Testing requirements and methods of enforcement of testing requirements for cannabinoids, including artificially derived cannabinoids, to protect the public health and safety

Changes to state law to support the regulation of intoxicating cannabis-derived products and artificially derived cannabinoids (continued from last meeting)

- What portions of the secondary market supply chain should be licensed?
 - Secondary product manufacturing (in-state)
 - Importing cannabinoid hemp from out-of-state (License held by instate recipient or out-of-state sender?)
 - Wholesale/distribution of cannabinoid hemp (in-state)
 - o Retail sales of cannabinoid hemp:
 - In-state businesses?
 - Out-of-state businesses selling direct to in-state consumers?
- Are additional resources needed to handle additional volume of licenses?
- Is some type of track and trace system needed for import/export/wholesale of bulk cannabinoid hemp materials?
- Is some type of track and trace system needed for finished products to associate test results to batches and labels?
- For each of these, should it be a single source for maintaining data (like CTS), or would GMP (or GMP-like) recordkeeping requirements be adequate. If the latter, how should businesses failing to keep adequately traceable records be handled?
