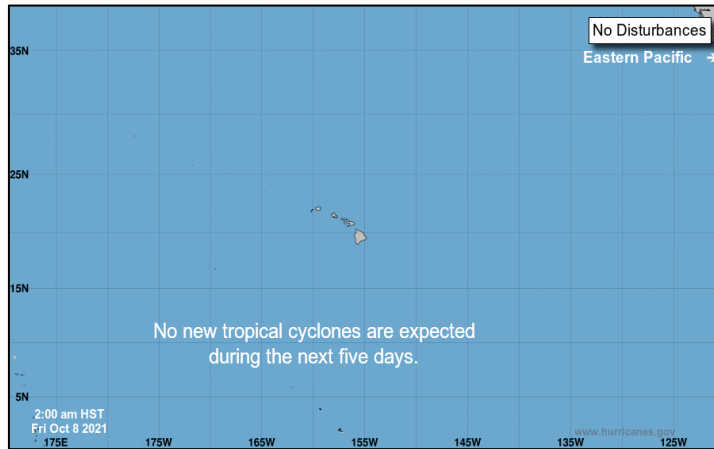

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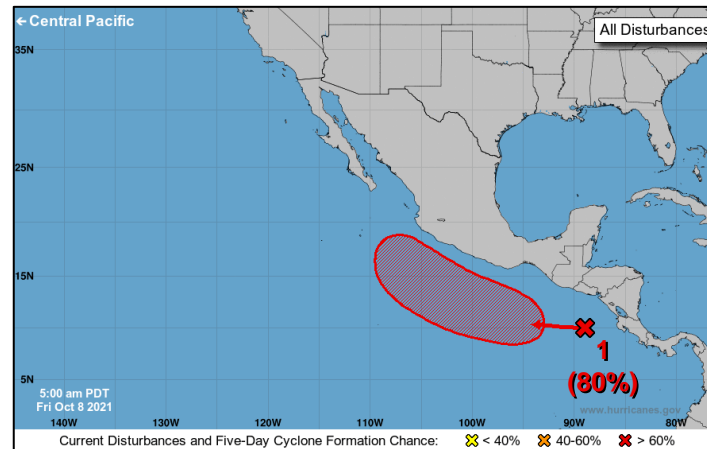
# Tropical Outlook – Five Day

- No new tropical cyclones are expected during the next five days

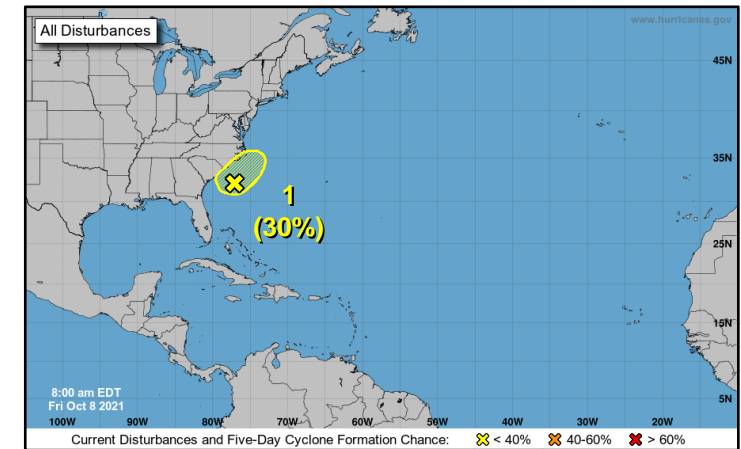
