# National Current Ops / Monitoring

### New Significant Incidents / Ongoing Ops:

- COVID-19
- Potential severe weather outbreak Lower Mississippi and Tennessee valleys (High Risk)

### **Hazard Monitoring:**

- Severe thunderstorms possible Southern Plains to Middle Mississippi and Ohio valleys and Southeast
- Heavy rain and flash flooding possible Middle Mississippi Valley; Tennessee Valley to Southern Appalachians
- Freezing rain possible Great Lakes

### Potential Severe Weather Outbreak – Lower MS/TN Valleys

#### **Current Situation**

Possible tornado outbreak is forecast into early this evening across parts of the Southeast into the Tennessee Valley. Several long-track strong (EF2+) tornadoes, destructive winds (75 mph+) and very large hail (2"+) are forecast from the Lower Mississippi Valley across parts of the Southeast and into the Tennessee and Ohio valleys. Storms are likely to begin midday from southeast AR into northeast LA and into southwest MS.

#### **State Preparations/Response**

- AL EOC: Partial Activation (COVID); will increase to higher Partial Activation level at 1:00 p.m. ET
- MS, TN & AR EOCs at Partial Activation (COVID)
- KY & LA EOCs at Monitoring (COVID)


#### Federal Preparations/Response

#### Region IV

- Region IV will go to Enhanced Watch at 10:00 a.m. ET; RRCC at Level III (COVID)
- IMAT-1 is available, IMAT-2 deployed for COVID response but can re-deploy if needed
- 13 federal CVC sites in the Moderate and Enhanced risk areas
- No shortfalls, or requests for federal assistance




- Region VI at Enhanced Watch (8:00 a.m. to 11:30 p.m. ET); RRCC at Level III (COVID)

- No shortfalls or requests for federal assistance


