From the Governor of the State of Maryland

LAMAR JACKSON DAY FEBRUARY 11th, 2024

WHEREAS, Lamar Demeatrice Jackson Jr., quarterback for the Baltimore Ravens, has received his second Most Valuable Player Award from the National Football League and becomes only the eleventh quarterback in the history of the NFL to

achieve this remarkable feat; and

WHEREAS, Lamar Jackson received this prestigious award following a season where he led the Baltimore Ravens to the

American Football Conference Championship, threw 3,678 passing yards and completed 24 passing touchdowns, 5 rushing touchdowns, and rushed for 821 yards, the most for any quarterback in the 2023 NFL season; and

WHEREAS, Lamar Jackson this season finished with the fourth highest quarterback passing rating in the NFL at 102.7; and

WHEREAS,

Lamar Jackson has given his all to his play on the field, to his team, to the people of Baltimore and to the State of

Maryland; and

WHEREAS, Lamar Jackson's achievements, work ethic, strength, and leadership on the field and in the community are a shining example of excellence and a dedication that all Marylanders can all be incredibly proud of.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, WES MOORE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND, do hereby proclaim FEBRUARY 11th, 2024 as LAMAR JACKSON DAY and call upon the people of our state to join in this observance.