## Eastern Pacific



### Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located a few hundred miles S of the coast of southern Mexico
- Tropical depression is likely to form over the weekend or early next week
- Formation chance: 48 hours: Med (40%); 5 days: High (80%)

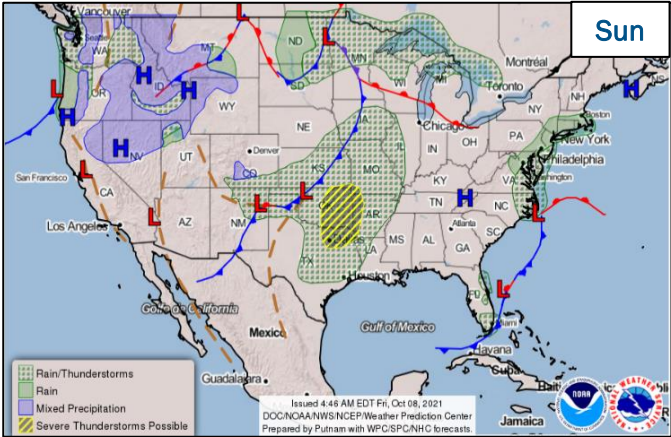
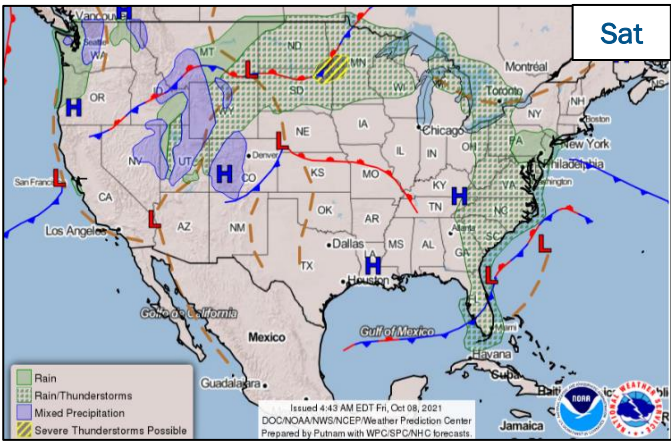
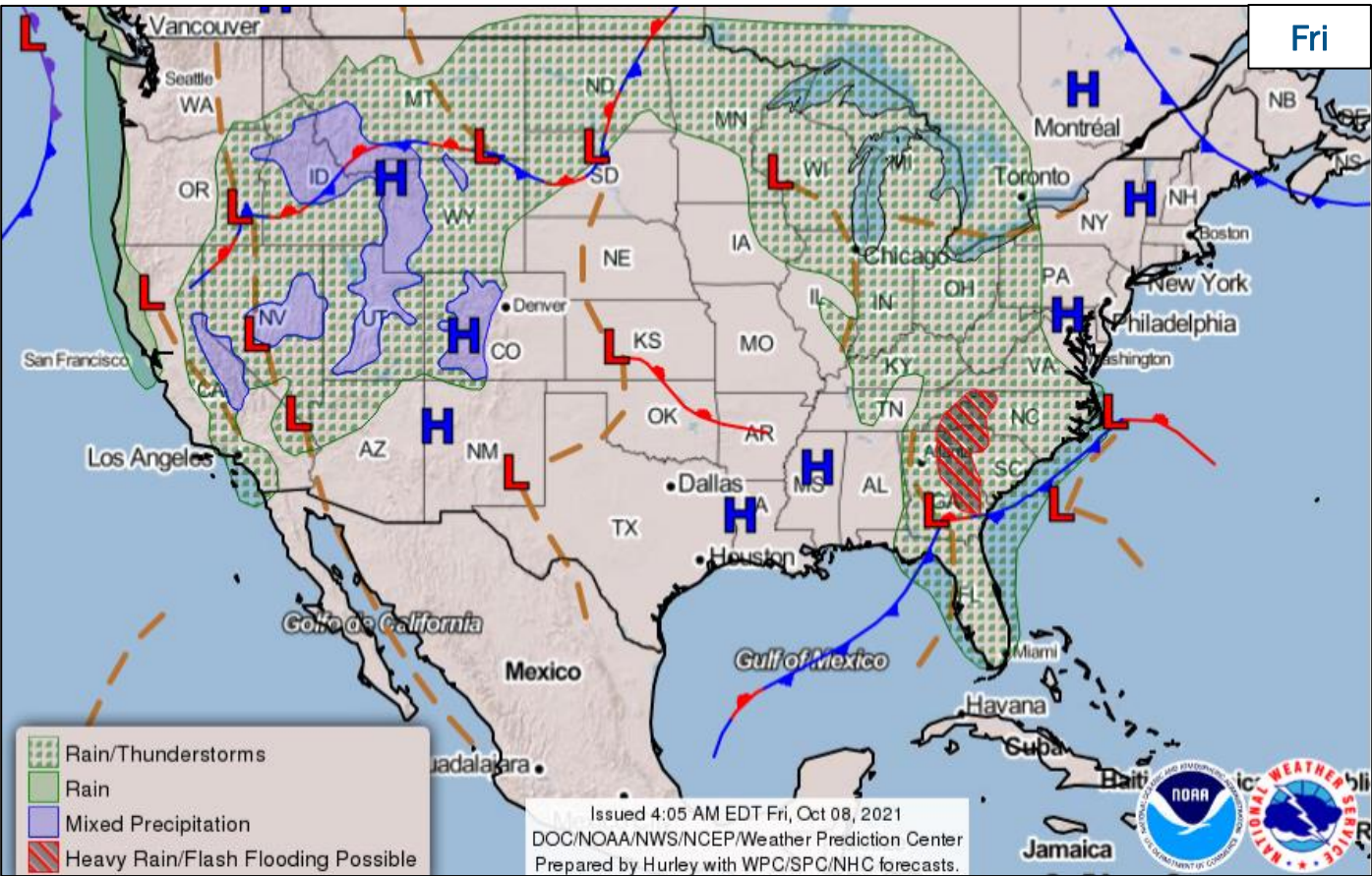
### Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- 150 miles off the coast of South Carolina
- Regardless of development, the system could bring gusty winds and locally heavy rain to eastern portions of the Carolinas through the weekend
