






# Skagit Co. Redistricting Timeline

Very compressed timeline due to delayed release of U.S. Census data





# High-level process flow to Final map

### 1. Data collection - occurs throughout the redistricting process

- Public hearing testimony
- Electronic comments
- District Scenario
   Modeler
- Census data
- Other boundary data
  - School districts
  - Municipalities
  - Neighborhoods
  - Tribal lands



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# Draft maps

- Draft maps were generated by the county redistricting team from the current district boundaries and meet redistricting legal requirements.
- There can be more than one draft map developed by the redistricting team.
- They reflect public input given through testimony at public meetings or submitted electronically to the team.
- No single draft map is <u>expected</u> to become the final map.




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# Final map

- The final map may incorporate elements of one or many draft maps.
- It will reflect public feedback, though you may not see specific comments or ideas in the final map.
- County redistricting team members will focus on what they've heard on how to prioritize redistricting criteria.
- There is no perfect map!



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# Redistricting Criteria

- > RCW 29A.76.010 Counties, municipal corporations, and special purpose districts.
- (a) Each internal director, council, or commissioner district shall be as nearly equal
  in population as possible to each and every other such district comprising the
  municipal corporation, county, or special purpose district.
- o (b) Each district shall be as compact as possible.
- o (c) Each district shall consist of **geographically contiguous area**.
- (d) Population data may not be used for purposes of favoring or disfavoring any racial group or political party.
- (e) To the extent feasible and if not inconsistent with the basic enabling legislation for the municipal corporation, county, or district, the district boundaries shall coincide with existing recognized natural boundaries and shall, to the extent possible, preserve existing communities of related and mutual interest.
