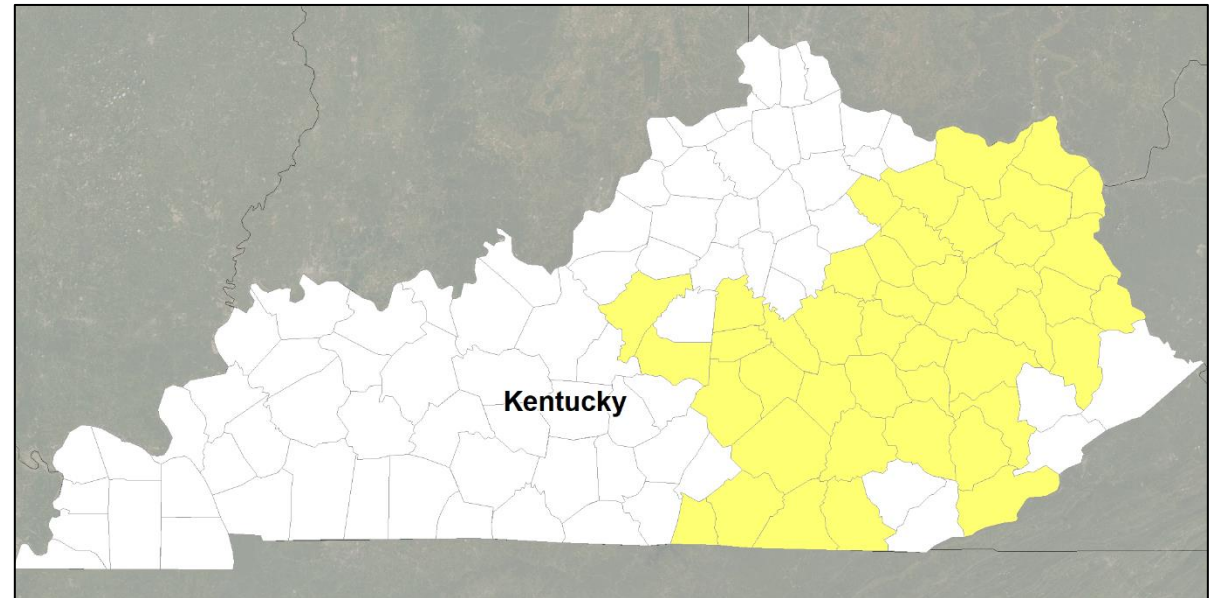
