INDIANA HEALTH COVERAGE PROGRAMS BT202087 JULY 16, 2020

Enrollment as *Transportation Network Company (TNC)* will not require fingerprinting and background check

As announced in *Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) Bulletin [BT202081](#)*, the IHCP will expand its list of eligible transportation providers to include a new provider specialty, *Transportation Network Company (TNC)*.

This new provider specialty will now allow TNC providers to enroll in their own classification as explained in [BT202081](#):

- Provider type: 26 – *Transportation*
- Provider specialty: 267 – *Transportation Network Company (TNC)*



All currently enrolled TNCs will be automatically transferred into this new provider specialty and associated risk level. This provider specialty is classified as Limited Risk.

[BT202081](#) gives requirements that providers must meet to enroll as a TNC provider specialty. The bulletin incorrectly states that fingerprinting and a criminal background check are required.

Correction: Enrollment as a TNC provider specialty does not require fingerprinting and a criminal background check.

All other information in the bulletin is accurate and remains unchanged.
