Save on Home Internet

There is a new federal program available to help families have access to affordable high-speed internet. The Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP) provides eligible households up to \$30/month off internet bills (or \$75/month on Tribal lands), as well as a one-time \$100 discount off a laptop, tablet, or computer. To further lower costs, the Biden-Harris Administration secured commitments from internet service providers across the country to offer high-speed plans that are fully covered by the ACP — meaning millions of working families can now get high-speed internet without paying a dime.

You are eligible if any *one* of these of these applies:

- A member of your household participates in:
 - Free and Reduced-Prices School Lunch or Breakfast Program
 - Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)
 - Medicaid
 - Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants, and Children (WIC)
 - Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
 - Federal Public Housing Assistance
 - Veterans Pension and Survivors Benefit
 - Federal Pell Grant (Current year)
 - Tribal assistance programs, including Bureau of Indian Affairs General Assistance, Tribal Head Start, Tribal Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (Tribal TANF), Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations
- Your household income is 200% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines or less, <u>OR</u>
- Your household qualifies for a participating provider's existing low-income plan.