- Formation chance: 48 hours: Low (30%); 5 days: Low (30%)



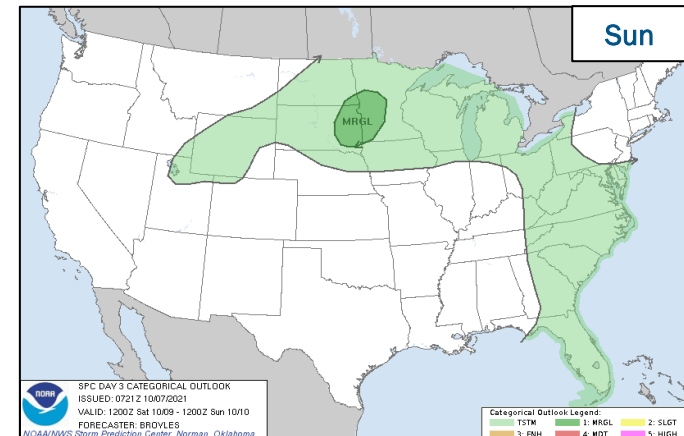
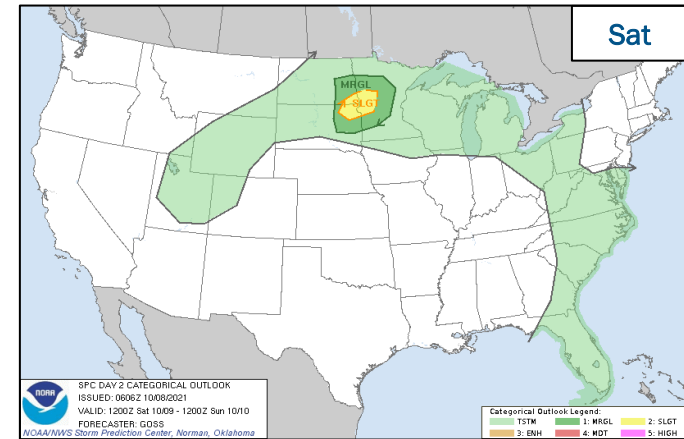
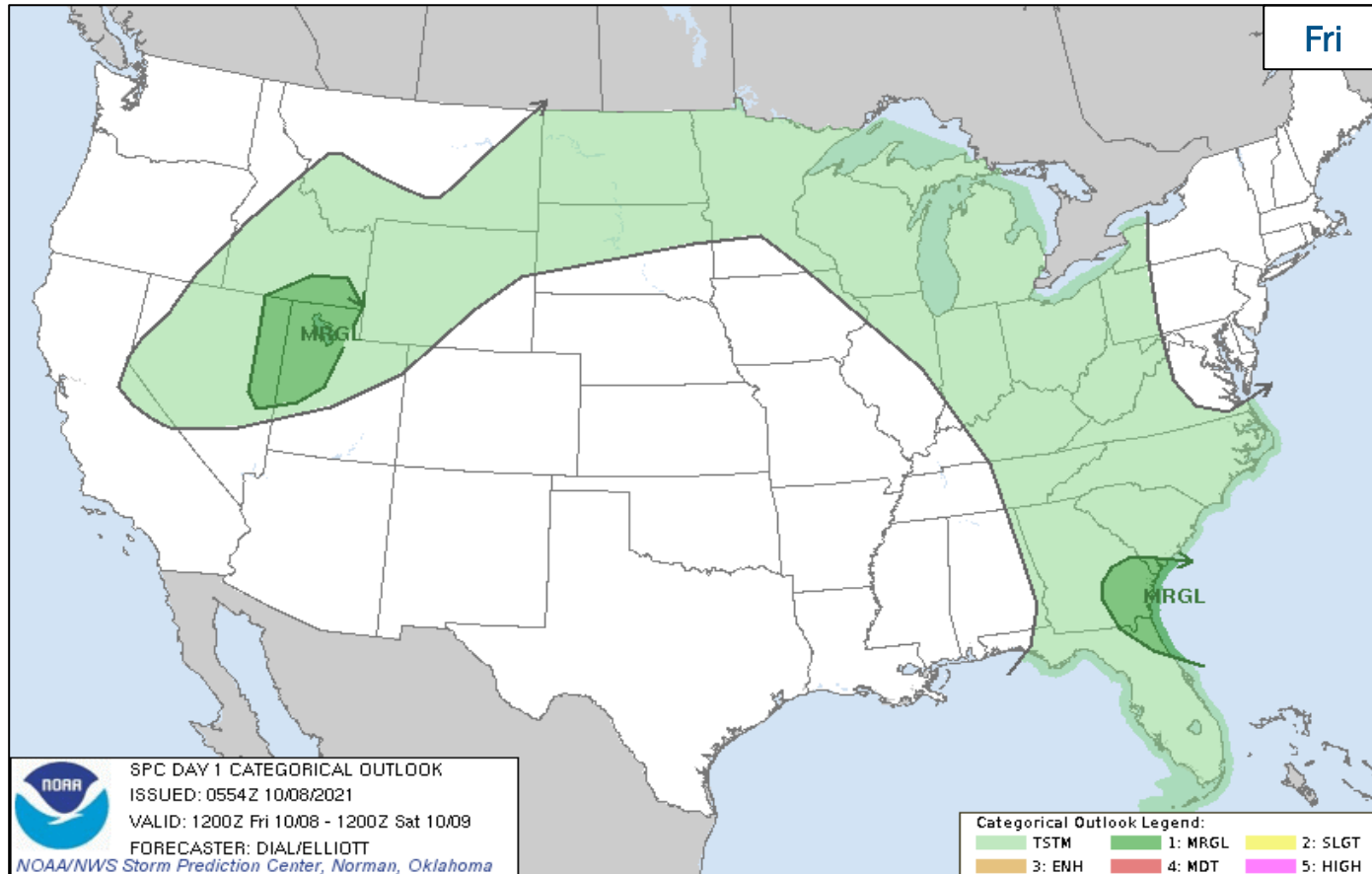

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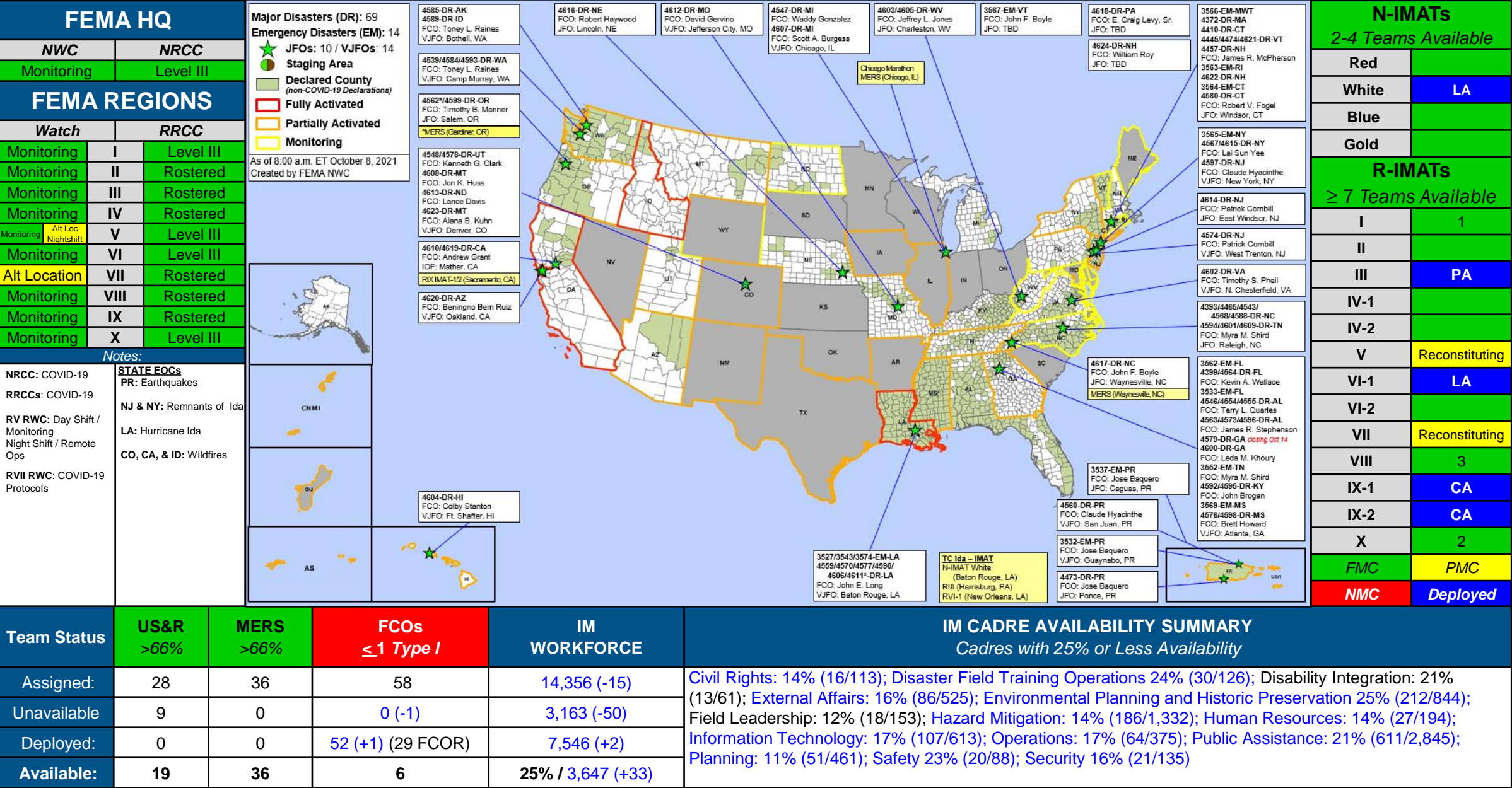
# Declaration Amendments

FEMA-4614-DR-NJ	4	Oct 7	Adds one county for Public Assistance Adds 9 counties for emergency protective measures (Category B), limited to direct Federal assistance and reimbursement for mass care including evacuation and shelter support
