STATEMENT OF SUFFICIENCY

On March 19, 2024, Marisol Lynda Rodriguez, Democratic candidate for State Board of Education, District 2, submitted 3,278 petition signatures to the Elections Division of the Secretary of State's office. The candidate seeks nomination by petition to the June 25, 2024 primary election ballot. Under Colorado law, Ms. Rodriguez's petition must contain at least 1,500 valid signatures.¹

¹ Under section 1-4-801(2)(a.5), C.R.S., a major party state board of education for a congressional district candidate petition requires "the lesser of one thousand five hundred signers or signers equal to ten percent of the votes cast in the district at the contested or uncontested primary election for the political party's candidate for the office for which the petition is being circulated . . ."
