Exceptional Children Parent Survey

Research shows students reach higher levels of achievement when families are actively involved in the education system. As a parent, family member, or guardian of a student with a disability, you know firsthand what is working and what is not. Therefore, each year the Office of Exceptional Children (OEC) gathers feedback from families through a survey. The five largest local educational agencies (LEAs) and select LEAs across the state are provided this survey to pass along to families within their district.

Filling out the survey is completely voluntary. You will not be asked to provide your name or other personally identifiable information. The information is confidential, and we will not share it with anyone. The information from all families will be compiled to create a report about your school system, the state, the efforts to involve families in their children's education and the impact of that involvement on educational results for students with disabilities.

The survey has already been sent from the OEC to LEAs for distribution to their families. If your LEA is listed below and you have not received communication regarding this survey by the end of April, please reach out to your local [EC director](#). Parent responses are due back by July 31, 2023.
