This card is for recording sport-caught fish only, NOT for personal use or subsistence-caught fish.

#### Which fish must be recorded?

For some species, there's a limit to the number of fish you may keep per season. Each area has different limits, seasons, and recording requirements. Read the sport fishing regulations for the waters you fish. Species with an annual limit are listed in the General Regulations section in area sport fish regulation summary books.

## Who is required to have this Harvest Record Card in their possession?

- 1. Alaska resident youth anglers under the age of 18 and nonresident youth anglers under the age of 16;
- 2. Anglers with the ADF&G Senior License (PID); and
- 3. Anglers with the ADF&G Disabled Veteran's License (DAV).

## Can I put someone else's fish on my card?

No. Each sport fish angler must have his or her own harvest record card.

# What happens if I don't have a card and/or don't record my fish?

The fine could be \$100 for not recording a king salmon, PLUS \$100 for not carrying the card, PLUS court costs. In addition, fish and fishing equipment may be subject to forfeit under AS 16.05.190 or AS 16.05.195.

## Do I turn in this card at the end of the year?

No. Carry it with you when fishing and show it if requested by a peace officer or ADF&G representative.

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
