- 1. Notice must be sent to the provided fax or email and followed with a phone call to the Facility Compliance Branch. Fax: (504) 365-2287 Email: transfernoticenola@uscg.mil Phone: 504-329-0726.
- 2. Midstream transfers are PROHIBITED in the General or Quarantine Anchorages.
- 3. Notices are required for all Midstream Transfers involving Hazardous Material as defined by 49 CFR 171.8; PROHIBITED CARGOS: All Liquefied Hazardous Gases (LHG) as defined in 33 CFR 127.005, All Cargoes of Particular Hazard (COPH) as defined in 33 CFR 126.3, Ethylamine, Methylamine and Hydrogen Peroxide.
- 4. The vessel's bridge must be manned at all times.
- 5. The transfer must be conducted in accordance with all applicable requirements provided in 33 CFR Part 156.
- 6. The National Response Center (1-800-424-8802) must be notified IMMEDIATELY of any actual or potential oil/chemical spill.
- 7. Sector New Orleans (504-365-2209) must be notified IMMEDIATELY of any oil/chemical spill, loss of cargo, or other accident.
