RESOLUTION REGARDING CREATION OF A PROGRAM FOR DISPOSAL OF FLOOD-RELATED DEBRIS

WHEREAS, The Board of Skagit County Commissioners declared a state of emergency due to heavy rainfall and flooding effective October 28, 2021; by Resolution No. R20210227; and

WHEREAS, significant flooding has occurred along the Skagit River and Samish River; and

WHEREAS, the general public's health and welfare is threatened by refuse created as a result of the flooding and it is in the best interest of Skagit County to provide cost-effective disposal options for non-commercial Skagit County residents that have been affected by flooding.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, by the Board of Skagit County Commissioners that a program be established to allow for the disposal of flood-related debris at no cost to non-commercial Skagit County residents that have been affected by flooding; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the voucher program will begin on November 20, 2021, and extend until December 31, 2021.


