## ZERO TO THREE's Diagnostic Classification of Mental Health and Developmental Disorders of Infancy and Early Childhood (DC:0-5™)

The DC:0-5™ (compatible with the DSM-5 and the ICD-10 and ICD-11) is the only developmentally sensitive, multi-axial classification system for diagnosing mental health and developmental disorders in infants and young children. This is a complex process that requires dyadic assessment of caregivers and children, recognition of the different developmental expressions of mental health symptoms, and awareness of cultural considerations.

### The current training is for licensed providers only.

Future trainings will be offered for other disciplines working with young children.
